

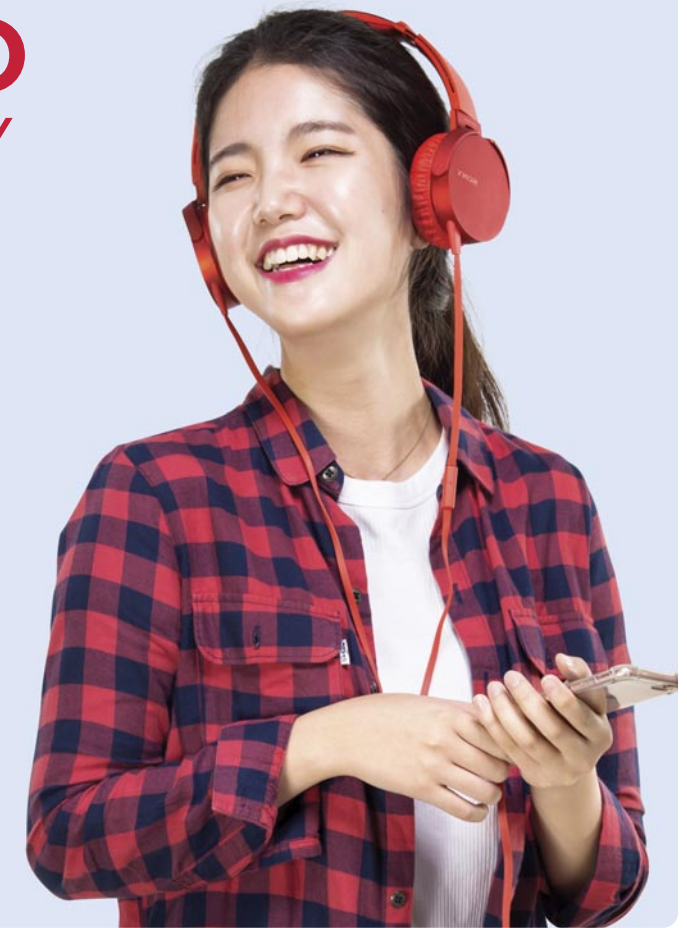

# Welcome to Dongseo!

Dongseo University ('DSU') is reforming university education and cultivating creative human resources in the era of the 4th Industrial Revolution and Smart Tech. Digital and AI technologies will continue to reshape every sector of the economy. DSU focuses on ensuring students acquire the right skills for new jobs and new tasks.

The year 2022 marks DSU's 30th anniversary. During its short history, Dongseo has been growing very quickly, particularly in specializations like film & video, design, IT, digital content, media communication and international studies. Our excellence in these fields is evidenced through largescale national funding projects and awards in prestigious national and international competitions.

Recently, we launched DSU's International College (IC), where all majors are offered in English. This allows international students access to education in many of our core areas of specialization. The IC also provides international students with outstanding academic guidance and support services.

Based on DSU's top quality education taught by leading experts with access to advanced facilities, students from around the world are choosing Dongseo University. We look forward to welcoming young talents to our diverse international community and helping them succeed at each step along their academic journey.

## FOUNDING STORY

Dr. Sung Man Chang (also known as "Min Seok") established the Dongseo Educational Foundation in 1965 to provide higher education under the spirit of Christianity. Since then, the Foundation has given rise to three different institutions of higher education: Kyoungnam College of Information and Technology (KIT) in 1965, Dongseo University (DSU) in 1992, and Busan Digital University (BDU) in 2002. Together these three institutions – KIT, DSU and BDU – educate around 20,000 students annually and employ over 1,000 professors and staff.

Since its establishment, Dongseo University has grown rapidly based on the three strategies of specialization, informatization and internationalization. These strategies have provided leverage for DSU to become a globally innovative future university. The campus, which was a barren hillside in 1992, has become a renowned 21st century global campus.

In its first year, Dongseo accepted 400 students to 8 majors. At the time, DSU operated under the name Dongseo College of Technology. One year later, in 1993, the name was changed to Dongseo University of Technology, and in 1995, while Founder Dr. Sung Man Chang was serving as its third president, the school assumed the current name of Dongseo University.

In 1999, Dr. Dong Soon Park became DSU' fourth president. Dr. Park served three consecutive terms as president prior to her appointment as Chancellor of the Dongseo Educational Foundation, in which role she continues to serve.

Dr. Jekuk Chang was appointed president of Dongseo University in 2011 and continues to serve in this role. In 2017, Dr. Chang announced the vision of a 'Future University', and since then DSU has been transforming itself by implementing a ten-part plan to strengthen its educational capacities in four core areas: future orientation, creativity enhancement, internationalization, and academic specialization.



### Cutting-edge, fusion curriculum design

#### 21st century university

Dongseo provides convergence education that merges academic disciplines and links academia with industry to prepare graduates for 4th industrial revolution. DSU's educational approach involves developing and sharing outstanding contents. Examples include virtual reality (VR)-based content production (Software + Media Communication + Design) and collaborations through GAA (Global Access Asia), the online courseware platform connecting AUPF partner institutions.

### Future-oriented classes

#### Project-based and innovative education

The innovative education paradigm of DSU breaks away from simple knowledge transfer and repetition in examinations. Blended learning like O2O (On-line to Off-line), project-based education, and In-school Field Studies (IFS) are incorporated into university curricula.

### Coursera for Campus

Dongseo University offers unlimited access to educational contents on Coursera.

By partnering with Coursera, Dongseo enhances its rapid technology infrastructure development and makes world-class contents created by top institutions available to its students. This partnership gives Dongseo students free access to the entire catalogue of educational contents on the Coursera platform, allowing them to earn certificates and upgrade their professional skills.

Dongseo also operates various associated support programs to encourage active participation and successful course completion.

Traditional learning methods are replaced at DSU with innovative alternatives. Rather than testing students' ability to retain information, DSU focuses on the ability to combine and apply concepts for creating value.

### Talent Development Center

#### Discovering the hidden "N% Talent"

Dongseo University operates the Talent Development Center to maximize the hidden potential of each student. In particular, the center has implemented a diverse and differentiated program that ensures no student gives up or gets left behind in their education. Students receive access to 24-hour creative spaces on campus, where they can unleash their imaginations, along with start-up support to promote entrepreneurship.

### Creativity-enhancing education

#### Developing future human resources

As a result, Dongseo University provides education aimed at developing students' abilities to imagine, create, test, and commercialize their ideas. One example is that regardless of major, all first-year students take courses to awaken their creativity and realize their visions. ## Globalized Campuses

**Roughly 1,200 international students**  
Dongseo University's local campuses are truly global environments where about 1,200 international students from 70 countries all around the world study together. Many of DSU's international students take English-based degree programs overseen by the International College, and DSU runs 2+2 joint degree programs with leading universities in China, Lithuania, Malaysia, Indonesia, Vietnam.

## Branch Campuses

**US, China, and Japan**  
Dongseo was the first university in Korea to have campuses in Fullerton, California, and Wuhan, Hubei Province, China. Every year, Dongseo sends 200 students abroad through its SAP-USA and SAP-China programs. While abroad, the students study their majors and take intensive foreign-language courses. Additionally, they enjoy a wide range of cultural experiences. In 2017, SAP-Japan was established, and DSU currently has 60 students studying at the Fukuoka campus of Japan University of Economics.

## SAP-Global

Dongseo University operates Global Capstone Design projects in 10 major cities. The SAP-Global program provides opportunities for students

to conduct capstone design projects abroad in major cosmopolitan cities. The projects are based on fusion education combining academic research with industry best practices. Participating students spend one semester overseas studying and gaining experience through industry collaborations.

Cities included: U.S. - Los Angeles, San Antonio; China - Beijing, Shanghai; Japan - Tokyo, Fukuoka; Finland - Oulu; Lithuania - Vilnius; Vietnam - Hanoi; Indonesia - Surabaya

## Asia-focused Education

**Top economic region in the 21st century**  
Asia is at the center of the 21st century global economy. Since 2012, Dongseo University has successfully operated the 'CAMPUS Asia' program initially launched by national leaders in Korea, China and Japan. In 2017, Dongseo established its East Asia Department to run this program and conduct research on regional issues. Other popular Asia-focused programs at DSU include the Asia Summer Program and the Dongseo Asia Initiatives Program.

Dongseo sends roughly 1,000 students abroad each year and provides them with support for numerous international programs. Additionally, about 1,200 international students are studying at Dongseo's local campuses in Korea.

## SPECIALIZED UNIVERSITY

Pursuing continuous change and innovation through specialized education

### Culture Contents

**Hub for culture and arts**  
Dongseo University promotes culture and arts. Its Digital Contents Division, Im Kwon Taek College of Film & Arts, and Media Communication Department are leaders in the development of technology for preserving and producing cultural contents. DSU's focus on creative convergence contents contributes to the flourishing of Korean cultural contents in an era of culture and arts globalization.

### Advanced Engineering Education

**ICT specialization**  
With strong governmental support, Dongseo has become an ICT-specialized university studying advanced technologies including Internet of Things (IoT), Artificial Intelligence (AI), Drone robotics, 3D printing, and Virtual/Augmented Reality (VR/AR). DSU nurtures talented students with international competitiveness through global industry-academic cooperation programs such as overseas field training and internships.

### Cradle for Film and New Media Start-ups

**Start-up center for future CEOs**  
Dongseo supports the creative ideas of entrepreneurial students at its Centum Campus to help them head leading businesses of the future. In particular, Centum Campus has established itself as a control tower for student start-ups connected with advanced ICT convergence and the video content industry thriving in the Centum area.



Dongseo University has long emphasized specialization as a core strategy for strengthening competitiveness. The university's colleges of Global Business, Software Convergence, Science and Engineering, and the Im Kwon Taek College of Film & Arts are all realizing this aim and raising their educational value.

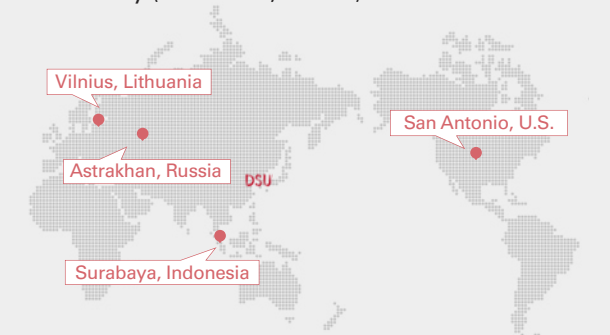

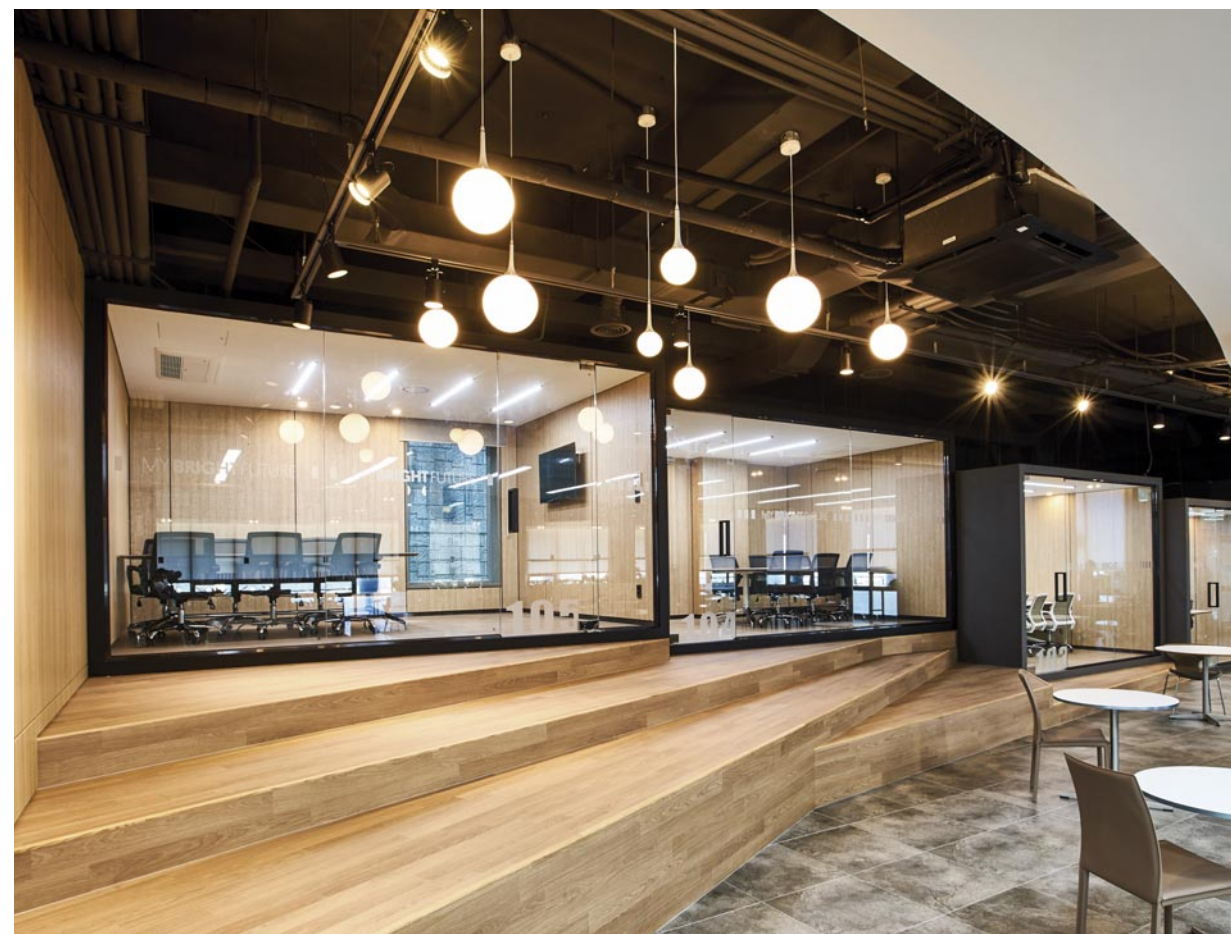


## Language & Literature Hall / International Cooperation Hall

These two buildings house the departments of foreign languages and graduate schools. On the first floor of International Cooperation Hall is the Student Counseling Center, where students can receive counseling and consult about their career prospects.

## Minseok Library

The main library at Dongseo University has a large collection of academic books and multimedia facilities as well as an IT Zone consisting of a PC area, printing/scanning area, U-Zone with UCC and A/V rooms, and Multiplex with a 200-inch full HD screen.



## Student Plaza

As its name suggests, the Student Plaza is ultimately a place for students. On the roof is an artificial-turf soccer field and running tracks. Inside are restaurants and shops along with about 60 club meeting rooms, the Office of the Student Union, and the Office of Student Affairs.



## Minseok Sports Center

The sports center has a full-sized gym and exercise facilities for squash, tennis, badminton, golf, and fencing. It is available throughout the year for local residents and Dongseo students.

## University Chapel

Dongseo students can pray and join services in the on-campus chapel whenever they want. The university chapel offers a space for shelter and hope.





### Design Hall

Design is a core specialization and DSU is currently implementing its 2nd stage of Design Internationalization. All design-related education is offered in the Design Hall, which has state-of-the-art facilities. This supports creative designers who will contribute to the industrial, fashion, environmental, exhibition, and visual design fields.

### International College Building

The International College Building has a modern design library and is home to the International College, which oversees English-based degree programs and provides services to help international students adjust to studying abroad and campus life.



### New Millennium Building

New Millennium Building has cutting-edge classrooms for online lectures and international distance video lectures. It is also home to the Regional Technology Innovation Center, Dongseo Media Outlet and Dongseo Media Center with a studio, sound effects room, and editing rooms.



### International House I, II

International House I and II are on-campus dormitories for international students studying at Dongseo University. They can accommodate more than 500 students in double occupancy, providing a comfortable living space.



### Global Village

Global Village is an accommodation and cultural complex. Global House has double-occupancy dormitories with room for over one thousand students. The main complex has classrooms and recreation facilities including a swimming pool, gym and sauna. Global Village consists of two buildings with 13 floors plus 6 basement levels.



### Centum City Campus in Haeundae

The Dongseo Centum Campus is specialized in Film & Video and Culture & Tourism. It is home to the Im Kwon Taek College of Film and Arts, the Im Kwon Taek Museum, and DSU's Tourism Division. Benefiting from its location in Busan with the highest concentration of visual contents institutions such as the Busan Cinema Center, Korean Film Council and Busan Film Commission, Centum Campus has also become a start-up center for entrepreneurial students and future CEOs in ICT convergence fields.

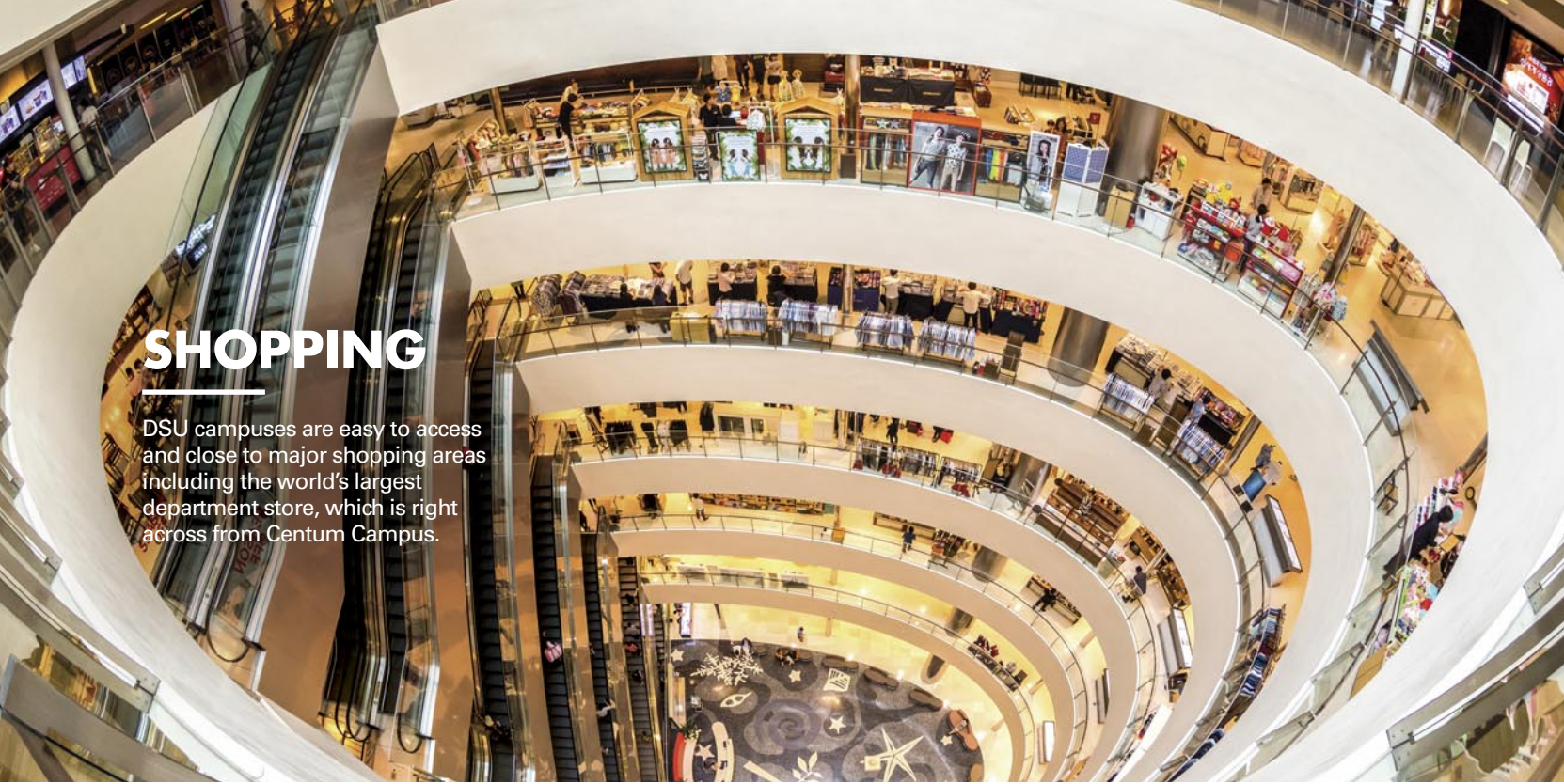




# LIFE IN BUSAN ME TROPOLITAN CITY

DSU campuses are easy to access and close to major shopping areas including the world's largest department store, which is right across from Centum Campus.



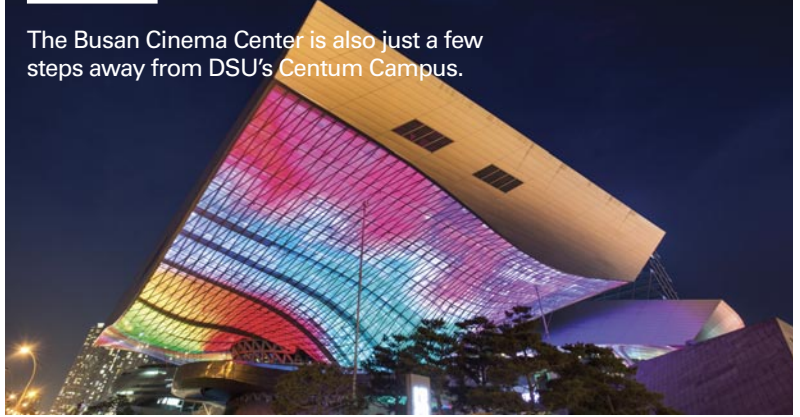
## EXCITEMENT & RELAXATION

Dongseo's International College offers English-based education in the fields of Business Administration, International Studies, Computer Engineering, Film & Video, Animation & VFX, VFX & Film, Game, Design, and Liberal Education. International students who are not proficient in Korean can thus increase their global potential by earning an undergraduate degree abroad at DSU in one of the university's specialized fields. The curricula of International College are designed to prepare international graduates for entering today's competitive global workforce.

The dedicated faculty and staff of International College help international students in many ways, such as in adjusting comfortably to life on campus, excelling academically, setting definite goals and planning to achieve them. International College also serves as the central coordinator and promoter of diverse extracurricular activities that enrich international students' socialization with Korean students at Dongseo University.

In addition to English-based degree programs, International College oversees the Korean Language & Business Program and the Korean Language Program. It also offers a credit program that enables students to earn transferable academic credits by taking major, liberal education, or Korean or English language courses, all of which are taught by expert faculty.

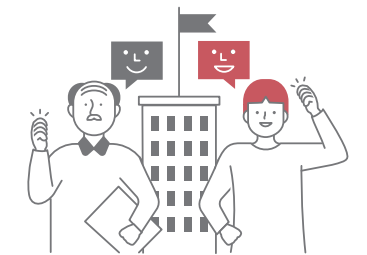

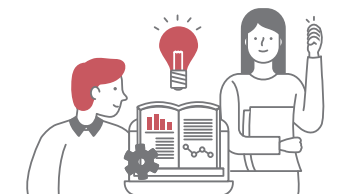

# GLOBAL BUSINESS COLLEGE

The Global Business College encourages students to take a broad perspective and engage on the world stage. It provides knowledge of fundamental theories along with practical job training to develop graduates capable of succeeding in the global market. Its innovative curricula and active collaboration with overseas partner universities help foster creative human resources for business and foreign language related fields.

## Division of Global Business Administration

The Division of Business Administration produces managerial experts and entrepreneurs. An example of its innovative approach to offering students practical training is the VOICE program, in which the division works closely with companies to set up virtual offices at the university. Students complete projects suggested by company representatives and this type of virtual on-the-job training prepares them to meet actual workplace expectations. In addition to teaching the skills needed to become a business leader, the Division of Global Business Administration also provides knowledgeable support for young entrepreneurs. (Business Administration Major, Accounting and Taxation Major)

## Department of International Trade and Business

This department investigates foreign marketing, trade, management of foreign exchange, and standards of international commercial transactions. The department aims to develop global trade experts who can actively respond to global changes.

## Department of International Logistics

International Logistics is a five-track education system designed to produce leaders for an era of high global logistics competition. It covers important aspects of harbor and aviation distribution, business administration, and practical trade.

## Department of English

English is now the common language of a globalized and informationalized era. This makes its importance greater than ever. The English Department focuses on providing students with the proficiencies needed to communicate successfully in international environments. Students in the department can take advantage of various international exchange programs and cultural experiences. For example, DSU sends 100 students annually to its branch campus in California, USA.



## Department of Japanese

Through practical courses focusing on actual language use, students gain fluency in Japanese and come to understand the culture of Japan. Students also broaden their academic views as they learn about various aspects of Japan studies. Students studying Japanese at DSU may also have a chance to study abroad through Dongseo University's agreements with many partner institutions in Japan.

## Department of Chinese

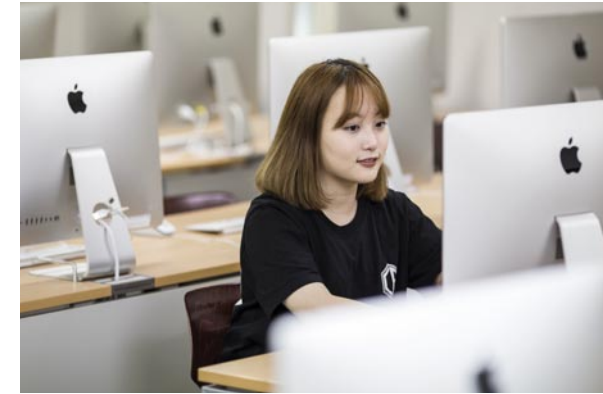

## Department of Software

Societies everywhere are becoming more focused on software. This department produces graduates with the skills needed to lead in a software-focused society. Specifically, graduates learn to develop new technologies for the fourth industrial revolution, including ones involving artificial intelligence, big data, robots, self-driving vehicles, etc.

## Department of Information Security

To nurture actual security leaders in the cyber world, the Department of Information Security focuses on "practical information security." Its curriculum offers various opportunities to gain working-level experience through collaboration with security companies like AhnLab Inc. and government institutions like the cyber-crime investigation team at Busan Metropolitan Police Agency.

## Department of Information and Communication Engineering

The department fosters talents to play key roles in a Hyper Connected Society. It teaches theories of information communication and technology covering aspects such as the processing of signals from IoT devices by sensors and artificial intelligence as well as the creation of new IT convergence services. This enables students to lead in the era of the fourth industrial revolution based on a new paradigm of future society.



## Department of Computer Engineering

The Department of Computer Engineering combines aspects of each track within its division to provide students with a solid and well-rounded foundation in computer engineering.

## Department of Game Technology

The Game Technology Department produces creative talents who are strong in the areas of programming, graphics, and design. It trains students to become contents production professionals in the fields of virtual reality, augmented reality and game using state-of-the-art facilities and equipment. The department also collaborates with industries using game engines to foster flexible and creative convergence understanding.

## Department of Visual Animation

Department of Visual Animation produces excellent artists in the fields of 2D & 3D animation and digital imaging. It offers courses on storyboard, layout, character production, animation, visual effects and editing in a state-of-the-art educational environment. This environment includes capabilities for viewing special DSU classes taught by Hollywood artists, an education center with about 1,400 stored video lectures, VR/AR equipment, and labs with over 300 personal computers.

# SCIENCE AND ENGINEERING COLLEGE

The Science and Engineering College produces broad-minded science and engineering experts. In addition to developing engineering talents, it offers training in practical English, opportunities for academy-industry cooperation and overseas student exchanges, and education in the humanities. It intends to foster experts in the specialized fields through advanced and fusional education depending on students' dream and capability.

## Department of Applied Electronics Engineering

The Department of Applied Electronics Engineering provides education on the essential technologies of electricity and electronics, which are used to design and produce artificial intelligence, semiconductors, displays, IoT, smart factories, self-driving cars, creative robots, autonomous drones, and smart mobility devices. It uses project-based experiments and a product-based education system to foster technology leaders.

## Department of Mechatronics Engineering

The Department of Mechatronics Engineering has developed a unique Self Development Curriculum that integrates various aspects of advanced engineering. Its track-based education system allows students to have greater control over their educational path based on their own individual interests and abilities. In addition, the department constantly updates its career tracks to reflect changes within related industries so that students have access to the most cutting-edge technologies.

## Department of Architectural Engineering

The Department of Architectural Engineering teaches how to create practical, usable, and artistic spaces that harmonize an environment. Focus is given to the use of new materials, automated equipment, and computing techniques. Major studies include aspects of architectural planning and the design of structures, interior and exterior decorations, material ingredients, and construction work. Students also learn about the architectural characteristics of formative arts to improve their creativity and design capabilities.



## Department of Civil and Environmental Engineering

The Department of Civil and Environmental Engineering focuses on the four fields of structural engineering, geotechnical engineering, hydraulic engineering, and construction and measurement. It produces graduates with visions for the future who can implement those visions based on technological abilities appropriate for the global and information-oriented infrastructure construction environment of the 21st century.

The Department of Civil Engineering researches how to make natural environments more user-friendly and comfortable. The department focuses on structural engineering, solidification engineering, hydraulic engineering, construction work and surveying. Emphasis is placed on cultivating talented people who have a vision for the future. To this end, the department teaches techniques needed for infrastructure development within the 21st century's global and information-oriented era.

## Department of Architecture (5-year accredited curriculum)

Architecture combines the arts and technology. It is a study of humanities and social sciences. The Department of Architectural Design seeks to cultivate students' capacity for creative thinking and start them along the path toward becoming talented professional architects.

## Department of Advanced Materials and Chemical Engineering

New materials are used in many industries, such as those for medical supplies, energy, petrochemical and oil refining, synthetic fibers, macromolecules, semiconductors, etc. The Department of Advanced Materials and Chemical Engineering produces professionals who have abilities for business administration and for conducting research and development on the design, measurement, and fabrication of elements required for industrial processes.



## Department of Bio-Chemical Engineering

The Department of Bio-Chemical Engineering studies biological phenomena at the convergence of the latest biotechnological theories. These relate to medical treatments, new medicines, and environmental features essential for human life and welfare. They also involve high-tech biomaterials, nanotechnology, and biopharmaceutical technology. The department teaches theory and practice to foster global talents who will lead the 21st century. It also offers student exchanges, internships and opportunities for collaboration with universities in Germany.

## Department of Food and Nutrition

The Department of Food and Nutrition teaches the latest scientific theories, research methods, and knowledge applications. It provides students with practical understanding in the areas of food, nutrition and meal provision to enjoy a healthy life based on reasonable dietary choices. The department produces food and nutrition experts who will take responsibility for educating modern society about how to have a delicious and healthy dietary life.

# COLLEGE OF DESIGN

The College of Design at Dongseo University comprises the Division of Design and the Department of Fashion Design. In the Division of Design, students follow an integrated education system involving eight Fusion Design Routes. This enables students to select a route that is best suited to their own interests and abilities. The curriculum merges specialized design courses with courses in other fields such as Business Administration, Film, Digital Contents, Architecture, and Computer Engineering. In the Department of Fashion Design, students learn to create, produce and market their designs. The department's curriculum provides fusion education combining artistry, creativity, design skills, and market planning abilities.

## Division of Design

### Graphic Design Route

The Graphic Design Route produces versatile designers capable of creating concepts for expressing ideas in various graphic design media formats, including posters, advertisements, packaging, illustrations, etc. This route also fosters competitive intelligence (CI) and business intelligence (BI).

### Advertising Design Route

The Advertising Design Route trains designers to combine the well-balanced planning, creation and production of advertisements. It produces highly competent advertising design experts.

### Digital Media Design Route

The Digital Media Design Route combines the latest technology and design issues of advanced digital media to nurture top designers of user interfaces, motion graphics, information designs, and image designs.

### Art and Design Route

The Art and Design Route produces art-oriented designers to lead modern design trends through visual communication arts & design education expanded and integrated by the convergence of visual design and visual art fields.

### Product Design Route

The Product Design Route trains designers with innovative and creative abilities. It fosters students wishing to manage design firms or start their own design business through value innovation and new product designs.

### Environmental Design Route

The Environmental Design Route examines and analyzes various spaces including indoor spaces, exhibition spaces, and urban environments. It produces space designers who will improve quality of life based on understanding space users' needs and preferences.

## Department of Fashion Design

The Department of Fashion Design has a separate curriculum from the Division of Design. Its curriculum nurtures students' abilities to create unique fashion designs and market them effectively at local and global levels. The curriculum also provides fusion education with the aim of training talented global fashion professionals.

ACADEMICS



# IM KWON TAEK COLLEGE OF FILM & ARTS

The Im Kwon Taek College of Film & Arts was established in 2007 under the guidance of the master director for whom it is named. In 2011, the college relocated to DSU's Centum Campus, which has cutting-edge facilities and is located at the center of Busan's film and media district. The college comprises its three original departments as well as the Division of Digital Contents, which joined the college in 2014.



## Department of Film & Video

The Film & Video Department offers one of the best education systems in Korea. The curriculum was designed with assistance from master director Im Kwon Taek and reflects his pioneering spirit for filmmaking. Students in the department develop sense of what it means to be human and incorporate this into their own films. As part of Dongseo's Global Studies Institute, the department also offers the option of earning a degree through courses taught entirely in English.

## Department of Theatre and Film Acting

The Department of Theatre & Film Acting trains students to act in films, theatre productions or on television. The department offers education focused on developing practical skills. Classes are often closely

linked with the Film & Video Department, and many opportunities for field training exist. Students also receive one-on-one training with their advising professor, which prepares them to advance into fields such as directing, planning, stage lighting, sound, stage design, makeup, etc.

## Department of Musical Productions

Students in the Department of Musical Production receive well-structured education that focuses on practical training. The curriculum not only allows students to become musical actors, directors, and planners, but also professionals in stage lighting, sound, makeup, stage technology, and musical education.

# MINSEOK LIBERAL ARTS COLLEGE

The Minseok Liberal Arts College was established in 2017 to enhance Liberal Arts education at Dongseo University based on an increasing demand for students who can see connections between diverse fields and use their broad understanding to create new high-value-added items. The Minseok Liberal Arts College fosters students' creativity and expands their academic perspectives. In this way, it produces human resources who possess not only knowledge of their major but also knowledge of other fields within Liberal Arts. Through the college, Dongseo University also collaborates with Kyungsoo University based on an agreement for academic cooperation. Many courses offered by the Minseok Liberal Arts College are taught entirely in English and may be taken as electives counting toward degree requirements.

Note : The Minseok Liberal Arts College does not admit students directly, though students may apply for a double major in Liberal Arts after being admitted to another academic department of Dongseo University.

## Department of ICT Convergence Engineering

### **Mechatronics Engineering Track**

Offers core academic education for the fourth industrial revolution involving convergence of machines, electricity and electronics, and control technologies.

### **Software Convergence Track**

Produces software development experts for automatic control of smart devices and systems.

## Department of Social Security

### **Police Track**

Trains individuals who have theoretical and practical backgrounds based on their major to be (maritime) police officers.

### **Detective Track**

Produces detectives for social safety and enterprise security involving the protection of industrial technology.

## Department of Social Welfare Consulting

### **Social Welfare Field**

Produces social welfare experts specializing in social welfare services, counseling, and welfare administration; also offers practice-focused training applicable for founding social welfare facilities.

### **Life Planning and Asset Management Field**

Provides education on life planning, start-ups and asset management for a stable life after retirement.

## Department of Senior Exercise Prescription

### **Exercise Prescription Therapist Course**

Produces exercise prescription therapists specialized in preventing and treating chronic diseases based on understanding of the mental and physical characteristics of senior citizens.

### **Exercise Instructor Course**

Fosters practical talents who are specialized in prevention and treatment of musculoskeletal injuries in everyday life, combining sports medicine and exercise rehabilitation.



# DIVISION OF MEDIA COMMUNICATION

The Division of Media Communication has the best facilities and faculty in the region for cultivating talented young individuals interested in pioneering a rapidly changing media environment. Recent upgrades include the multi-story Dongseo Media Outlet, which has professional quality production capabilities along with a café and work spaces for collaboration with local broadcasting companies.

## Department of Broadcasting and Media

The Department of Broadcasting and Media provides students with the theoretical and practical skills expected by professional broadcasting companies. The department is equipped with professional-quality facilities to prepare students to work with new media technologies such as Full HD and UHD. The Department of Digital Broadcasting also operates its own high-quality studio offering students the chance to work as on aspects of production in a real-world recording environment.

## Department of Advertising and Public Relations

In the new media era, educational goals must match real world demands. The new media environment will be led by public relations experts, and the Department of Advertising & PR produces experts in mass communication, imagery, and public relations. Through the Dongseo Media Center and Dongseo Media Outlet, the department provides students with practical experience using state-of-the-art imagery and public information facilities.



# DIVISION OF SOCIAL WELFARE

The Division of Social Welfare cultivates expertise on the basis of understanding the individual, the family, and the society. It is helping to promote a harmonious and beautiful society emphasizing the value of human life and social justice. Social welfare is a growing field as a result of demographics and economic development, and the Division of Social Welfare produces highly trained professionals that are sure to be in high demand.

## Department of Social Welfare

Students in the Major of Social Welfare learn to analyze social welfare policies and programs based on the scientific diagnosis of human needs. The primary goal of the department is to develop experts in areas involving social welfare, regional social work, social welfare civil offices, mental health, medical treatment, social work for schools, and care of the elderly, children and families.

## Department of Adolescent Counselling Psychology

The Major of Adolescent Counseling Psychology develops skilled and compassionate individuals trained to address issues affecting youths and teenagers. Graduates often choose to work in environments where they can make a difference through one-to-one or small group counseling sessions or through various types of educational programs. The Department of Adolescent Counseling Psychology provides an excellent way to beneficially influence the lives of others and of having a positive impact on one's community.



# DIVISION OF TOURISM

Increases in per capita incomes have greatly boosted demand for travel, and the Division of Tourism opens new doors toward working in some of the 21st century's most profitable and exciting industries like tourism and convention planning. With globalized and diversified educational programs, the Division of Tourism produces experts able to impress travelers with innovative services.

## Department of Hotel Management

The Major of Hotel Management produces talented experts in the hotel and food-service industry. Students acquire the knowledge and skills needed for working in this field through the department's globalized and differentiated education curriculum.

## Department of Event and Convention

Events and conventions are among the most highly-valued areas within the field of tourism. Indeed, Korea has begun to focus on these areas as one of its strategic industries. This department produces experts in all operational aspects of events and conventions.

## Department of Tourism Management

The Major of Tourism Management develops tourism experts. To this end, the major has created an education system partly based on collaborations with well-known tourism companies. This academic-industrial cooperation program offers students the chance to develop adjustment capacities through practical field training.



# DIVISION OF BIOHEALTH SCIENCE

Technological advancements have made people healthier today than at any time in the past. The Division of Biohealth Science strives to continue supporting a healthy society by instilling students with a professional spirit and a sense of duty toward respecting human life. It also teaches students advanced health care techniques to help them make patient procedures as easy and painless as possible.

## Department of Health Administration

The Department of Health Administration produces experts who can contribute toward the developments of medical health in Korea. Its curriculum focuses on developing health administrators who can effectively manage increasingly information-oriented medical environments. The department fosters individuals able to increase the health of citizens. Emphasis is placed on basic theories required for administration, organization, and management of health facilities. These include finance, health insurance, and practices at medical sites.

## Department of Dental Sanitary Science

The Department of Dental Sanitary Science produces dental hygiene experts who have the knowledge and practical experience needed for the prevention of oral diseases. This department emphasizes English education and practical on-sight training.

## Department of Radiology

The Department of Radiology teaches students to provide information for cancer treatment and other diseases. Students complete their basic studies in diagnosis, radiation treatment and nuclear cardiology. Other courses focus on imagery information as well as managing and maintaining equipment.

## Department of Occupational Therapy

The Department of Occupational Therapy promotes health by enabling people to perform meaningful and purposeful activities. Furthermore, occupational therapists are becoming increasingly involved in addressing the impact of social, political and environmental factors that contribute to exclusion and occupational deprivation.

## Department of Biomedical Laboratory Science

The Department of Biomedical Laboratory Science focuses on diagnoses for detecting diseases and medical treatments for their cure. Clinical inspections use chemical and microbiological blood tests as well as immunological and elemental genetic techniques developed through the life sciences. Use of up-to-date, practical science is emphasized. The department provides instruction in life science, chemistry and medical science. Graduates can become clinical pathologists, researchers, or graduate students pursuing further studies. Other options include entering medical institutions in Korea or in foreign countries.

## Department of Nursing Science

The Department of Nursing Science produces nurses with a Christian spirit. To develop expert nurses who can become leaders in health and medical fields around the world, the department teaches the abilities of critical communication, use of technology, and problem solving.



# DIVISION OF SPORTS SCIENCE



The Division of Sports Science fosters experts with pertinent scientific knowledge for promoting healthy lifestyles. Students acquire the skills needed to work as personal trainers for professional athletes, physiotherapists able to help patients recover from physical injuries, or security professionals protecting clients.

## Department of Physical Education

The Department of Physical Education trains students to be professional sports instructors with an awareness of fair play and an ability to take into account the situations of athletes. In this age of sport, creative rather conventional instructors are needed. To foster such professionals, the department offers instruction on many practical subjects like swimming, personal fitness, skiing, etc. It also teaches theoretical aspects of exercise physiology and prescription, sports psychology, sports sociology, etc.

## Department of Exercise Prescription

Students in this department learn about the prevention, treatment, and rehabilitation for metabolic diseases caused by a lack of exercise and for injuries that occur during sport activities. Students also learn about developing customized exercise programs, and they have the opportunity to become professionals involved in the prevention and treatment of sports damage and adult diseases.

# DEPARTMENT OF EAST ASIAN STUDIES



East Asia was among the earliest cradles of civilization. Today, it is a vibrant region experiencing rapid economic development and offering exciting opportunities to those with knowledge of its languages, cultures, and potential for international cooperation.

'East Asian Studies' was established to foster leaders who have a deep understanding of humanities and the languages of East Asia. Students in the department learn to analyze and seek solutions for issues affecting the region. Also, through programs such as CAMPUS Asia, students may have the chance to study extensively abroad. This unique four-year program involves three phases: one year of preparatory study at DSU's main campus, two years in a "mobile campus" rotating between partner universities in China and Japan, and a final year of graduation preparation at DSU.

# DEPARTMENT OF INTERNATIONAL STUDIES



As the pace of globalization increases so does the need for individuals with the knowledge and skills required to advise on international policies and to do business at an international level. The DIS provides a foundation for success that enhances the diverse career options available to its graduates.

The Department of International Studies, which was established in 2008 as the first English-only department of its kind in the Busan area, prepares students to become global leaders through an American-style interdisciplinary program that combines political science, economics, sociology and international relations. With its small class sizes, North American professors and student body comprised of young people from various countries, the DIS aims also to develop negotiation skills, research and problem-solving techniques, cultural agility, and proficiency in written and spoken English. Graduates of the DIS have gone on to well-known graduate schools as well as to jobs in the private and public sector around the world.

# DEPARTMENT OF POLICE ADMINISTRATION

Police maintain social order by serving to protect and assist the citizens in their communities. Fulfilling the administrative functions associated with this task requires specialized training and appropriate dispositions. The Department of Police Administration at DSU prepares graduates to take on critical social responsibilities.

New forms of crime are causing harm within modern societies. The Department of Police Administration produces talented people who have a sense of duty in maintaining public peace and keeping the lives of citizens stable. It accomplishes this by training students to deal effectively with common and emerging forms of criminal behavior.



# KOREAN LANGUAGE PROGRAM

The Institute of Foreign Language Education (IFLE) at Dongseo University is a leading educational institute offering Korean language education and cultural experiences to international students, exchange students and foreign instructors. Through its six-level program, students can find the class best suited to their own current abilities. Class sizes are kept to fewer than 15 students to encourage active participation. The IFLE is especially helpful in assisting international students adapt quickly to Korean culture and campus life at Dongseo University.

The IFLE has excellently trained language instructors and well-equipped lecture rooms. Also, there are various auditory materials and multimedia facilities available for practicing listening, recording stories and analyzing pronunciation.

# ADMISSION PROCEDURE

Dongseo University welcomes international applicants to its undergraduate, graduate, and Korean language programs. Students wishing to apply to undergraduate programs at Dongseo University should follow the steps outlined in the admissions procedure below and visit DSU's English website to download the required application forms.

## 01. ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for admission as an international student at Dongseo University, students must meet the following criteria.

### FRESHMEN

- 1) The applicant and both of his/her parents must be citizens of a country other than Korea.
- 2) The applicant must meet the minimum language requirements.
  - For Korean-based programs, the applicant must pass TOPIK Level 3.
  - For English-based programs, the applicant must obtain a score of TOEFL 530 (CBT 197, iBT 71), IELTS 5.5, CEFR B2 or TEPS 600 (new TEPS 327).
- 3) The applicant must also have graduated from a high school inside or outside Korea.

### TRANSFER STUDENTS

- 1) Same as condition (1) outlined for freshmen above.
- 2) Same as condition (2) outlined for freshmen above.
- 3) A sophomore transfer applicant must also have either
  - completed (or be expected to complete) at least 1 year (2 regular semesters) and earned at least 25% of the credits required to complete a bachelor degree at a university inside or outside Korea; or,
  - graduated (or be expected to graduate) from a 2-year or 3-year college inside or outside Korea.
- 4) A junior transfer applicant must also have either
  - completed (or be expected to complete) at least 2 years (4 regular semesters) and earned (or be expected to earn) at least 50% of the credits required to complete a bachelor degree at a university inside or outside Korea; or,
  - graduated (or be expected to graduate) from a 2-year or 3-year college inside or outside Korea.

  - For Korean programs: TOPIK Level 3 or above
  - For English programs: TOEFL 530 (CBT 197, iBT 71), IELTS 5.5 and TEPS 600 (new TEPS 327) or above
  - The proof of language proficiency must be valid until the final date of the application period
- 14) Application fee: ₩60,000 KRW
- 15) Official authorization for inquiry into enrollment and academic credit and personal information collection and usage agreement

### NOTE

- Documents 7, 8 and 10 must be translated and notarized if the original document is not in Korean or English.
- Transcripts and diplomas issued by non-Korean academic institutions must be verified and certified by the Korean embassy where the institution is located. If the institution is located in a member state of Apostille, the Apostille verification must be attached.
- Application documents, including transcripts, certificates and test results, will not be returned.
