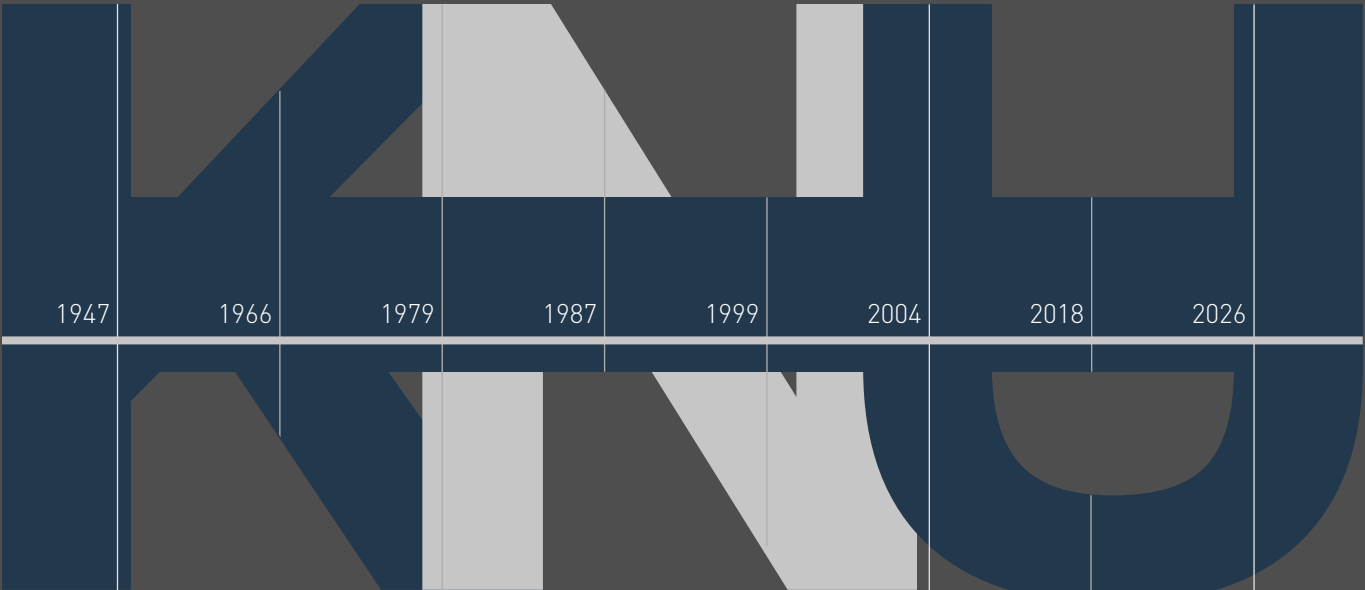

Program	Detailed Content
Cultural Experience Program	Samcheok city tour; participation in local festivals; kimchi-making and traditional costume experiences; marine sports classes; charity bazaars, etc.
Korean Life Adaptation Support Program	Orientation for new students, Korean language classes, free TOPIK preparation courses, visa guidance seminars, transportation support.
Employment Capacity Building Program	Provision of information and support for part-time job applications; job skills training programs (e.g., Excel, driving license); guidance on writing resumes and self-introductions, etc.

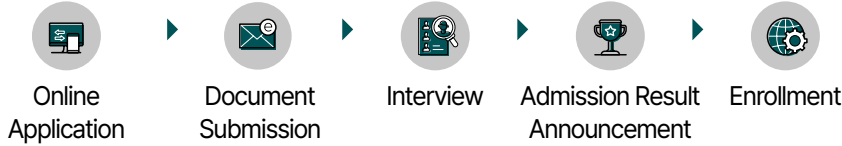

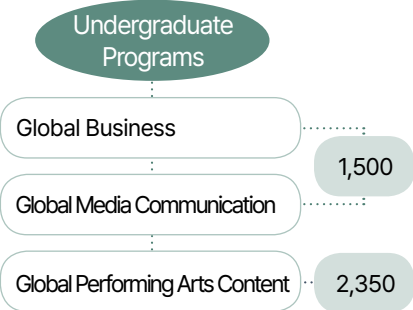

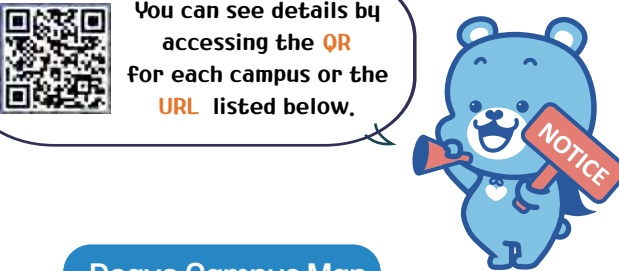
