- **Once submitted, the application cannot be modified or canceled.**
- For admitted applicants, admission may be canceled if the issuance of a visa for entry into Korea is denied.

Transfer	1. Both parents and the student are foreign nationals (excluding dual nationality) 2. [3rd Year Transfer] Completed (or expected to complete) at least 2nd year or more at a 4-year regular university, or graduated (or expected to graduate) from a 2-year college, in Korea or abroad.
