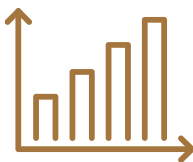

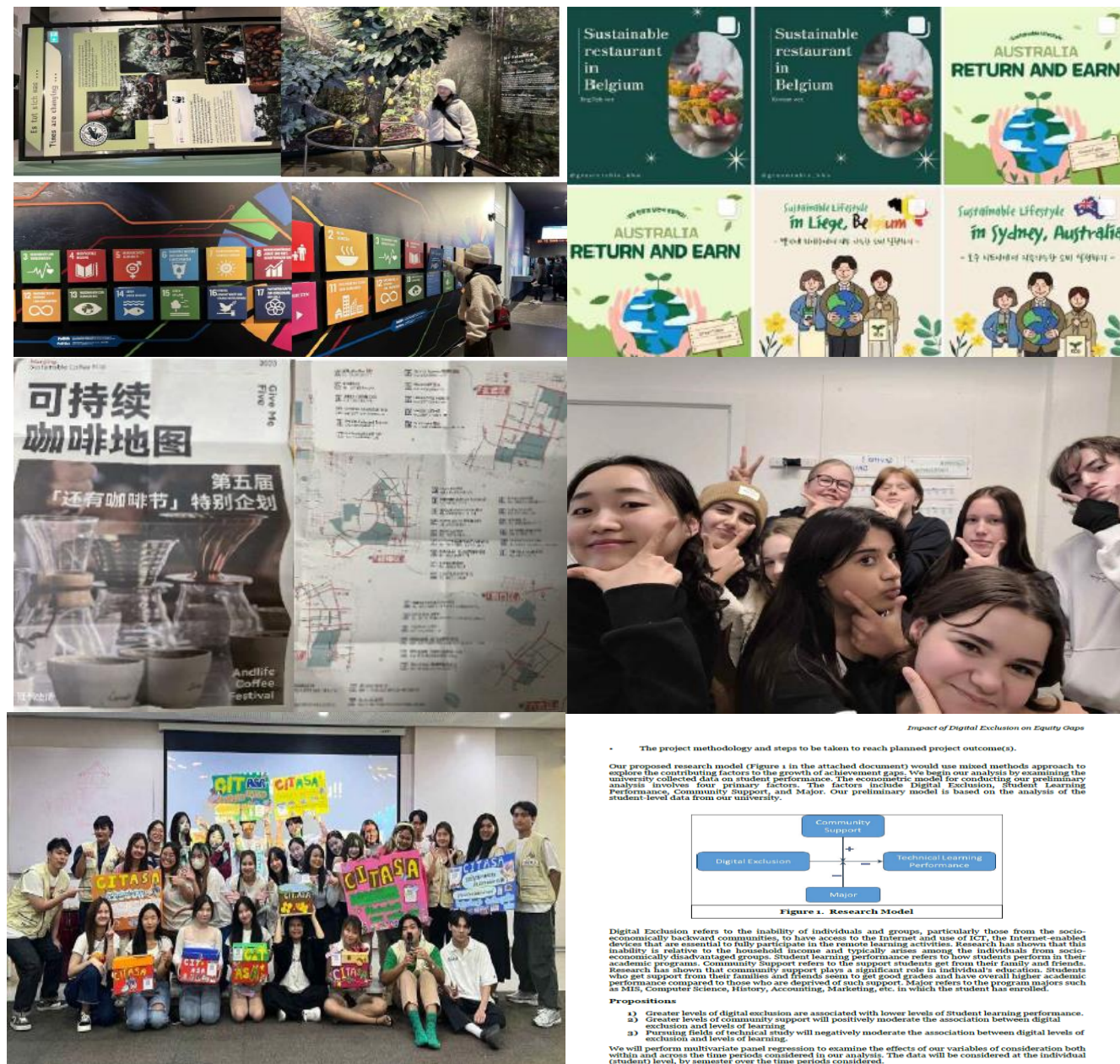

Kyung Hee University is offering a **Korean Studies Global Virtual School** aimed at foreign students. This program seeks to introduce and deepen understanding of Korean studies, particularly in light of the global popularity of Hallyu (the Korean Wave) and K-culture.

Credit Hours & Grading

- 3 credit courses: A total of 45 hours of in-class sessions
- Grading is based on attendance, class discussion, homework, and examinations and elements of assessment may be determined by each instructor. Kyung Hee University regulations require a minimum of 70% attendance for students to receive academic credit.
- All domestic and overseas students may transfer credits according to the policies of their home institutions.
- In case of undergraduate students at KHEU, grades will be marked as Pass/Non-Pass on their transcripts.

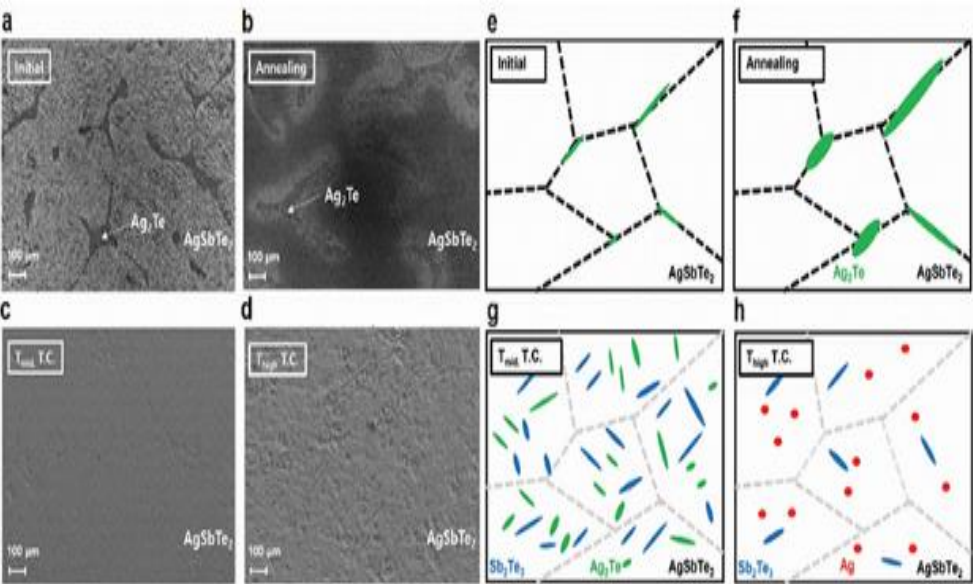

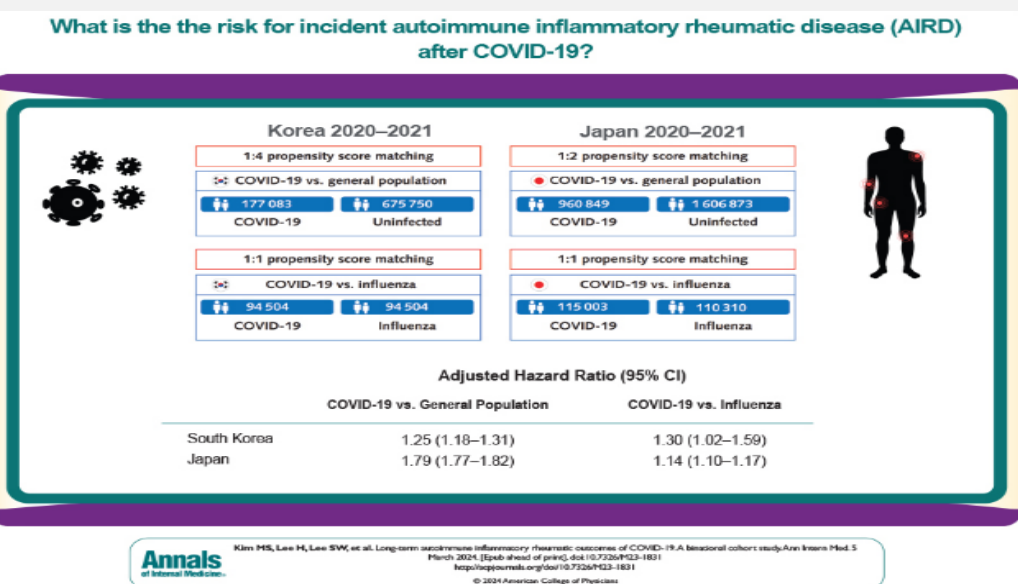
Development of Stable and Highly Efficient Thermoelectric Materials to Advance Carbon Neutrality

Professor Jong-Soo Rhyee and the research team at the Department of Applied Physics has presented a new approach to significantly improve the thermal stability of thermoelectric materials. This was the result of Increasing thermal stability and energy efficiency by exploiting the inherent instability of the material.



Constructing and Analysing Medical Big Data to Facilitate Research on “Chronic COVID-19 Syndrome”

Professor Dong Keon Yon of the College of Medicine and Jinseok Lee of the Department of Biomedical Engineering are deriving promising results on the ‘chronic COVID-19 syndrome’ through their joint analysis of medical big data. The likelihood of developing inflammatory rheumatic disease and allergic disease increases after COVID-19 infection.

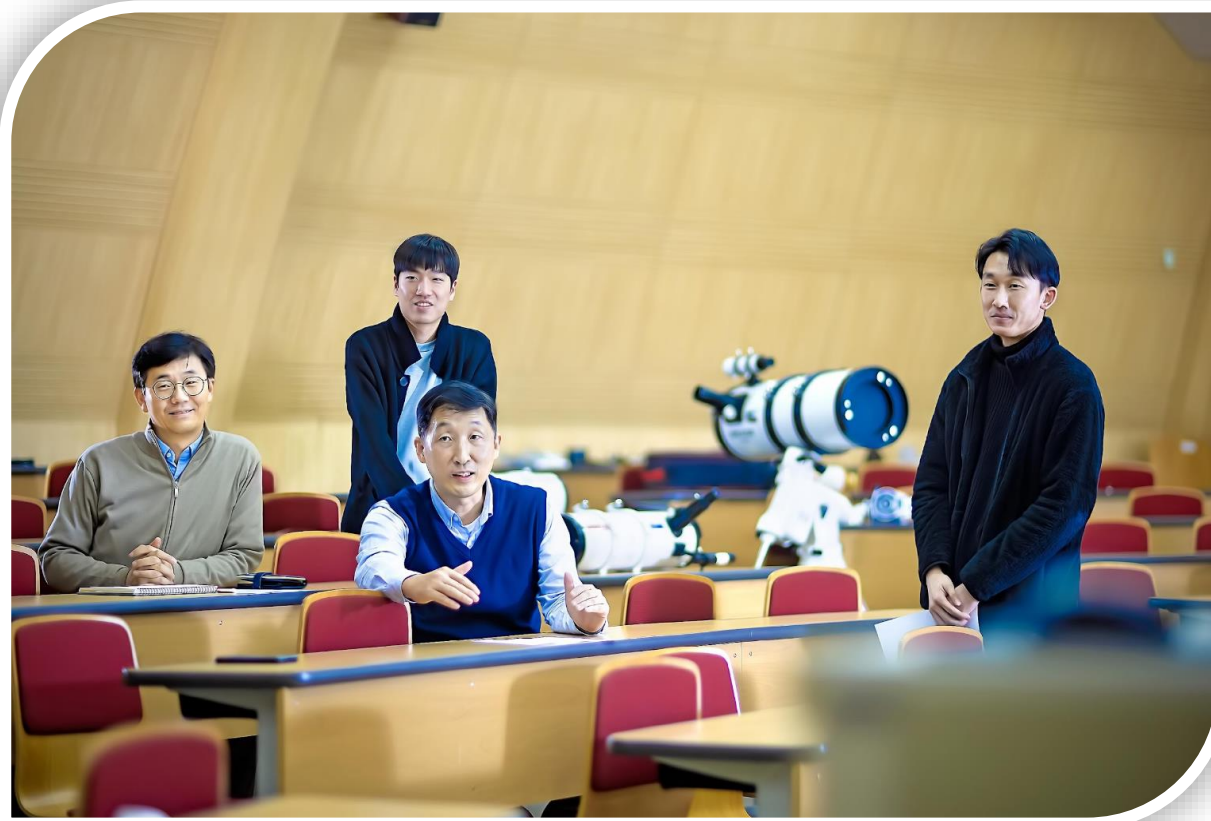


New 4D Security Technology to Prevent IoT Device Hacking

A research team led by Professor Wook Park from the Department of Electronic Engineering has developed the world’s first four-dimensional physical unclonable function (PUF) Technology. This system uses the inherent random characteristics of the hardware to create a unique, unclonable “Digital Fingerprints” to block hacking attempts and make the structure impossible to replicate, even by the creators themselves.



Faculty-led Research & Collaboration: Noticeable Fields of Studies



Professor Seon Jong-ho's research team will develop a Lunar Space Environment Monitor (LUSEM) loaded on an unmanned lunar probe scheduled to launch in 2024. It is the **first** collaborative project since the signing of the Artemis Agreement.

College of Hotel & Tourism Management has played a key role in developing the Korean Tourism Industry by fostering more than **10,000** professionals since its establishment in 1975.



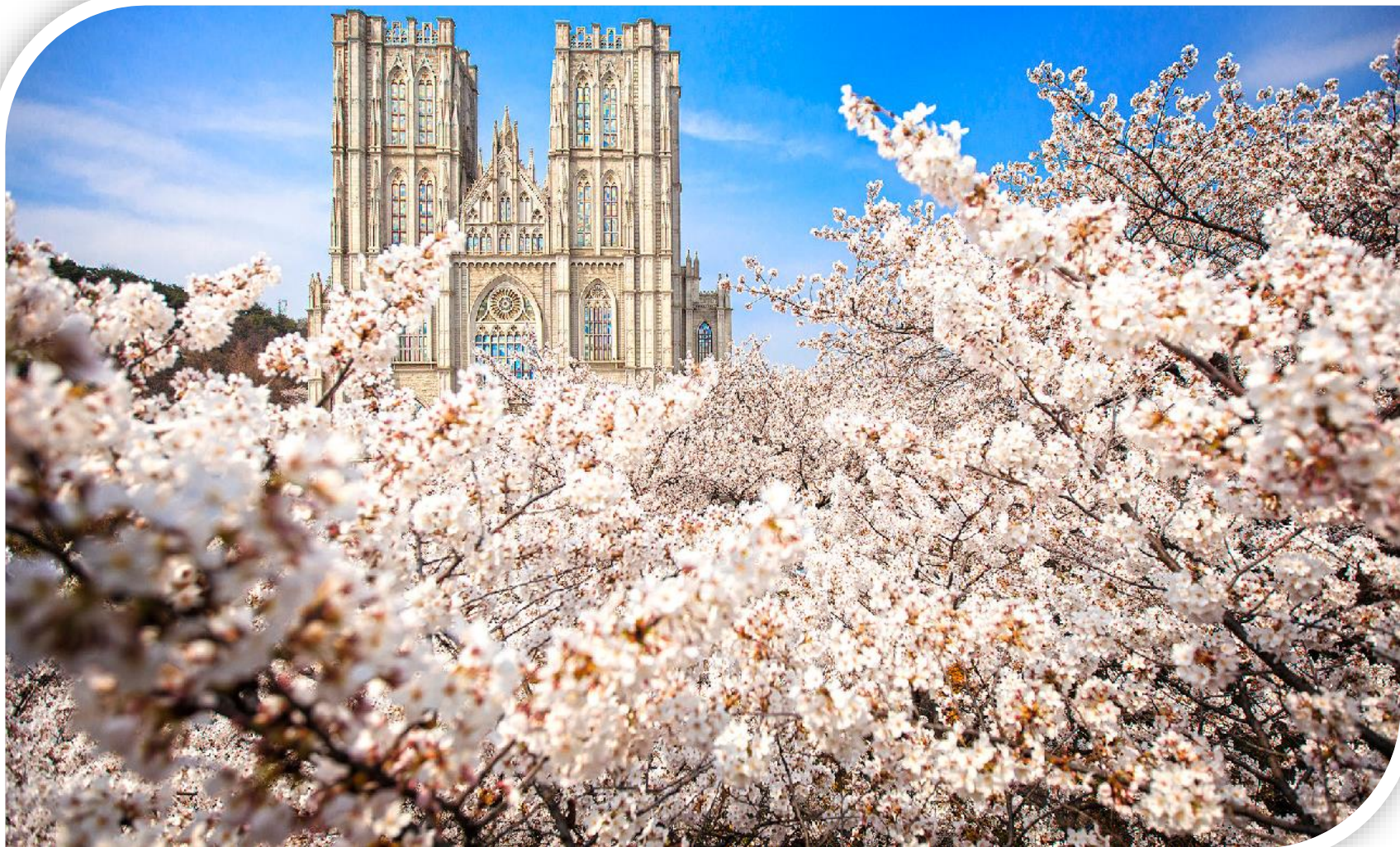

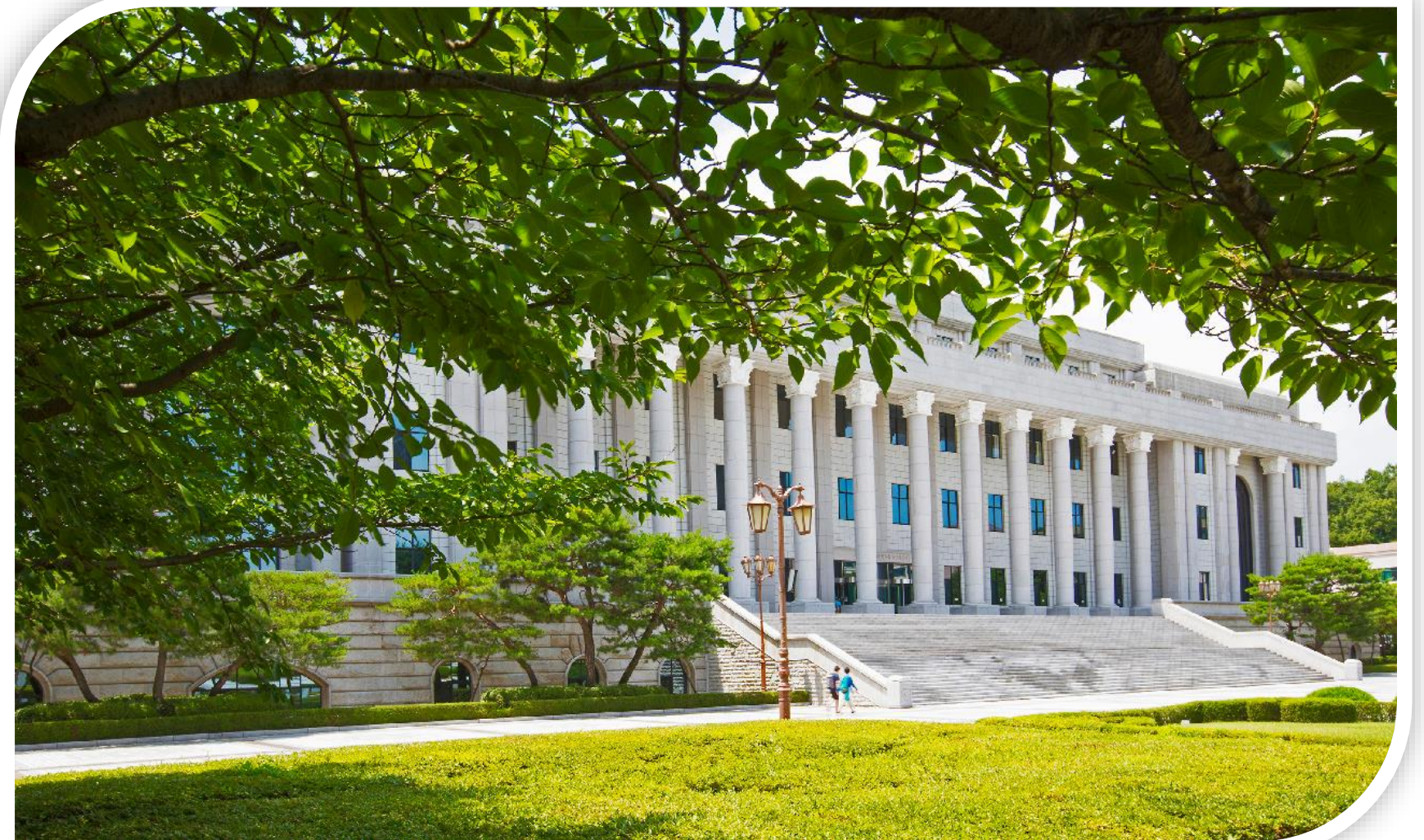

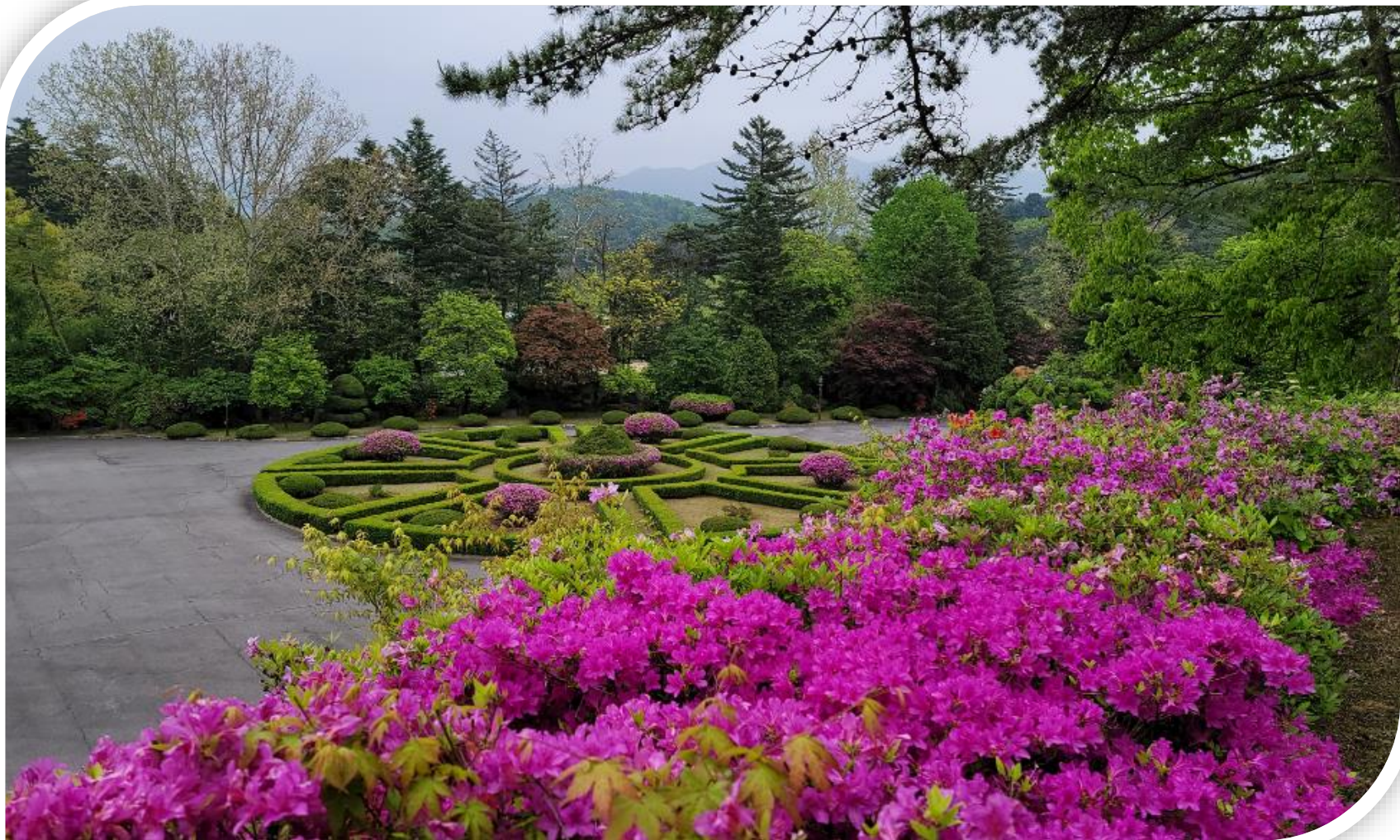
