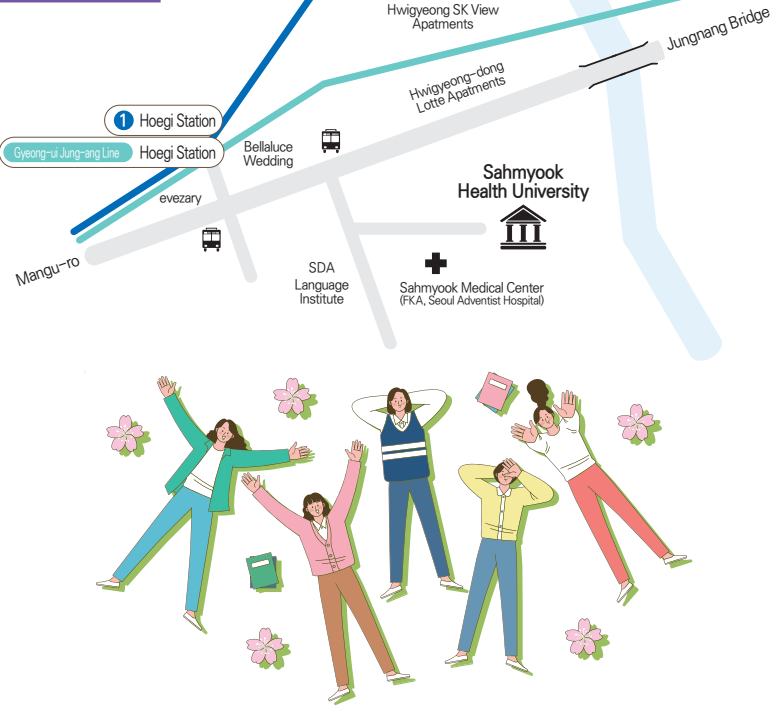
Driving

Sahmyook Health University Guide for International Students

1. Korean Language Center (Language Course)

Features:

- Practical Korean + TOPIK Level-Based Learning (Levels 1–6)
- Small class sizes (19 students max per class) for enhanced individual feedback
- 4 days per week (Mon–Thu), intensive morning classes (09:00–13:00) for easy balancing of studies and daily life
- Semester system (Spring/Summer/Fall/Winter, each 3 months: 11 weeks of classes + 2 weeks break) for flexible enrollment
- Scholarship benefits (Sejong/TOPIK 10~30%) and support for academic advancement

Application Process: Submit completed application to lingo@shu.ac.kr or johnk@shu.ac.kr (Documents must be submitted 2 to 4 months prior to the intended semester of study, depending on the country)

Curriculum:

- General: Levels 1–6 (Beginner–Advanced) – Integrated Korean language by level, Korean cultural understanding, balanced communication/reading/writing/listening classes, cultural experiences (per university schedule)
- Major (Advanced Track): Intensive TOPIK preparation, practical conversation (daily life/academic/work situations), Academic Korean (presentations/reports), pronunciation/intonation coaching
- Operation: 16 hours per week (4 days × 4 hours), small class formation, placement after level test

Certificates Awarded:

- Certificate of Completion issued upon program completion (subject to university regulations)
- Support for enhancing TOPIK test-taking skills and achieving high scores
- Enhance readiness for further studies or employment through mastery of practical Korean for academic and daily life

Post-Graduation Pathways:

- Degree Program Preparation: Prepare for degree programs like Global Convergence or Global Nursing Services at Sahmyook Health University
- Secure Korean proficiency for admission or transfer to domestic universities (vocational/general)
- Enhance basic Korean communication skills for industrial and service sector roles
- Support meeting scholarship and visa requirements based on TOPIK scores

Eligibility for Applying to Korean Language Center:

- Holders of a high school diploma or equivalent qualification
- Eligible for a General Training Visa (D–4)
- Required documents at application: passport copy, diploma and transcript, bank statement, guarantee documents
- Bank balance verification of KRW 10,000,000 or more required for 6-month program enrollment, (50% reduction in required balance if advancing to a degree program at our university after completing the Korean Language Center program)
- Refer to the admission guidelines for details

Degree Programs (Global Convergence Department · Global Nursing Service Department) Eligibility:

- High school graduate (or expected graduate) or equivalent academic qualification
- Eligible for a Degree Program Visa (D–2)
- For Global Convergence: TOPIK Level 2 or higher required
- For Global Nursing Services: TOPIK Level 1 or higher required

Required Documents:

- Application Form (University Format) + Photo (taken within last 3 months)
- Personal Statement & Study Plan (University Format)
- High school graduation (or expected graduation) certificate, transcript (Apostille or consular certification required)
- Passport copy, family relationship certificate, proof of financial capability (bank statement showing KRW 20 million or more)
- For the Global Nursing Service Department: KRW 10 million or more
- Korean language proficiency requirement: TOPIK score or Korean language course completion certificate must be submitted
