Korean Language Course

SKLI is recognized as one of Korea's top Korean language education institutions. It is staffed by highly qualified instructors and offers a specialized curriculum using its own textbook series—the first of its kind in Busan, published in 2006 and now translated into multiple languages.

Designated by Korea's Ministry of Education as a Global Korea Scholarship (GKS) language training institution, SKLI offers a professional and immersive language education experience. It also serves as an official test center for the TOPIK exam since 2019, allowing students to conveniently take the test on campus.

To enrich language learning, SKLI runs a variety of programs including Korean culture experiences, student counseling, and peer support initiatives, helping students deeply understand both the language and culture of Korea.

Eligibility requirements(Undergraduate/Graduate/Korean Language Course)

* Undergraduate students must acquire over level 4 TOPIK or above by the end of Bachelor's course in order to graduate
3. TOPIK Level 2 holders among applicants for Korean language track (excluding Silla Global College and Global College of Engineering) are required to complete 300 hours of Korean language training during the first semester. (1,950,000 KRW for Korean language training for first semester)
4. Among the applicants for the English Track (BA K-Culture, Automotive & Mechanical Engineering, Hotel & Tourism MA Marketing Dept.), Exemption from submitting a certificate of accredited English examination for those from countries who use English as their first language or legal official language (list of countries using English as their first language or legal official language are limited to country information specified on the website of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs)
5.
