



01 Application Procedure



* Applicants' scholastic ability is prioritized when it comes to evaluation. Even the applicants who do not satisfy Korean standards can be accepted by Hanyang University according to the scholastic competence. However, these students should satisfy Korean standards to start their degree programs.

Changes on 2021 Spring Semester Admission Guidelines

1. Undergraduate

(1) Separate admission procedure by campus

Seoul or ERICA campus applicants should apply separately at each campus as each campus has different admission process from 2021 spring semester admission. For more details, please refer to the admission guidelines of each campus. (to be announced in August 2020)

(2) Changes on dual application criteria

- Spring 2021 Seoul campus applicants (undergraduate) can make dual application for Seoul campus

2. Graduate

(1) Seoul or ERICA campus applicants must make application through Seoul Campus Office of International Affairs

(No separate application between campuses, No dual application, same as before)

(2) Changes on acceptance criteria

From 2021 Spring semester, graduate school applicants must satisfy the Korean language standards to be successfully accepted. Applicants who are not able to submit documents for Korean language standards within document submission period still have chances to receive "Korean Language standards Exemption Letter" during the document screening process by professors.



Admission Test (Undergraduate only)

Only undergraduate applicants are required to take the admission test, and will be proceeded simultaneously in Korea and China. Applicants who fail to take the test will automatically be dropped from admission. Applicants who live in Korea should take the test in Hanyang University and applicants who live in China should take the test in Shanghai or Beijing. Foreign applicants residing abroad, except for China, Hong Kong, must have an online face-to-face interview substituting for the admission test. Applicants who fail to attend the video interview will automatically be dropped from admission.

- 1) **Exam type** : Essay examination
- 2) **Exam date** : Please see application schedule. (The dates are tentative and will be announced on OIA website - <http://study.hanyang.ac.kr>)
- 3) **Exam venue** : Hanyang University (Details are to be announced)

- 5) **Questions will be given in Korean, English, Chinese, Japanese and Mongolian.**

HYU Korean Language Proficiency Standards

Satisfying Korean standards is irrelevant to the admission to undergraduate and graduate schools. Nonetheless, students who have passed the admission test but failed the Korean Language Proficiency Test must take a leave of absence (for more details, you should check the regulation of leave of absence) and take Korean language courses at either Hanyang University Institute of International Education or language institutes of other universities. By satisfying Korean requirement of our university, students can re-register for upcoming school semester.




