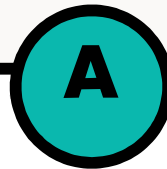

Where is Hanyang Cyber University located?

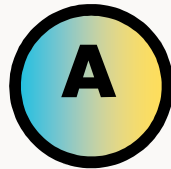


Hanyang Cyber University is located on the campus of Hanyang University.

(Address: 220 Wangsimni-ro, Seongdong-gu, Seoul, Republic of Korea)

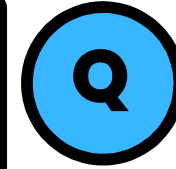


What is the difference between Hanyang University and Hanyang Cyber University?



While both universities are operated by the same educational foundation, Hanyang Foundation, there are key differences between them. Hanyang University is a four-year offline university officially accredited by the Korean Ministry of Education, whereas Hanyang Cyber University is a four-year online university, also accredited by the Ministry of Education, and operates as an independent institution. At Hanyang Cyber University, all classes and exams are conducted entirely online, so there is no need to attend campus in person. Students can study anytime and anywhere, offering great flexibility.

Can I receive the GKS scholarship?

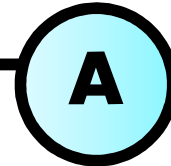
Online universities are not eligible institutions for the GKS
scholarship.

However, since there are no settlement costs in Korea,
students can conveniently earn a Korean graduate school
degree even while living abroad.

Additionally, international applicants are eligible for
scholarships of up to 30% for their first year, making it an even
more affordable and practical choice.



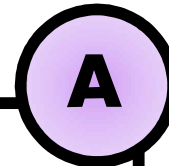
What majors are offered at

Does the graduate school hold seminars online?

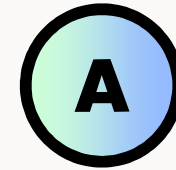


Both online and offline seminars are available.
For offline seminars, an online session is conducted
simultaneously for students who have difficulty
attending in person. The recorded version of the
seminar is also uploaded to the classroom so that
students can review the session later.



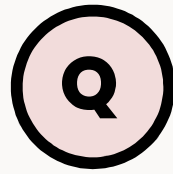
Are there any offline gatherings for international students?

What are the graduation requirements?



Common Requirements

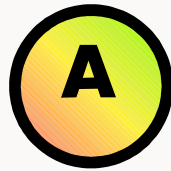
- Enrollment for four or more semesters
- Completion of 24 credits
- GPA of 3.0 or higher



Additional requirements such as a thesis, foreign language exam, or other conditions may apply depending on the department, so please check and fulfill those specific requirements accordingly.
