01 Qualification for Application

- Individuals with both parents and oneself being foreigners.
- Individuals who have graduated from the high school.

02 Admission Schedule

- Year-round Enrollment: Four admission periods each year: March (Spring), May (Summer), September (Fall), and November (Winter)

There is no age limit, but students who graduated high school can apply for the Korean language course.

※ Notes for Applicants

1. Materials received and Admission fees are non-refundable.
2. All details in the documents must be accurately provided. Any adverse consequences (such as disqualification) arising from errors, omissions, incomplete record files, or failure to submit required documents are the responsibility of the applicant.
3. Qualified applicants must pay tuition fees within the specified period; failure to do so will result in automatic disqualification.
4. To address any additional requirements or notifications during the admission period, applicants must be available for contact by the Office of International Affairs. Any losses incurred due to the inability to contact the applicant will be the responsibility of the applicant.
5. Applicants who do not participate in the actual exam and oral interview conducted by the admission unit will be excluded from the admission review.
6. The 'International Exchange Committee' of the university may choose not to accept applicants if it deems their academic abilities to be insufficient.
7. Matters not explicitly stated in this admission guide will be handled based on the principles applicable to foreign applicants at our school.
8. All students are required to join insurance which the university suggests.
