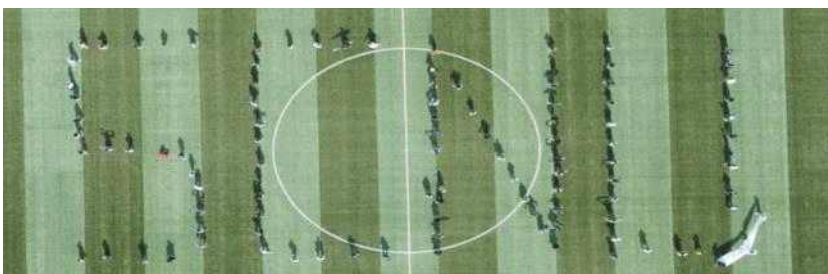
Korean Language School

- **Completion criteria:** Minimum score of 60 of the graduation test and 80% attendance

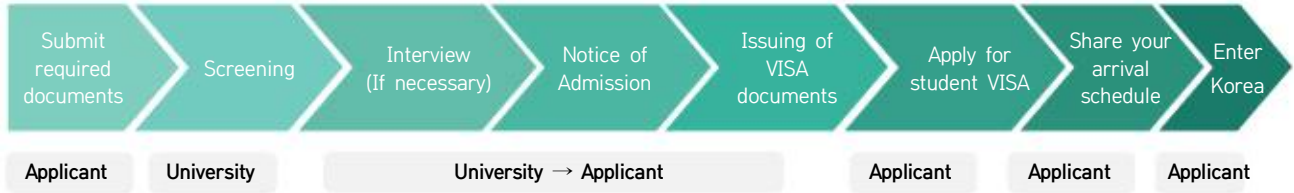

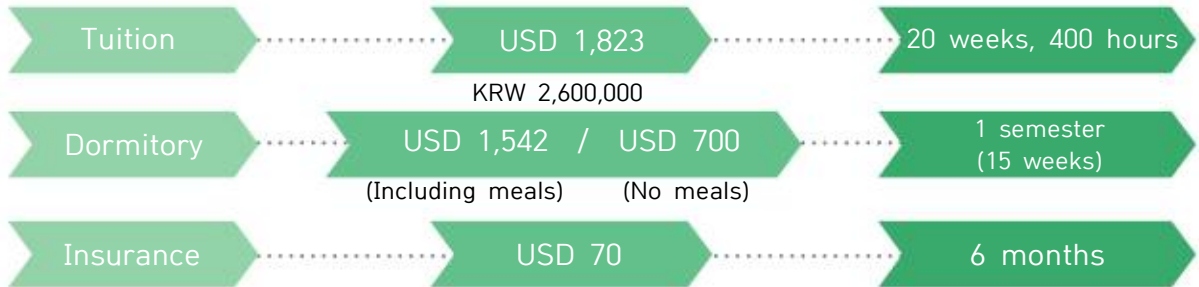

Tuition and Scholarships Scholarships

1 Tuition Fees

- Textbook(USD 45) to be paid separately



• USD 1 = KRW 1,426

- All international students are required to join the National Health Insurance six months of stay.

2 Payment Information

- Applicants must pay for one year's tuition and one semester's dormitory fee in advance.
- If the payment has to be made under another person's name, send the copy of receipt by email to our office.
- Any overseas wiring fees will be borne by the applicants.

Eligibility and Required Documents

1 Eligibility

- Applicants must have completed secondary education (high school or equivalent).

2 Required Documents

- Please prepare the following **original or notarized documents** and submit in person or by post.
- All documents must be written in Korean or English; if issued in **another language, attach a notarized translation.**
- Additional documents may be required depending on the applicant's home country and VISA types. Inquire to the Korean Embassy in your home country in advance for visa application.

Documents	Remarks
① Application Form	Includes personal information, study plan, and consent for personal data use. Attach two recent passport-sized photos (white background, 3.5cm*4.5cm).
② Copy of Passport	Must be valid for at least 6 months from the application date.
③ Graduation Certificate (most recent school)	- Must be Apostilled or confirmed by the Korean Consulate in your home country. ※ Processing for Apostille or consular confirmation may take up to 30 days.
④ Academic transcript (most recent school)	Translated and notarized in English or Korean.
⑤ Bank balance statement	- Minimum balance of KRW 8,000,000 (or equivalent) - Issued within 30 days of application - must show applicant's or parent's name - Vietnam : Original copy of the deposit certificate for study abroad expenses in Korea - Uzbekistan : KDB deposit certificate
⑥ Financial Certificate	- Parents' proof of employment and proof of income, or business license and property certificate if self-employed. - All must be translated in English or Korean and notarized.
⑦ Proof of Family relationship	Birth Certificate or family relationship certificate, translated in Korean or English and notarized
⑧ Proof of citizenship	- Copy of Passpor (No notarization needed) - Copy of national ID card (translated and notarized)
⑨ Valid TOPIK certificate	Optional for applicants with valid TOPIK results

- ※ Additional documents may be requested after document screening.
- ※ All submitted documents will not be returned.

Dormitory



Location : On-Campus (5-minutes walk from the institute)

Type: Apartment-style twin rooms

- Fees: Per semester (within 15 weeks), about USD 1,550 including meals, or USD 710 without meals.
- Korean Language School students are required to stay in the dormitory. Those who have immediate family members residing in vicinity permitted by the Immigration Office may live off campus.
- Dormitory fees may vary depending on the duration of stay. Students can choose between a meal or no meal plan. Dormitory fee should be paid with tuition fee
- Amenities & facilities: bed, closet, telephone, laundry room, TV room, cafeteria, computer room, kitchen for international students, prayer room, etc.



VISA Issuance

- Applicants must apply for VISA directly to the Korea Embassy or Consulate in their home country.
 - ※ Applicants are responsible for checking the required documents for their student visa application.
 - ※ Applicants must enter Korea within one week before the semester begins.
 - ※ Please contact us if you have a valid VISA already.

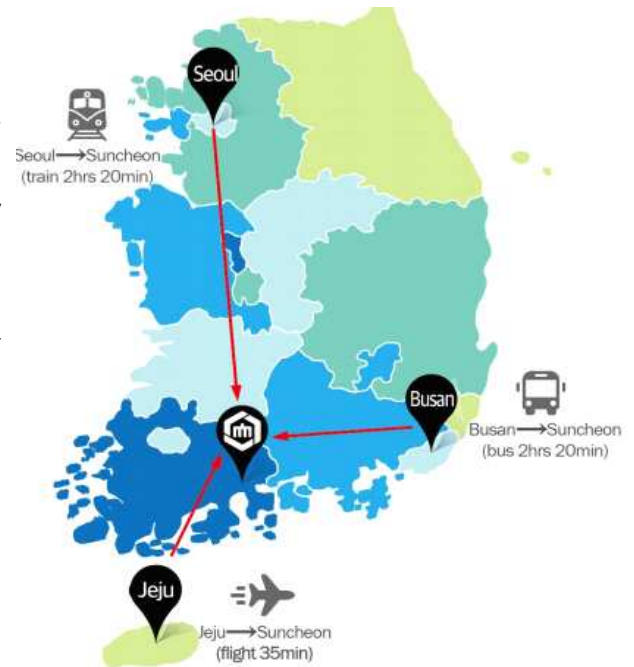



Notices


- In accordance with the Ministry of Justice regulations, applicants who fail to obtain an authorized VISA number cannot be admitted, even if they hold an acceptance letter.
- Admission will be cancelled if tuition fees are not paid within the designated period.
- If any submitted documents is found to be false or forged in any way, the admission will be revoked immediately.
- **All submitted documents will not be returned.**
- If an applicant withdraws the application due to VISA issues or personal reasons before the semester begins, a refund application form and a copy of the applicant's bankbook must be submitted. In such cases, overseas remittance fees will be deducted from the refund amount.
- Students must comply with all rules and regulations of the Korean Language School. Failure to do so may result in disciplinary action, including warnings or expulsion.
- Staying in the university dormitory and observing dormitory rules is mandatory for language students.
