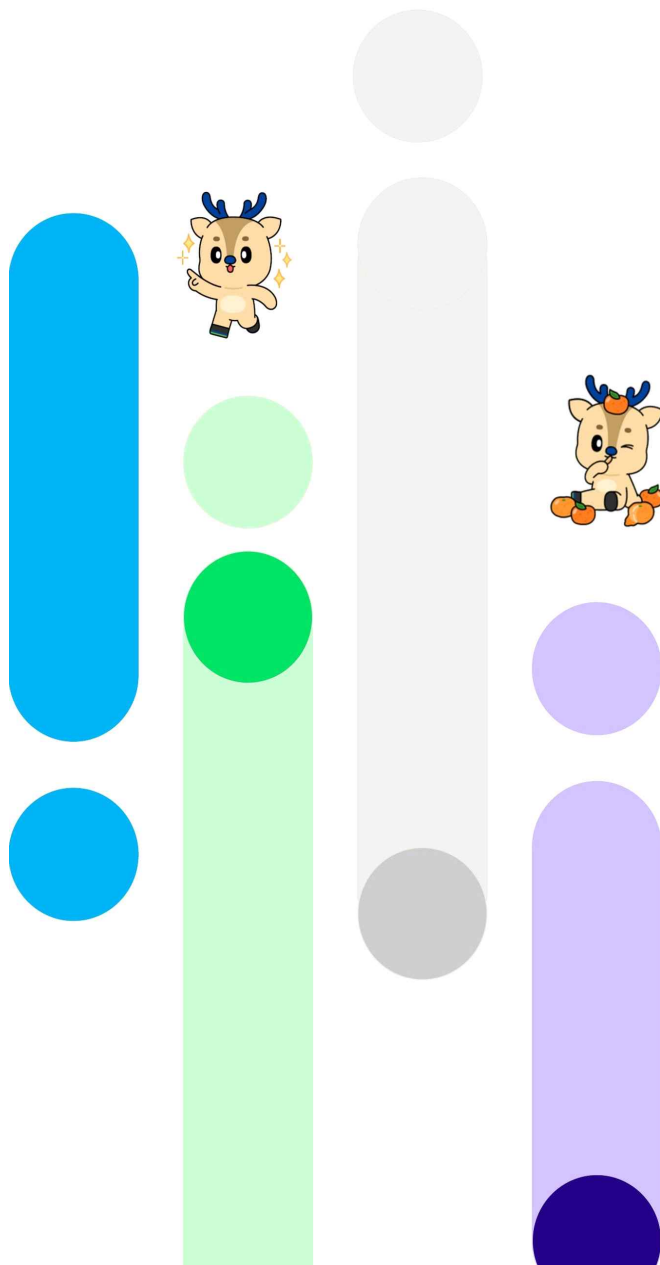

1) 1 Class hour: 50 minutes of lecture + 10 minutes of break; the lecture consists of 4 credit hours per day (09:00 ~ 12:50).

III Qualification to Apply

Visa Type	Qualification to Apply
D4 visa (Language Trainee Visa)	- High School Graduate or Higher ※ But, if people are from 21 countries³⁾ designated by the ministry of Justice or 5 countries⁴⁾ that are under close scrutiny and their final degree is a High School Diploma, their graduation must be within 2 years.(Except for the people who have the TOPIK certificate) - If necessary, the university will follow the rules dictated by the "Operation of Korean Language Course at Jeju National University".
Other Visas (Verified to Stay for more than 6 months in Korea)	Follows the guidelines of the "Operation of Korean language course at Jeju National University".

IV Required Documents

○ Language Training (D4-1) Visa Application(Updated)

No.	Document	Content
1	Application Form	- Fill out the attached form after download. - Self Introduction, Study Plan, and Financial Confirmation should be filled out. - Expired date of the passport must be after the beginning day of the semester.
2	Passport Copy	- Chinese nationals must submit a copy of citizenship. - Students from Uzbekistan must submit the new passport which can be used for the departure abroad - Students who are already in Korea must submit a copy of their ARC (Alien Registration Card)
3.	Certificate of the Final Degree ① Certificate of (or Expected) Graduation ② Transcripts	- Submit the certificate of the highest educational qualification (High school graduates or higher). (You can choose one option among the two below) 1)Original APOSTILLE Certificate of Final Degree (not original diploma, but the copy of your diploma that received original apostille). 2)Original Certificate of Graduation confirmed by a Korean Consul in the country your high school is located or by a Consul in Korea ("not original diploma", but the "Copy of your diploma" that received original confirmation by Korean Consul). - People who received their diploma in China have to submit their Certificate of Diploma published by the Chinese Ministry of Education or documents confirmed by a consul. – University: http://www.chsi.com.cn ; http://www.cdgd.edu.cn/ – High School: http://www.chsi.com.cn – Submit a COPY of the original diploma (Originals not accepted due to the likelihood of it getting lost)
4	Financial Support Documents * (Under Applicant or its parents' name) Bank Statement (Over 8 million won)	- If the Bank Statement is under parents' name, family relationship certificate must be submitted. - These documents must be issued within one month, and over 8 million won must have been deposited for over 3 months. ※ However, in the cases of Vietnamese or Uzbek applicants, the applicants must open a bank account with an officially recognized bank that has both domestic (Korean) and international branches (including smaller branches) and that bank account must be an account that has a system of payment reservation. They must submit the bank balance statement to prove their financial capability during their study period when applying for their study visas. (Only bank balance statements which clearly indicate the conditional

		suspension of payment period will be accepted) * 4 million won can be withdrawn in installments every six months, indicating that the payment has been suspended for a total of one year.
5	ID Photo(2 photos)	• 2 ID photos that have been taken within 3 months before the application date (Size 3.5×4.5cm)
6	Others (Only those concerned submit)	• Currently employed: Employment records, Reasons for studying abroad. • Break Periods: If applicants have more than a year's break from school after graduation, relevant documents that explain about that break period should be submitted. • If applicants have experience studying in Korea, relevant certificates must be submitted. • Those who have TOPIK, the scores certificate must be submitted.

*In the case of Financial Support Documents, if a coordinator in charge of specific nations make requests for other documents(parents' employment and income) apart from the bank statement, they are regarded as required documents.

* All submitted documents will not be returned.

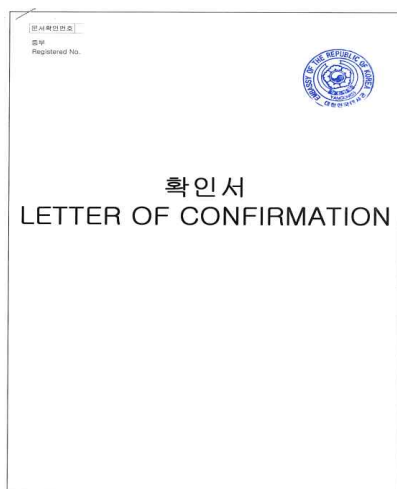

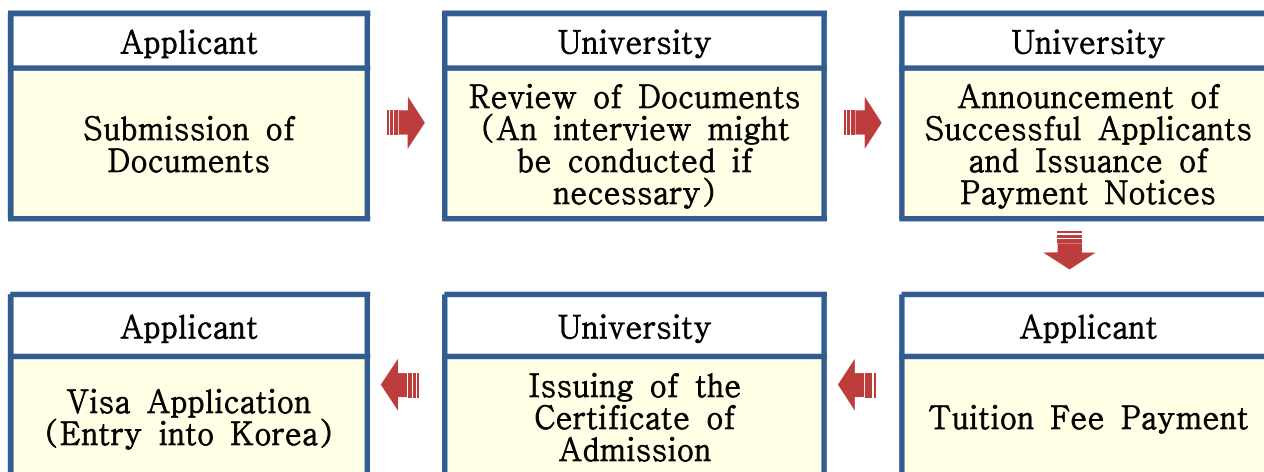
