Korean Language Training Course Recruitment Guide



- The regular course is our school's permanent year-round program to develop integrated communication skills. The course is designed for students who want to go to a university or graduate school in Korea by studying the Korean language intensively.

- The regular course runs in four quarters of spring, summer, autumn, and winter per year, allowing learners to start studying Korean by choosing the right time for them.

- A class consists of at least 15 to 20 students. One quarter lasts 10 weeks and is trained for four hours a day (about 200 hours per quarter) from Monday to Friday. Class hours are open from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m.

1. educational goals and content by level

LEVEL 1	Can generate simple sentences based on 800 basic vocabulary and understanding of basic grammar. Can understand and compose simple life sentences and practical sentences
LEVEL 2	Use approximately 1500 to 2000 vocabulary words and understand and use the familiar topic in paragraph units. Use language separation in formal and informal situations
LEVEL 3	Perform basic language necessary for the use of various public facilities, etc., without any difficulty in daily life. Use of basic characteristics of octopus and spoken language separately
LEVEL 4	Understand plain content such as news and use general social material relatively accurately and fluently. <u>Understanding and Using Socio-Cultural Content Based on Understanding Korean Culture</u>
LEVEL 5	Can conduct research or work in a specialized field. Understand and use unfamiliar materials throughout politics, economy, society and culture. Use of formal, informal, colloquial contextual distinctions
LEVEL 6	Accurate and fluent language use required for research or job performance in a specialized field. Ability to participate in university lecture-level activities by utilizing Korean grammar and free professional activities

2. School life

■ Quarterly schedule

Level Test	Students who will study for 10 weeks will be placed in a class at their level through a split exam (written test, interview test) before the start of the quota.
Orientation	On the first day of the new quarter, we will be introduced to the teacher at the entrance ceremony, greet our friends, and hear about the school schedule for the new quarter.
Learning Korean Culture Experience	We will have hands-on learning where you can use the Korean language that you have learned in the classroom outside the classroom. In addition, we will visit various historical sites and famous Korean tourist attractions to experience cultural experiences. During this time, you can experience pottery making, taekwondo, Korean cooking, hanji crafts, and traditional knots.
Language exchange and cultural exchange	You can participate in the birdie program where you can share your opinions on the Korean language and culture by matching them 1:1 with Korean students.
an interim examination	This is an opportunity to check your Korean proficiency once again as an opportunity to check your speaking, listening, reading, and writing skills that you have learned for five weeks.
final examination	This is an opportunity to check your Korean skills such as speaking, listening, reading, and writing, which you learned during the quarter. Promotion and payment are determined by the results of the midterm and final exams.
Completion and graduation ceremonies	It is a place where students and teachers who studied together at the end of one quarter class gather in one place to celebrate the completion and graduation of the quarter.

Jinri Festival	It is a festival where students from various countries introduce each country's food, clothes, songs, and culture during the Jinri Festival in October every year.
