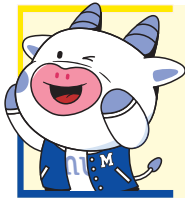

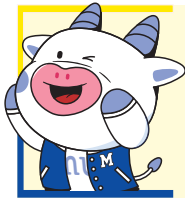
MILITARY DEPARTMENT (2 YEARS)

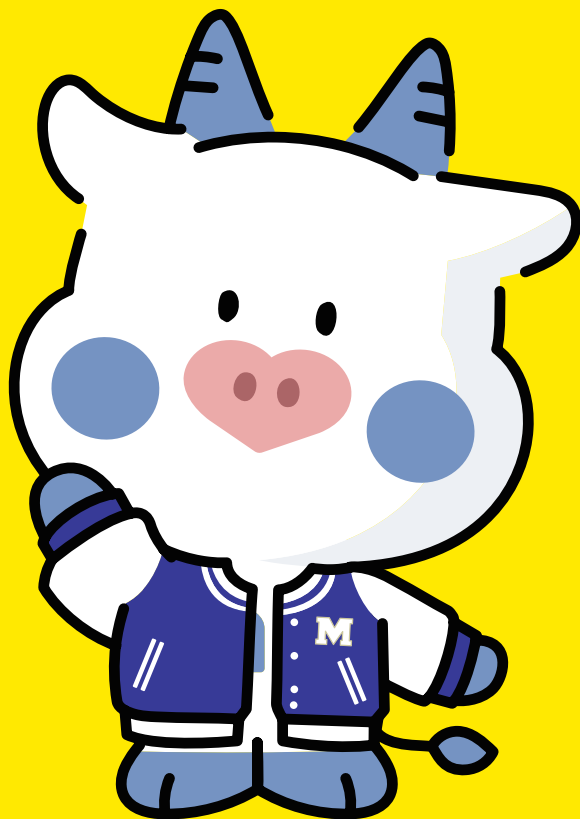

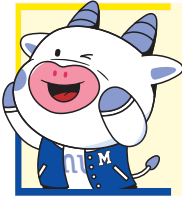

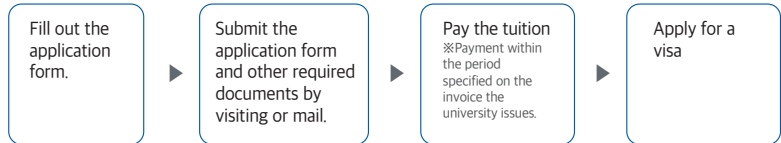

Application Procedure



Eligibility

- Application Period : Possible to apply at any time for each semester.
- Application Form : Download at the Masan University website or visit the Masan University International Exchange office to receive documents.
- How to Apply : Apply by the applicant or proxy, or by mail (Application by FAX is not allowed.)
※ If the application is made by proxy, the proxy must know all the details of the applicant and be able to reply questions regarding the application documents.

- Additional documents may be requested for receipt and screening processes.

Notices for Applicants

- ① Admission of persons who do not have the ability to study at our center may be canceled in the future.
- ② Acceptance or admission will be cancelled if any unlawful means are found, such as false records in qualifications or other documents or forged papers.
- ③ If the government of the Republic of Korea refuses to issue a visa, the application will be canceled and the tuition will be refunded according to the tuition refund policy.
- ④ The applicant's name (spelling) and date of birth must match the information on the passport.
- ⑤ The applicant is responsible for any disadvantage caused by mistakes in filling out the application form.
- ⑥ Certain documents, if requested by the university, have to be notarized and submitted. Additional documents, if requested, have to be submitted.
- ⑦ All documents submitted have to be an original one in Korean or English, or document translated into Korean.
- ⑧ After the admission, students have to apply for insurance for international students (insurance for foreign students of their home country is allowed) and submit a medical examination certificate (including hepatitis A and B, and pulmonary tuberculosis).
※ Admission may be canceled if any abnormal medical condition (such as infectious disease) is found.
- ⑨ Acceptance or admission will be cancelled if the admission schedule (document submission, tuition payment, etc.) is not followed.
- ⑩ The applicant should read and understand the application guidelines before submitting forms and documents. Any disadvantage caused by misunderstanding is the applicant's responsibility.
- ⑪ Documents submitted will not be returned, and the application form submitted cannot be changed.
