1 Information about the Dongduk Women's University



About Dongduk Educational Foundation

Dongduk Academy was founded by Dr. Chungang Cho Dong Sik. realized that the country needed education to save itself when Japan was invading. Dr. Chungang Cho Dong-sik understood that the most important way to improve the country's situation was to educate women. He founded the Dongduk Women's Home in April 1908. In April 1910, He merged it with the Dongduk Women's Home and changed its name to Dongduk. He dedicated his life to developing Dongduk and educating women in Korea.

Dongduk academic institutions consist of Dongduk Kindergarten, Sungdeok Middle School, Dongduk Girls Middle School, Dongduk Girls High School, and Dongduk Women's University.

About Dongduk Women's University

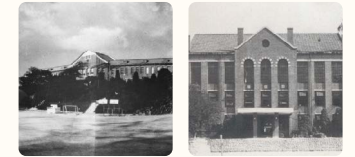
In 1948, the first steps towards creating Dongduk Women's College were taken when Dr. Chungang Cho Dong-sik gave the foundation forest land. After getting ready for a long time, Dongduk Women's College finally opened on May 27, 1950. At first, it could only hold 150 students. In 1967, Dongduk Women's College moved to its current Wolgok-dong campus. This was an important moment in the college's growth. In March 1988, the university became a comprehensive university. In the mid-1990s, it strengthened its field-oriented education by opening the College of Design and Innovation in Cheongdam-dong, the College of Performing Arts in Daehak-ro, and the Dongduk Art Gallery in Insadong. By 2025, Dongduk Women's University had grown to include five graduate schools, 12 colleges, and 41 different areas of study.

College of Design Innovation

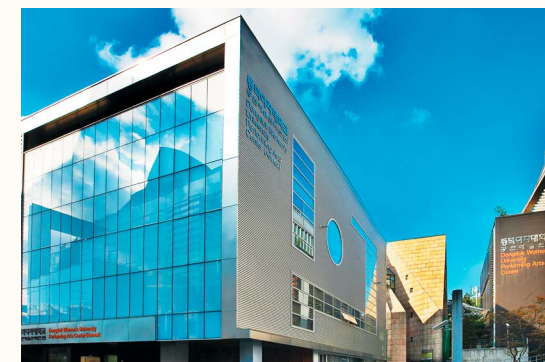
