Takes about 15 minutes from Hwarangdae Station (Line 6), Bus available at Taereung Station (Line 7)

# Dormitory

Both "International Education Center" and "Bahrom Education Center," which are located inside the Seoul Women's University campus, are dormitory for foreign students.

- The International Education Center is exclusive for Korean Language Center students. A lecture room, a computer room, and an exercise room are on the 1st floor. The 2nd and 3rd floors consists of dorm rooms.
- The Bahrom Education Center is a dorm for undergraduate students, but several floors are also available for Korean Language Center students.

## 1. Qualification for Dormitory Application

Female students who are enrolled in SWU's Korean Language Center.

## 2. Fees (13 weeks per term)

- ① Entrance Fee: 20,000 KRW (Non-refundable)
- ② Dormitory Fee: 774,800 KRW (Meals excluded)

## 3. Dormitory Policy

- ① Roll Call: Every night at 23:30
- ② Overnight stay outside of the dormitory is not permitted on weekdays during the semester, but weekend overnight stays are allowed upon prior application
- ③ Must follow the dormitory policy at all times

# Regular Program

This program is for non-Koreans or ethnic Koreans living outside of Korea who seek to obtain an undergraduate or graduate degree in Korea. There are six levels (Levels 1-6) that take about a year and a half to complete.

## 1. Schedule

## 2. Admission Requirement

Any male or female applicant who has a high school diploma.

## 3. Curriculum

- ① Levels: Level 1 to Level 6
- ② Terms: 4 terms per year (Spring, Summer, Fall, Winter)
- ③ Class Size: 10-15 students per class
- ④ Class Hours: 5 days per week (Mon~Fri), 4 hours per day(9:00~13:00) / TOPIK class once a week
- ⑤ Cultural Experience: Once a term (Taekwondo class, K-pop dance class, amusement park, etc.)
- ⑥ Special Event: Once a term (baseball game, movie day, field trip, etc.)

## 4. Scholarship

- ① First Place Prize: 200,000 KRW for the first place student in each level, every term.
- ② Second Place Prize: 100,000 KRW for the second place student in each level, every term.
- ③ Perfect Attendance: Student who attended class without missing a single day will be awarded both a certificate and a gift.

## 5. Certification Criteria (when all conditions below are met, promotion to next level)

- ① Test 80% + Attitude 20%
- ② Grade of 60 points or above in four subjects (Speaking, Listening, Reading, Writing)
- ③ Attendance rate of 80% or above

## 3. Tuition Payment

- ① Application Fee 60,000 KRW (Non-refundable)
- ② Tuition: 1,450,000 KRW per term (Textbook fee is NOT included)
- ③ Payment Method: payment by applicant's Passport name (by Wire Transfer ONLY)

## 4. Insurance Fee Payment

- ① Insurance Cost: 75,000 KRW
  - ② Insurance Coverage: For 6 months from the starting date of applying term
  - ③ Payment Method: Included in the Tuition Payment (by Wire Transfer ONLY)
- ※ Insurance issued in your home country is not accepted.
- ※ If you have already signed up for other Korean insurances, please submit your insurance policy in advance. (The insurance policy should be valid until the last day of the term the applicant registered for.)

- ① Korean Buddy: Exchange activities with SWU Korean students who can help with getting accustomed to Korean culture and enhancing Korean ability.
- ② Korean Conversation Class: Practice Korean conversation with our SWU Korean undergraduate students (available at all times)
- ③ TOPIK Course: Once a week, 2 hours per class
- ④ Field Trip / Corporate Tour: Offer a wide range of experiential learning opportunities outside of campus
