Regular Course

Course Description

- For international students who want to do a degree course, get a job or experience Korean culture
- Open 4 semesters a year (spring, summer, fall, winter)
- 200 hours over 10 weeks per semester (4 hours a day)
- Class organization by level (1 to 6) through placement test
- Classes in small groups of around 15 students
- Integrated learning of reading, listening, speaking and writing
- Use of 「Korean Alive」 developed by the institute
- Study trips and various Korean cultural experiences

- Application fee: KRW 100,000 (new applicants only)
- Tuition fee: KRW 1,300,000 per term

Applications

- Completed application form and study plan
 - You can download the forms from the Korean Language Institute website
- Copy of passport
- Copy of diploma and transcript notarized by Korean embassy(or Apostille)
 - Certificate of graduation or certificate of enrollment
- Copy of bank statement in the student's name (minimum of USD 10,000)
 - If the bank statement is under the parent's name, you must also submit family relation certificates

1. Submit an application form and related documents via email or mail
2. Approve admission and pay tuition fee
3. Receive an admission letter and apply for visa
4. Receive visa and purchase an airline ticket
5. Give notice of the arrival day in Korea to the Korean Language Institute
6. Arrive at the Korean Language Institute and take placement test
7. Assigned to class
