  - Foreign citizens whose parents are not Korean citizens
  - Foreign or Korean citizens who have completed elementary, middle and high school outside of Korea and never enrolled in any school(s) in Korea

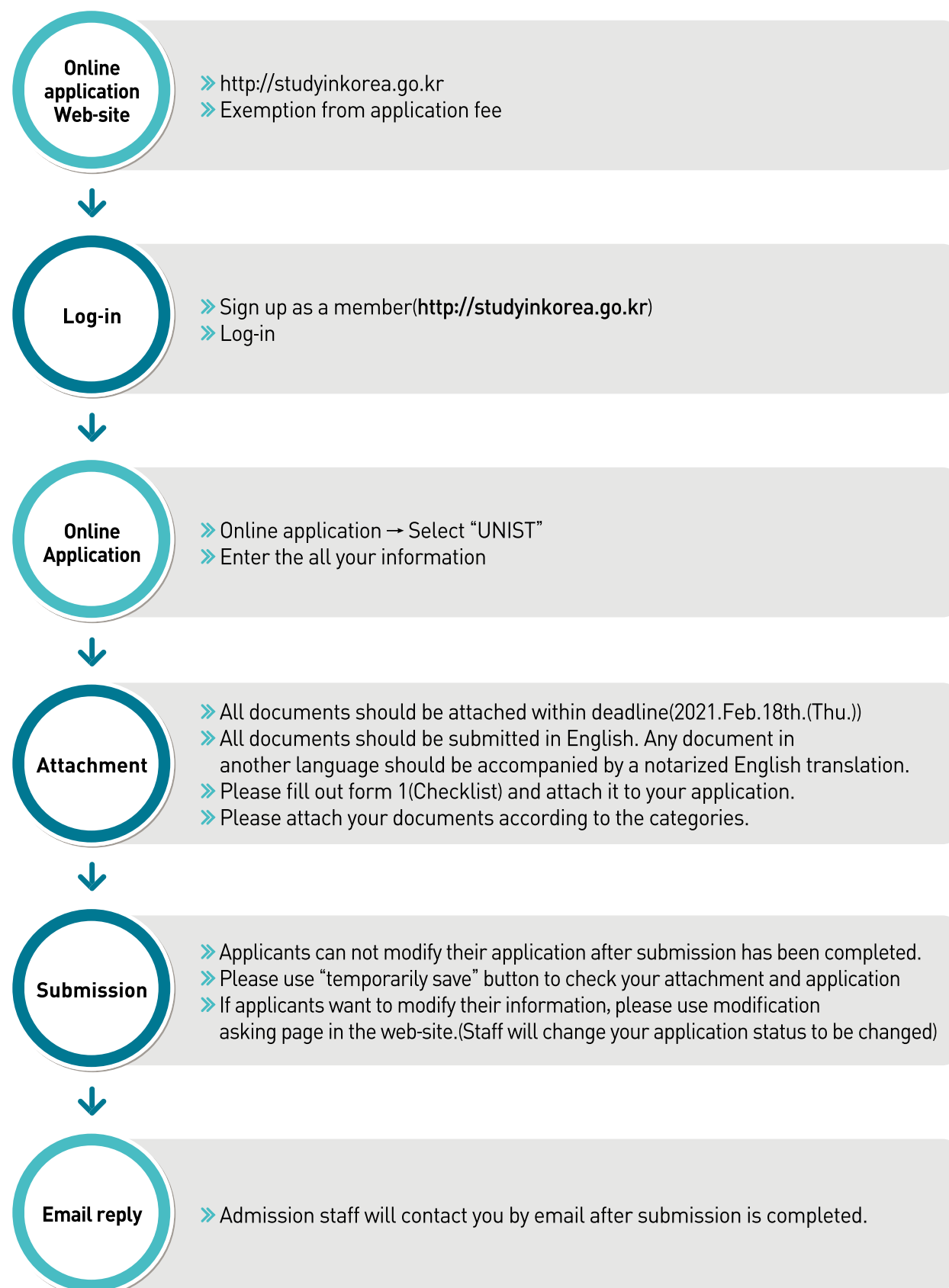
※ All the documents should be submitted in English. Any document in another language should be accompanied by a notarized English translation.

※ Exemption from submission of English Test Report

1. Applicant from U.S.A, Canada, U.K, Australia, New Zealand, Ireland (Native English Speaker)
2. Applicants from a country that uses English as a official language
3. Applicants who have completed all the classes in 100% English  
(This case is required to submit a certificate of class completion)



## Admission Procedure



## Admission Criteria

- Common criteria
  - Based on all the submitted documents such as personal statements, transcripts, and letter(s) of recommendation, UNIST considers various factors comprehensively including academic ability, study plan, vision and potential when determining admission.
  - Evaluation will be conducted by two or more evaluators.
- Dossier Evaluation
  - After the dossier evaluation, all the applicants are decided as “Accepted”, “Interviewed”, or “Rejected”.
- Interview
  - Telephone interview will be only directed to the applicants selected as interviewees and If necessary, we will conduct face to face interview.
  - Interview will be focused on applicant’s suitability, vision etc.
  - After the interview, all interviewees are decided as “Accepted”, “Candidate” or “Rejected”.
- Decision of Successful candidates
  - All accepted applicants from dossier evaluation and interview will be decided as successful candidates.
  - We can nominate candidates based on the results of interview.
- Registration
  - All successful candidates have to remit the deposit within deadline.
  - If successful candidates will not remit the deposit, it will be considered as abandonment of registration
  - Nominated candidates can be registered based on the registration result of successful candidates.

## Important notice for all the applicants

- If any of the submitted materials contains falsified information, admissions may be cancelled.
- Students whose graduation is pending at other institutions during the time of application should submit their graduation certificates(diplomas) within 20 days of enrollment at UNIST. Failure to submit these documents may result in their enrollment cancellation.
- All the submitted documents shall not be returned to the applicants.
- Even if the admitted students give up enrollment in UNIST, the deposit shall not be returned.
- Applicants should take full responsibilities for any mistakes or omissions on the application.
- All the documents should be submitted in English. Any document in another language should be accompanied by a notarized English translation.
