Category		Main Contents
Beginner	Level 1	Learning the characteristics of syllable structures in Hangeul consonants and vowels, spelling, and basic Korean and cultural education necessary for everyday situations and very personal and familiar topics.
	Level 2	Training in accurate pronunciation and correction, developing the ability to identify phonological changes, and learning Korean necessary for daily life and using public facilities.
Intermediate	Level 3	Acquiring basic language skills needed for using various public facilities and maintaining social relationships.
	Level 4	Learning vocabulary such as onomatopoeia, mimetic words, proverbs, and commonly used current affairs terminology.

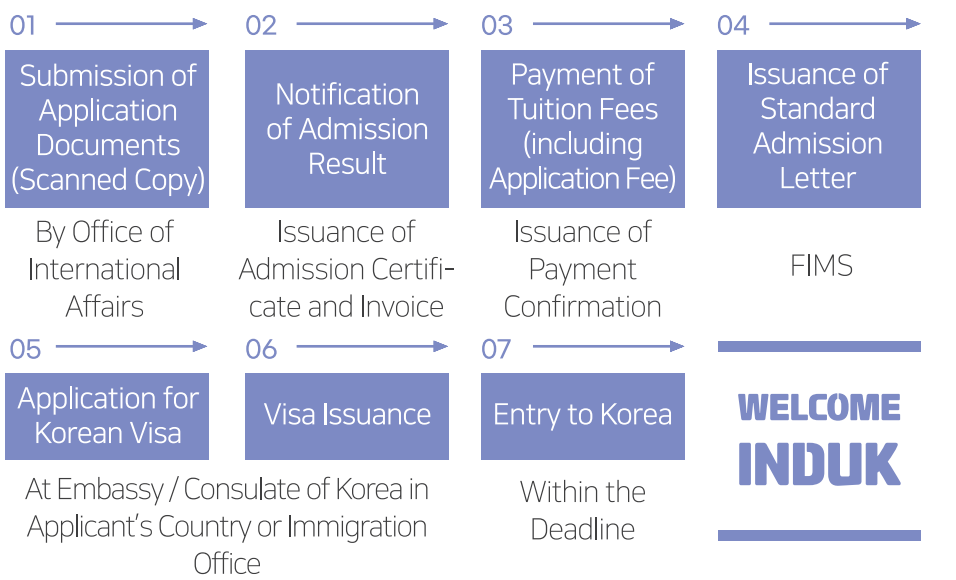

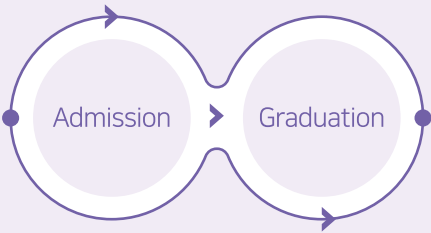
