Master of Orthopedic Manual Physiotherapy and Contrology (M.O.M.P.T.C)

This department combines manual physical therapy and Pilates to cultivate experts who can effectively enhance movement as well as treatment and prevention of physical ailments to improve health. The curriculum is based on the theoretical and practical courses specialized in physical therapy and Pilates necessary to achieve these educational objectives, and in particular, Pilates certificates are awarded through intensive research and practice related to the convergence of orthopedic manual physical therapy and rehabilitation Pilates to support students in working as specialists. Through this program, you can become a health expert who can contribute to the development of health science in Korea and work at the international level.

Characteristics and Benefits of the Department of Orthopedic Manual Physiotherapy and Contrology

- Curriculum operation is based on clinical reasoning and evidence-based practice, which are the main concepts of rehabilitation.
- Provides excellent curriculum through overseas physical therapy education programs such as the United States, Australia, and specialized Pilates education programs.
- As an orthopedic manual therapy and rehabilitation Pilates specialist, students will be awarded an orthopedic manual therapist certificate and rehabilitation Pilates certificate, which enables you to start a rehabilitation center, Pilates center, and research institute.
 - a. Education methods used in Commonwealth nations for physical therapy are applied, such as team teaching, discussion, and practice through case studies.
 - b. Opportunities to participate in research programs such as seminars, intensive classes, workshops, and joint research in connection with overseas professors are available.
- Through agreements with the University of Canberra in Australia and Wintech University in New Zealand, joint research and exchanges, short-term training and visitations to overseas universities are possible. Additionally, there is an option to advance to a graduate course in exercise therapy if students can obtain a minimum English proficiency score of IELTS 6.5.
- The curriculum of this department is also tailored to those recommended by the International Federation of Orthopedic Manual Physiotherapy under the World Health Organization, allowing students to advance as exercise therapists and physiotherapists in Commonwealth nations.

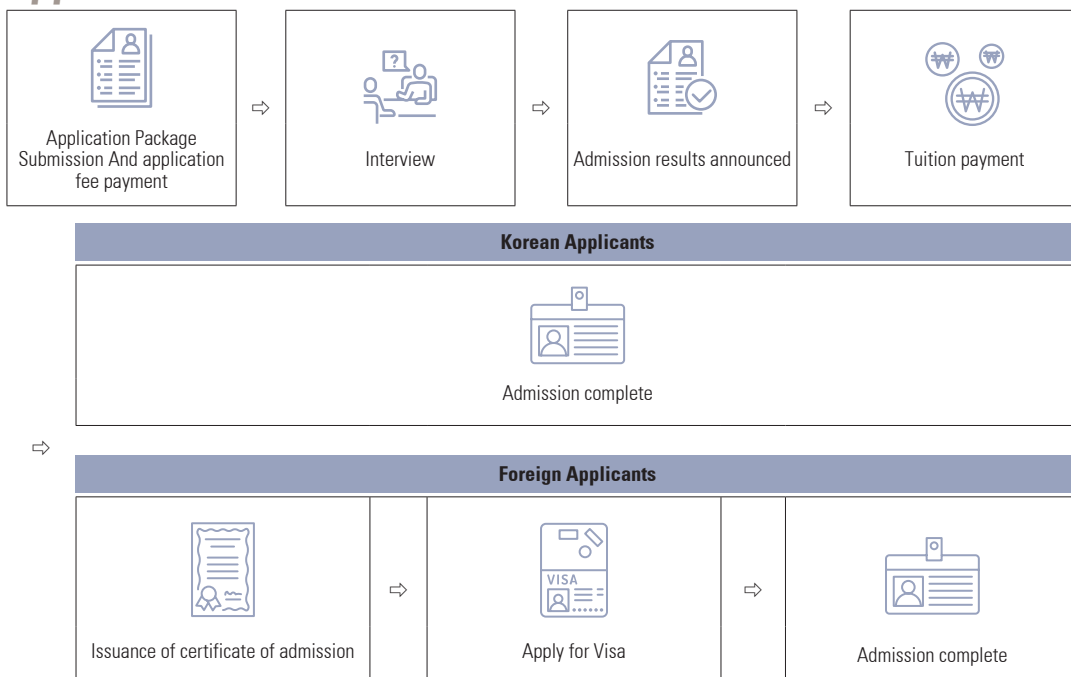

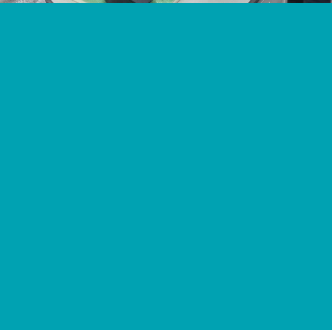
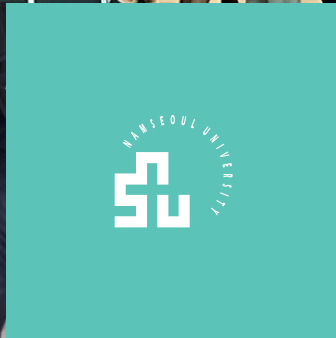
