### Eligibility

- Education: High school graduate or above
- Language proficiency: TOPIK Level 2 or higher, or Completion of Sejong Institute Korean Language Beginner Level 2 (2B) or higher

### Application Schedule

- Application submission: September 2026
- Announcement of successful applicants: December 2026

## Required Documents

- Application form (including Study Plan and Financial Support Pledge)
- High school graduation certificate  
(additional requirement: notarized Korean or English translation + Apostille)
- High school academic transcript  
(additional requirement: notarized Korean or English translation + Apostille)
- Proof of language proficiency
- Identification documents (student and parents), copy of student's passport
- Certificate of family relationship
- Financial proof documents
