Attention for All Applicants

1. Attention for All Applicants

- (1) The person with multiple nationalities including the Korean nationality or the stateless person is not considered as a foreigner.
- (2) Only the curriculum of the regular school acknowledged by the education related laws of the corresponding country is acknowledged.
: The qualification exam for college entrance, home-schooling, and cyber-learning are not considered regular courses.
- (3) The eligibility is determined based on March. 3rd. (Tue.), 2026.

2. Application Materials

- ※ **The application must be completed and submitted in Korean** after refer to the provided application informative materials written in English and Chinese.
- (1) The original copy is required for all application materials. Under unavoidable circumstances, copies that are verified with the original by the issuing institute can be submitted; however, the original must be submitted after the registration of accepted applicants. All application materials will not be returned.
 - (2) Documents written in other languages than Korean or English must have a notarized translation (to Korean or English) attached.
 - (3) Accept only the application documents issued within 6 months of application date. Meanwhile, documents of academic records (ex. graduation certificate, transcript) issued by foreign institutions upon completion of school will be accepted.
 - (4) For high school period the applicant attended in Korea, the applicant shall submit the school records instead of the certificate of enrollment or the grade transcript.
 - (5) If the name of the applicant on the documents submitted is different, the applicant shall attach the verification of identity issued by the court of the corresponding country or the head of a government organization.
 - (6) The sponsor basically indicates the parents of the applicant. If the applicant's relative or the third party (the applicant's countryman or Korean only) becomes the sponsor, the document that proves the relationship with the applicant shall be submitted. (Illegal immigrant in the Republic of Korea is ineligible.)
 - (7) The contact information provided in the application form should be viable during the period of admission process. If changed, it needs to be reported immediately to the Office of Admissions, and the applicant is responsible for any disadvantages that arise from the loss of contact. (Provide the contact information inside Korea, if possible.)
 - (8) Accepted applicants who submitted the certification of expected graduation (completion) shall obtain 'Apostillization' or the "Certification of Overseas Institutions" or "Consul Confirmation" at a diplomatic office of the applicant's country and submit it to Office of International affairs (#303, Golden 50th Commemoration Hall) by March. 3rd. (Tue.), 2026. (For Chinese students, submit 'Verification of Academic Achievement' or 'Consul Confirmation' or 'Apostillization')
 - (9) Applicants who do not submit the required document and/or who is not qualified for application requirement will be rejected and the admission fee will not be refunded.

3. Additional Notes

- (1) Those who are considered to have insufficient scholastic ability for Seoul Women's University will not be admitted and most courses are offered in Korean.
- (2) Those who failed to submit application documents or submitted false documents or applicants who are illegal immigrants or have illegal immigrant parents are excluded from the application procedure.
- (3) If the information provided on the application materials is found false, if the applicant is found ineligible, or if the applicant was qualified-admitted in any other dishonest method, the admission can be cancelled even during the semester.
- (4) All students entering Seoul Women's University must complete the courses: Introduction to Christianity (2 credits), Pious Meeting (new admission: 6 semesters, transfer admission: 2 semesters) to establish wholesome sense of values and develop leader's qualities based on Christian spirit alongside the Bahrom Education which are based on community life as compulsory courses (Bahrom Education 2 and 3 for students transferring to undergraduate course).
- (5) Refer to the decision of Seoul Women's University Admission Application Management Committee for matters not specified in this handbook.

Attention for Accepted Applicants

1. Admissions results will not be notified individually, so applicants should check Admissions results on Seoul Women's University's website
2. Domestic address and contact information must be included on the application for admission and applicant is responsible for any disadvantages caused by unable to get in touch.
3. Do not lose the receipt for tuition payment. It needs to be presented to the Korean Consulate or Immigration Office to obtain the student visa (D-2).
4. The standard admission letter is issued to those who are accepted and registered. Do not lose the admission letter and it will not be reissued.
5. To apply for the student visa, the applicant shall apply for the visa at the Korean Consulate or Immigration Office by submitting the standard admission letter and other required documents.
6. The student who obtained the student visa (D-2) must immediately apply for alien registration at the Immigration Office in Seoul (for those who are outside after arriving in Korea).
7. Accepted student must submit a copy of student visa (D-2) and alien registration to International Affairs Office of Seoul Women's University.
8. Successful applicants must subscribe to National Health Insurance and Private Health Insurance is required if additional coverage is needed.
9. If the student is rejected in the visa process, the student shall prepare the following documents and apply at the Office of Admissions of Seoul Women's University for a refund of the registration fee. (If the student cannot visit in person, then the refund can be made to the applicant's parents or sponsor only)
 - 1 Statement of Withdrawal (Attached Form)
 - Receipts for tuition and fees (original)
 - 1 copy of bank account under the applicant's name (or the name of a parent or the sponsor on paper) and 1 copy of identification

2 | Eligibility

New Admission

- (1) Parents and applicants are all non-Koreans
- ◆ Before applicants begin a curriculum equivalent to a high school in Korea, both parents and applicant must have acquired foreign nationality.
 - ◆ Applicant must submit a document that proves the loss of nationality, if the applicant and their parents have given up(lost) Korean nationality.
 - ◆ In the case of absence due to reasons such as divorce or death of parents, documents issued by the government must be submitted to prove it.
 - ◆ Multiple nationality of the Republic of Korea and stateless applicants are not considered as foreigners.
- (2) The applicant who completed (is expected to complete) high school education inside or outside Korea
- ◆ Applicants who entered university(including college) are considered as a higher-level academic background and are given an application qualification after confirming the submitted educational background certificate documents.

3 | Application Method

New Admission

- (1) Applications are made by recruitment unit, and students admitted to the undergraduate program will choose their major through a specified procedure.
- (2) Students admitted to the Division of Liberal Studies can choose their major from all departments, except for the Department of Christian Studies and the Arts and Physical Education fields.

Transfer Admission

- (1) Transfer admission applicants cannot apply to Division of Liberal Studies.
- (2) Applicants applying to the Division of Communications & Media should decide the major from Digital Media & Visual Communication or Journalism or Business Communication.
- (3) Applicants applying to the Division of Global Commerce should decide the major from Major of Global Business or Major of K-Content Media Industry.

A. Attention for Academic Achievement Authentication Documents

- ◆ The applicant shall submit documents before the designated date by choosing one of the following (1 ~ 3).
 1. Apostillized record of academic achievement
 2. Documents demonstrating academic achievement confirmed by the Korean consulate of the applicant's country or received Consul Confirmation from the competent official of the applicant's country
 3. In case applicant obtained a general high school degree in China:
 - 1) Certificates issued by an academic career and/or academic degree certification center operated by the Ministry of Education of China
 - ※ Limited to the applicant who obtained an academic degree in China, may take 30days to issue
