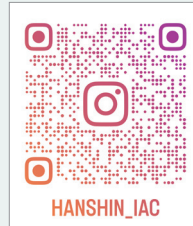

01 Korean Language Institute Description

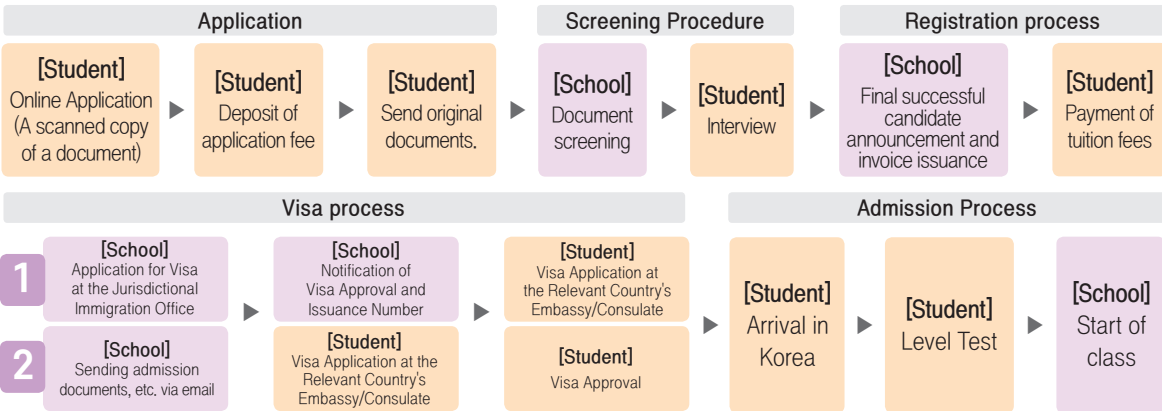
The regular program consists of six levels from level 1 to 6.

- 4 terms per year (Spring, Summer, Fall, and Winter).
- 5 days a week: A total of 200 hours of lessons is provided.

02 Qualification to apply

- High school graduate within 2 years from the date of admission to the language school (equivalent academic background)
- Students with less than 8 general absences in 3 years (excluding absences due to illness)
- GPA Grade Requirements :
 - Northern/Southern Vietnam : 6.5 or higher, Central : 7.5 or higher
 - Uzbekistan : 4.0 or higher
 - Myanmar : Above 300
 - For other countries, apply the same criteria as above.

03 Application Procedure



★ Visa Procedure 1 : Applies to citizens of China, Vietnam, Uzbekistan, and Mongolia.

Visa Procedure 2 : Applies to citizens of all countries other than the four nations listed above.

★ When the student applies for a visa in the destination country (or host country) : The school will send the necessary documents via email only to the admitted applicants.

- Korean Embassy visa application deadline : one month before the start of the regular semester.

• Insurance fee

- Students will be covered by group insurance through Hanshin University for the first 6 months.
- From the 7th month after entering Korea, you will be automatically registered for the National Health Insurance sector under the relevant laws (you will need to pay about KRW 80,000 per month).

• Vietnam study abroad expense deposit system

If you are a Vietnamese student, join a financial product with a payment reservation method to a commercial bank with its headquarters (including branches) in Vietnam and submit a balance certificate of KRW 10 million deposited for study abroad.

※ Only certificates of deposit balance that clearly state a 1-year suspension of payment

(withdrawal possible in installments of 5 million won every 6 months) are accepted.
