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

Eligibility Criteria

Nationality	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Applicants whose both parents are non-Korean nationals Applicants who completed their equivalent elementary, middle, and high school education outside Korea
Educational Background	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Freshman : High school graduate (or expected graduate) Transfer : Graduate (or expected graduate) of a 2- or 3-year college in Korea or abroad, or a student who has completed a certain number of semesters and credits at a 4-year university in Korea or abroad
Language Proficiency	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Holders of TOPIK (Test of Proficiency in Korean) Level 3 or higher Those who have completed Level 3 or higher of the regular Korean language course at CUP's Institute of International Education Applicants with equivalent Korean language proficiency recognized by CUP (e.g., successful completion of a Korean language interview conducted by CUP)
