# I . 2026 Fall Semester- Eligibility and Admission Process

## 1. Eligibility

- A. Applicants must have a high school diploma or an equivalent or higher educational background
- B. Both the applicant and their parents must hold foreign citizenship (non-Korean)
- C. Applicants must not have any grounds for disqualification in obtaining a D-2-1 visa
- D. Applicants must meet the required score for Korean (TOPIK) or English proficiency  
(Please refer to Item No. 8 in the Required Documents section)

- ※ If original documents are written in a language other than Korean or English, a notarized translation must be attached.
- ※ **Scanned copies (PDF) of student documents must be submitted as individual files named by category.**
  - Example: BankBalance(StudentName).pdf, FinalEducation(StudentName).pdf, ParentIncomeCertificate(StudentName).pdf, etc.
- ※ For item No. 8 (Language Proficiency), select and submit only one from: TOPIK Score Report, KIIP Completion Certificate, Sejong Institute Completion Certificate, or English Proficiency Test Score.
- ※ For foreigners in specific visa categories (e.g., E-series, F-series), document submission may be simplified (Inquire separately).
- ※ **Passing the KMCU Korean Language Entrance Test is recognized as equivalent to TOPIK Level 2 (A 50% tuition reduction is applied for the first semester).**
  - However, from the 2nd semester onwards (as an enrolled student), you must submit either a TOPIK Level 2 or higher or a KIIP Level 2 or higher completion certificate to continue receiving tuition reductions.
- ※ **Applicants admitted based on Sejong Institute or English proficiency scores must also submit either a TOPIK Level 2 or higher or a KIIP Level 2 or higher completion certificate starting from the 2nd semester to receive tuition reductions.**
- ※ **All submitted application forms and documents will not be returned under any circumstances**

## VI. Other Information

### 1. Notice on the Collection and Use of Personal Information

- 1) Personal information of applicants and others is collected and used for the university admission process as follows:
  - A) **Applicant Information:** Name, Foreigner Registration Number, address, mobile/ phone number, school records, year of graduation (or expected graduation), passport information, etc
  - B) **Guardian Information:** Relationship to the applicant, (mobile) phone number, address, etc
  - C) **School Information:** Information regarding local (overseas) and domestic schools.
- 2) Collected personal information will not be used for purposes other than university admissions, scholarships, academic statistical work, provision to external companies related to the announcement of successful candidates, and other notices provided by the university. When the retention period expires or the personal information becomes unnecessary (such as the purpose of processing being achieved), it will be destroyed without delay.
- 3) Consent for the collection and use of personal information is obtained at the time of application submission. If you do not agree, the admission process may not proceed smoothly. In particular, if you do not agree to the online provision of your high school student records or the College Scholastic Ability Test (CSAT) results, you may be required to submit those documents in person.
