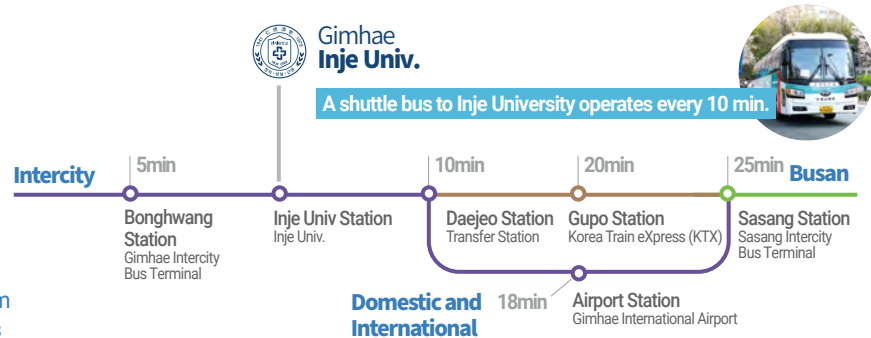

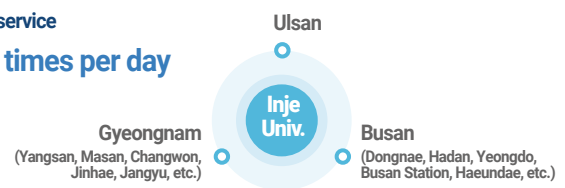

Level		Aims and Contents
Beginning	Level 1	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students can perform basic language functions such as self-introduction, buying things, ordering food, and understanding and expressing opinions on topics such as family, hobby, and weather. • Students can communicate based on a simple vocabulary and their understanding of basic grammar. Additionally, they can comprehend practical sentences and use everyday expressions.
	Level 2	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students can perform essential functions for their daily lives, such as calling and asking for a favor, those for the use of public facilities. • Students can understand and use paragraphs on private and familiar topics. • Students can distinguish expressions in formal situations from those in informal situations.
Intermediate	Level 3	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students do not have any difficulty in performing daily life activities and can perform fundamental language functions required to use various public facilities and maintain social relationships. • Students can express or understand social or specific topics that are familiar to them in a paragraph. • Students can understand and use the basic characteristics of written and spoken language.
	Level 4	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students can perform language functions required to use public facilities and maintain social relationships and have developed necessary language capabilities for conducting general tasks at work. • Students can understand and use most contents on general social topics indicated in news and articles. • Students can understand and use socio-cultural contents based on frequently used idioms and their understanding of representative Korean culture.
Advanced	Level 5	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students can enhance their capabilities for understanding and using advanced expressions based on their Korean language skills developed in elementary and intermediate courses. • Students can properly distinguish and use Korean expressions according to formal and informal context as well as spoken and written context.
	Level 6	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students can logically express their ideas based on their Korean language skills developed in classes and accurately and fluently perform language functions required for professional research or work to a certain extent. • Students can understand and discuss unfamiliar topics on politics, economy, society, culture, etc. • Students do not have any difficulty in performing language functions and expressing meanings although their Korean language level may not reach that of native speakers.

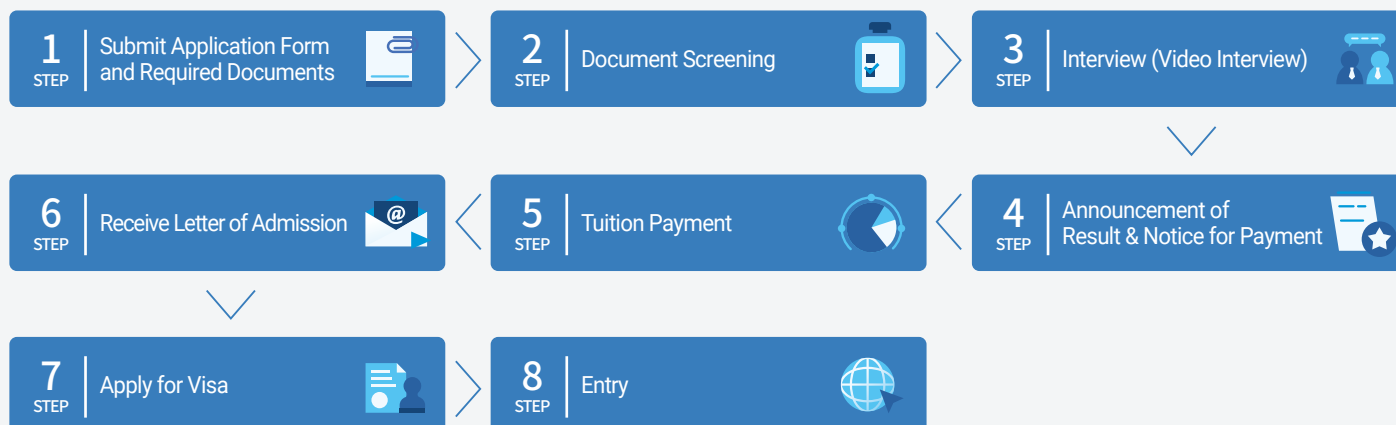

Required Documents		Contents
1	Application form	School form (A photo must be attached.)
2	Photo	① 4 photos (3cm x 4cm, white background) ② ID photo (JPG format)
3	A copy of passport	① a copy of passport * Passport validity must remain 2-3 years. ② a copy of the applicant's ID card
4	Bank statement	① A minimum balance of USD \$8,000 (Bank statements must be issued within one month.)
5	Certificate of final graduation	① Apostille countries: Apostille certificate with English translation ② Non-apostille countries: Certified by a Korean consulate * If the original document is not English, submit additional translation publication copy
6	Certificate of final academic transcript	
7	Birth certificate / family register (relation) certificate	① Family relationship certificate or birth certificate * For Chinese students, submit the family register. ② Parental employment and income certificate ③ A copy of your parents' ID (or a copy of passport)
8	Verification documents of the applicant's or his or her parents for the guarantee of finance	① Original copies of current employment and income certificates of the applicant or his or her parents ② A certificate of business registration or a confirmation document for business management ③ A land register (a verification document for eminent domain) or various verification documents issued by regional private and public organizations ④ Various business-related verification documents including a business-related bank statement

6 Notes

- Prepare the necessary documents for evaluation and submit them by mail.
- A student can personally apply for and obtain a visa (D-4) at the Korean Consulate with the required documents. (Please check the documents required for visa issuance before applying).
- Register according to the enrollment instructions sent with the admission letter.
- If false information is provided, admission will be canceled. Moreover, the incident will be reported to the immigration office.

Welcome to Inje University

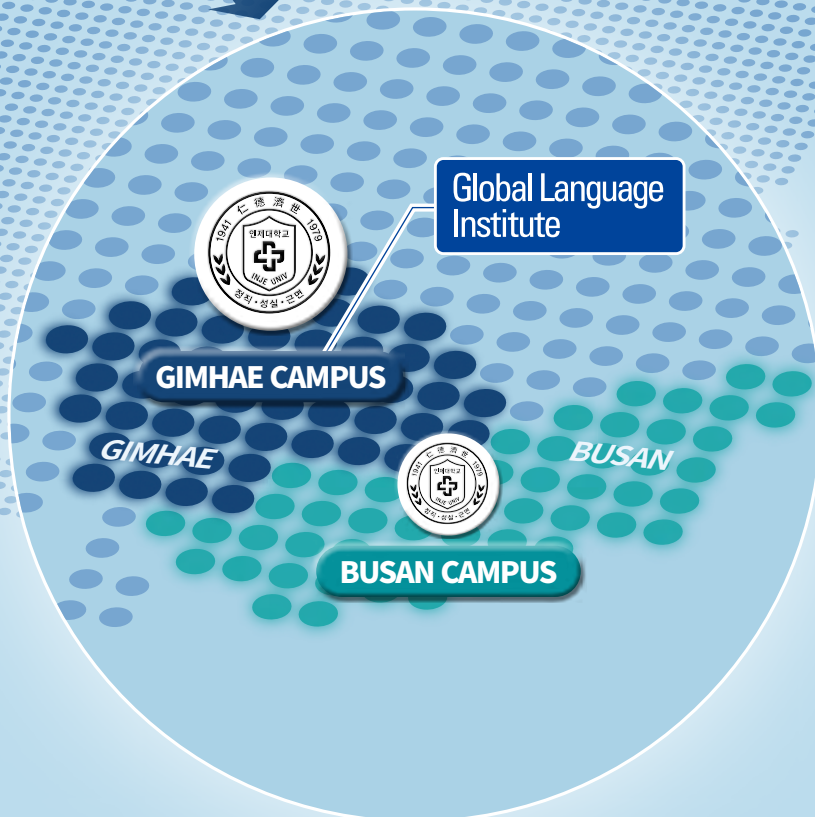
