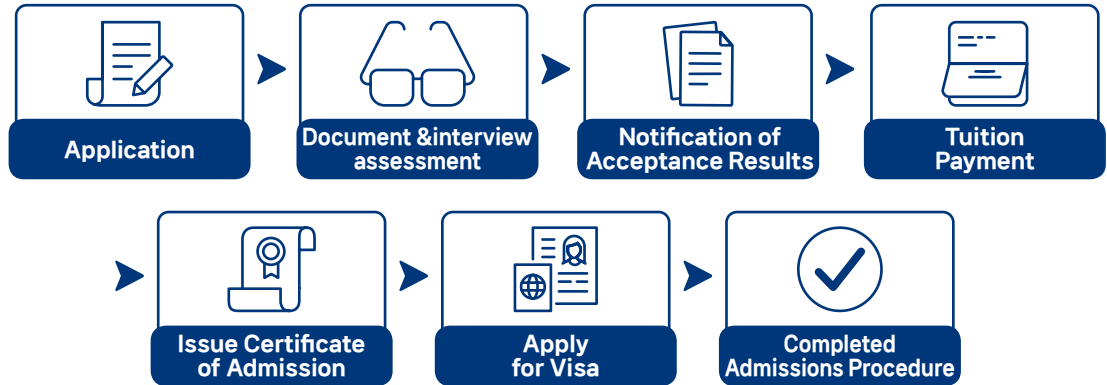

- Application form, 1 ID photo, Copy of passport
- Original Proof of Family Relationship
- Original Graduation Certificate and Transcript of highest academic achievement
 - Must submit Apostille Certification or Consular Authentication
- Original Certificate of Deposit Balance (KRW 10,000,000 or more)
 - Documents issued within 30 days of the application date are considered valid. / Recommend to keep a balance for at least three months
- (If applicable) A Copy of Employment Certificate and Income Certificate for the applicant or their parents / (If applicable) Letter of Guarantee
