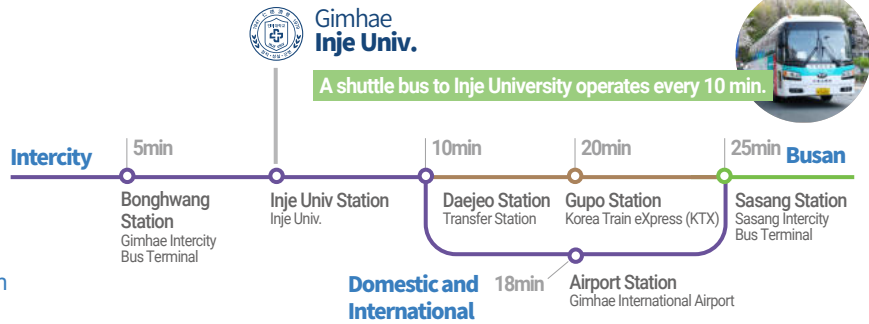

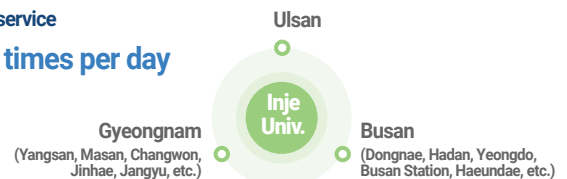

B) Criteria for English Proficiency

- TOEFL iBT 71 or above, IELTS 5.5 or above, CEFR B2 or above, NEW TEPS 326 or above

Applicants with nationality from countries where English is their native language or official language can meet the English proficiency with proof(graduation certificate) of completion of higher education in English. However, the above language proficiency can be relaxed for GKS(Global Korea Scholarship) Students, Foreign Government Scholarship Students, and students admitted as special cases after deliberation by Graduate School’s Admission Committee.

## Course Introduction

- The Global Korea Scholarship (GKS) program is designed for international students who wish to pursue undergraduate or graduate studies in Korea, thereby enhancing international education exchange and deepening mutual friendship between Korea and participating countries.
- Inje University operates the GKS program, offering the General Program (Undergraduate and Graduate), the UIC Program (Undergraduate), and the R&D Program (Graduate).

GKS General Program (Undergraduate & Graduate)	Inje University has been operating the GKS Program since 2011. In 2023, the university was selected as an Outstanding University for Managing GKS Scholars, recognizing its excellence in supporting and managing GKS students.
GKS UIC Program (Undergraduate)	Selected in 2025 for NIIED's 2026–2028 GKS Degree Program (UIC), this program offers an industry-oriented curriculum that combines academic study with practical experience to support students' future careers.
GKS R&D Program (Graduate)	Selected in 2025 for NIIED's 2026–2028 GKS Graduate Specialized Track (R&D), this program provides R&D-focused education and field experience to cultivate high-level researchers in strategic high-tech fields.

# Welcome to Inje University

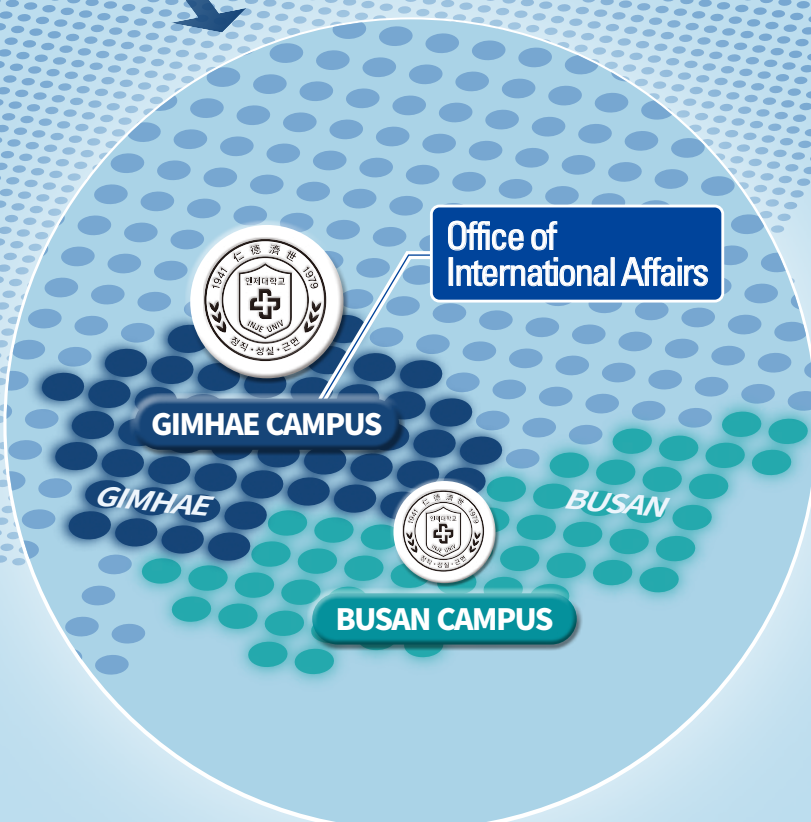
