TOPIK Program

Level	Education Contents
1	Student learns the most basic daily life Korean, such as greeting, self-introduction, buying things, ordering food, asking directions, and making appointments.
2	Student can understand and express familiar everyday topics such as family, hobbies, travel, transportation, banks, and restaurants.
3	Student can understand and express familiar social topics such as occupation, personality, love, the shape of objects, incidents and accidents, appreciating things, and school life.
4	Student can understand and express familiar social and abstract topics such as climate, the workplace, performances, consumer life, customs, the environment, education, etc.
5	Student can understand and express all broad social themes, including politics, economy, society, culture, the world, etc.
6	Student can express various professional and academic topics such as politics, economy, society, culture, etc. in Korean society.

Notes for Applicants

- ▶ Your name(spelling) and date of birth on the application must match those on your passport.
- ▶ Additional documents may be requested for smooth screening during the evaluation process.
- ▶ Regardless of the number of people who apply, students may not be accepted if they are judged to be unable to study at the University.
- ▶ If the documents you submitted are counterfeit, your admission will be canceled and your tuition will NOT be refunded.
- ▶ Application material will not be returned.
- ▶ If the visa is not issued by the Korean government, the acceptance letter is canceled and the tuition fee(excluding the application fee) paid in advance will be refunded.
- ▶ Applicants may not double-register with other universities or schools, and if they give up their registration after paying the tuition, their tuition will be refunded according to University refund policies.
- ▶ The applicant is responsible for the disadvantages that may be caused by mistakes or typos, such as mailing address and contact information, on the application material.
- ▶ Applicants must pay various bank fees that incur when making financial transfers, and the difference incurred due to exchange rates will be settled after admission.
- ▶ According to the Ministry of Justice's policy, a 'tuberculosis test' has been made mandatory for all international students who wish to register as International students. Students who fall under the list below must submit a medical certificate before entering the country.
 - ※ Countries for which the test is mandatory : China, Cambodia, Myanmar, the Philippines, Pakistan, Bangladesh, Mongolia, Indonesia, India, Nepal, Vietnam, Thailand, Russia, Malaysia, Uzbekistan, Sri Lanka, East Timor, Kyrgyzstan, Laos, Kazakhstan, Tajikistan, Ukraine, Azerbaijan, Belarus, Moldova, Nigeria, South Africa, Ethiopia, Democratic Republic of Congo, Kenya, Mozambique, Zimbabwe, Angola, Peru, Papua New Guinea(35 countries)
