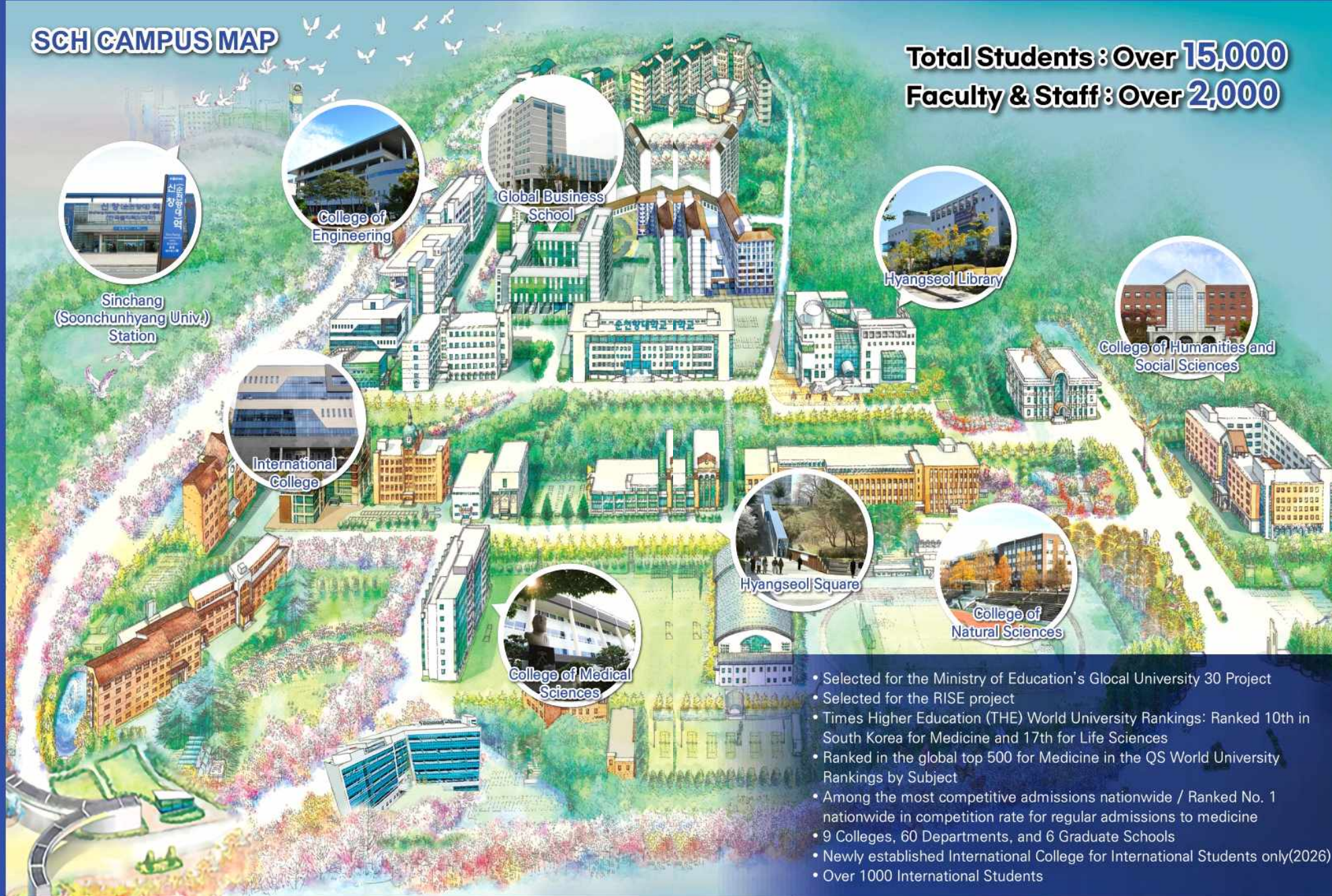

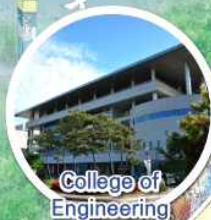


SCH CAMPUS MAP

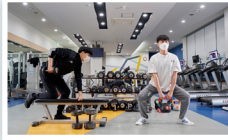

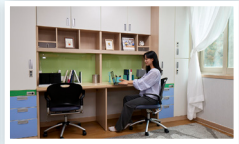

Admission Requirements

- Foreign individuals whose parents are both foreigners
- Applicant should have graduated (or be expected to graduate) from high school or recognized as the same level of education according to the law, the applicant must have completed a minimum of 12 years of elementary and secondary education
- Language Proficiency Requirement
 - ➔ General Majors : TOPIK Level 3 or higher
 - ➔ International College: No Korean language proficiency requirements. Official English proficiency test score [TOEFL iBT 59, IELTS 5.5, CEFR B2, NEW TEPS 202 or higher] is required only for the applicants to English-track programs.
