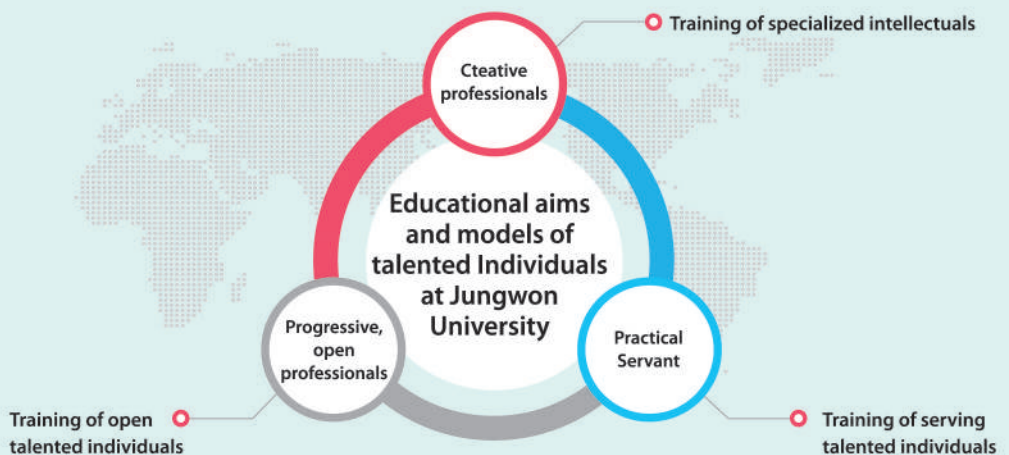

Department Introduction

The Department of Computer Engineering combines engineering in various fields such as computer engineering, information, communication, electronics, and security to provide information security, web/app development, embedded system development, and information and communication, which are essential for most industries in the 21st century knowledge and information society. It includes various fields, and the curriculum is designed to serve as a foundation for specialization in each field through basic knowledge of computer engineering.

Department Introduction

***Skin Beauty:** The field of skin beauty, which is currently in the spotlight, is an advanced course for therapy not only for the skin but also for the whole body, mind and body. We increase the employment rate through thorough theory and professional practice-oriented classes, and are based on systematic and diverse education on various healing therapies such as dermatology, cosmetology, dermatology, and aromatherapy.

***Hair Beauty:** A course that builds confidence through a curriculum ranging from basic practical training to field-oriented advanced hair styling, and educates you as a professional hairdresser by providing education on theories and practical skills such as hair science and scalp care. It's a process.

***Makeup, Nail Art, and Cosmetics:** As a creative applied major, this curriculum aims to educate students through theoretical and practical courses by learning makeup, cosmetics science, material development, and nail art for beauty design creation.

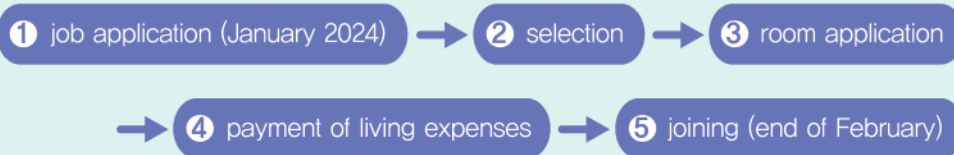

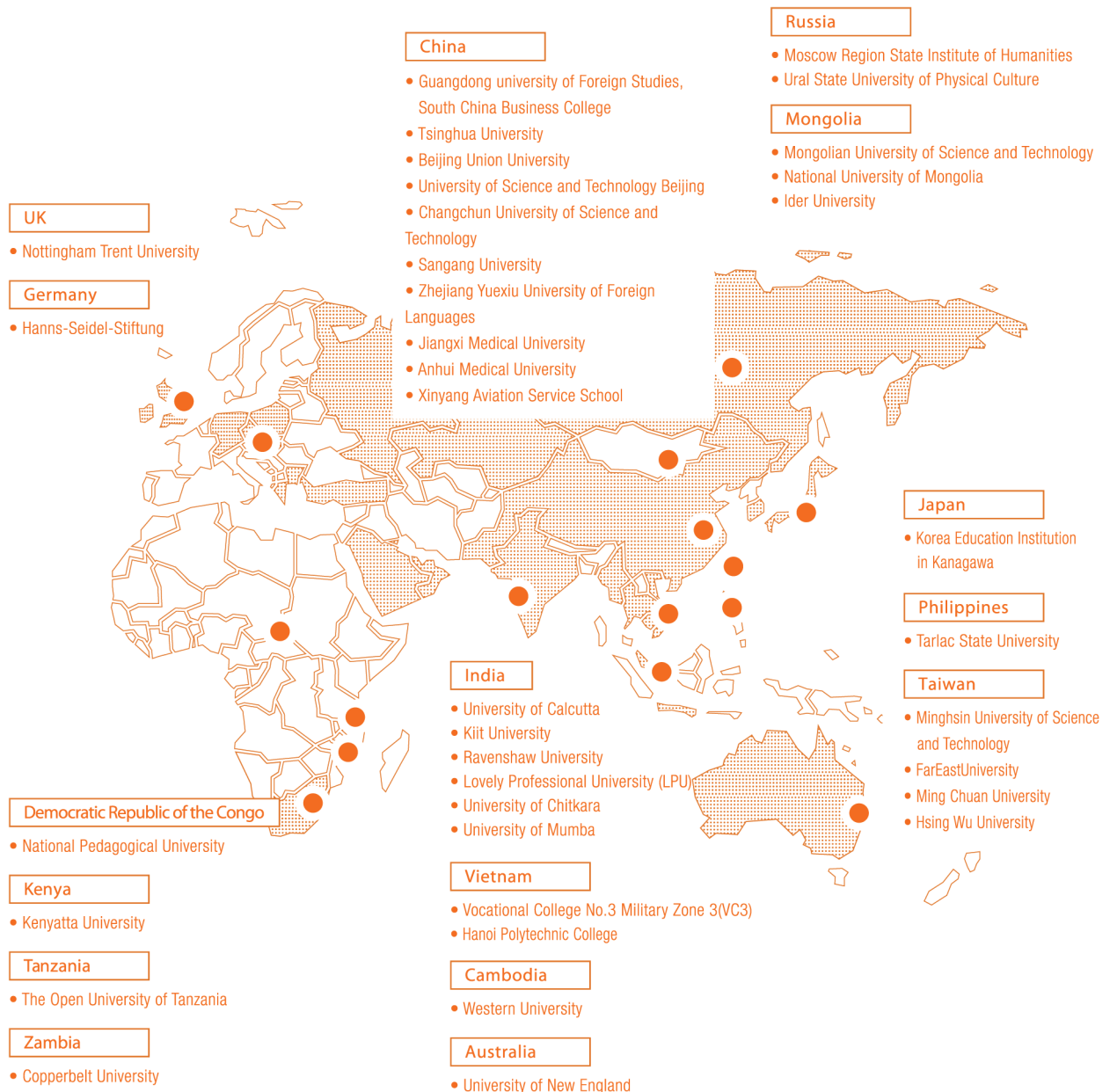

Dormitories

Jungwon University's eco-friendly dormitories provide hotel-class accommodations, while protecting the privacy of occupants. In consideration of students' health, all rooms as well as the building itself have been finished with granite ceramic, creating the finest environment for living and learning.

Living to Learn, Learning to Live

In addition to its eco-friendly dormitories with studio style rooms, the campus boasts an impressive array of top-notch facilities and conveniences not seen on a university campus, including study rooms, extracurricular club rooms, the Jungwon Book & Fun Cafe, a campus bookstore, a clinic, a hair salon, a karaoke, a greenhouse, an international-standard turf soccer field, a fitness club, an indoor golf range, a pool hall, separate spas for men and women, an international-standard indoor swimming pool, and a landscaped outdoor swimming pool. Jungwon University is a self-sufficient community designed to meet the needs of students and faculty residing on the campus.





Museum

The Jungwon University Museum showcases rare cultural artifacts not to be found anywhere else in Korea, thus fulfilling its commitment to cultural enrichment for students and local residents. In the Natural History Hall, 630 pieces including fossils, minerals, and samples from dinosaurs and other forms of life are on display. The World Customs and Religions Hall contains 2,800 artifacts from China, Europe, the United States, Africa, South America, and beyond, while the Material Civilizations Hall displays watches, musical instruments, machinery, and other items. There is also an outdoor exhibition area with about 50 bronze and stone pieces on display.

8-lane indoor swimming pool of international standard with 50m course

We have an indoor swimming pool of international standard that is normally only seen at sports colleges in Korea. The indoor swimming pool is used for liberal art courses as well as all Jungwon members.

Korea's first university with an outdoor natural grass golf course

We have an eco-friendly 18-hole executive golf course, a first for Korea, which is used by the Department of Sports Coaching to conduct classes for students to generate an understanding of field sports. It is also used as a leisure opportunity for foreign guests, the local community, and for the convenience and welfare improvement of the faculty.



Spas

There are two spas equipped with a variety of mineral, medicinal, and underwater massage baths that contribute greatly to the health of Jungwon's students and faculty community.

Student center

The student center serves as the center of campus life. It offers numerous up-to-date facilities that make life more convenient and enjoyable for students, including an intensive study room, extracurricular clubs, and a convenience store.

Sports Center

Furnished with the latest equipment the sports center serves as a space for quality leisure time and the wholesome enhancement of physical fitness. Students can enjoy a variety of features, including a fitness club, a screen golf practice range, table tennis, and pool tables

Jungwon Book & Fun Cafe

At the Book & Fun Cafe, students can see Jungwon University's commitment to global education in action. Staffed with English-speaking personnel, the cafe is designed as a hands-on learning environment for students to carry on conversations in English, Japanese, or Chinese.
