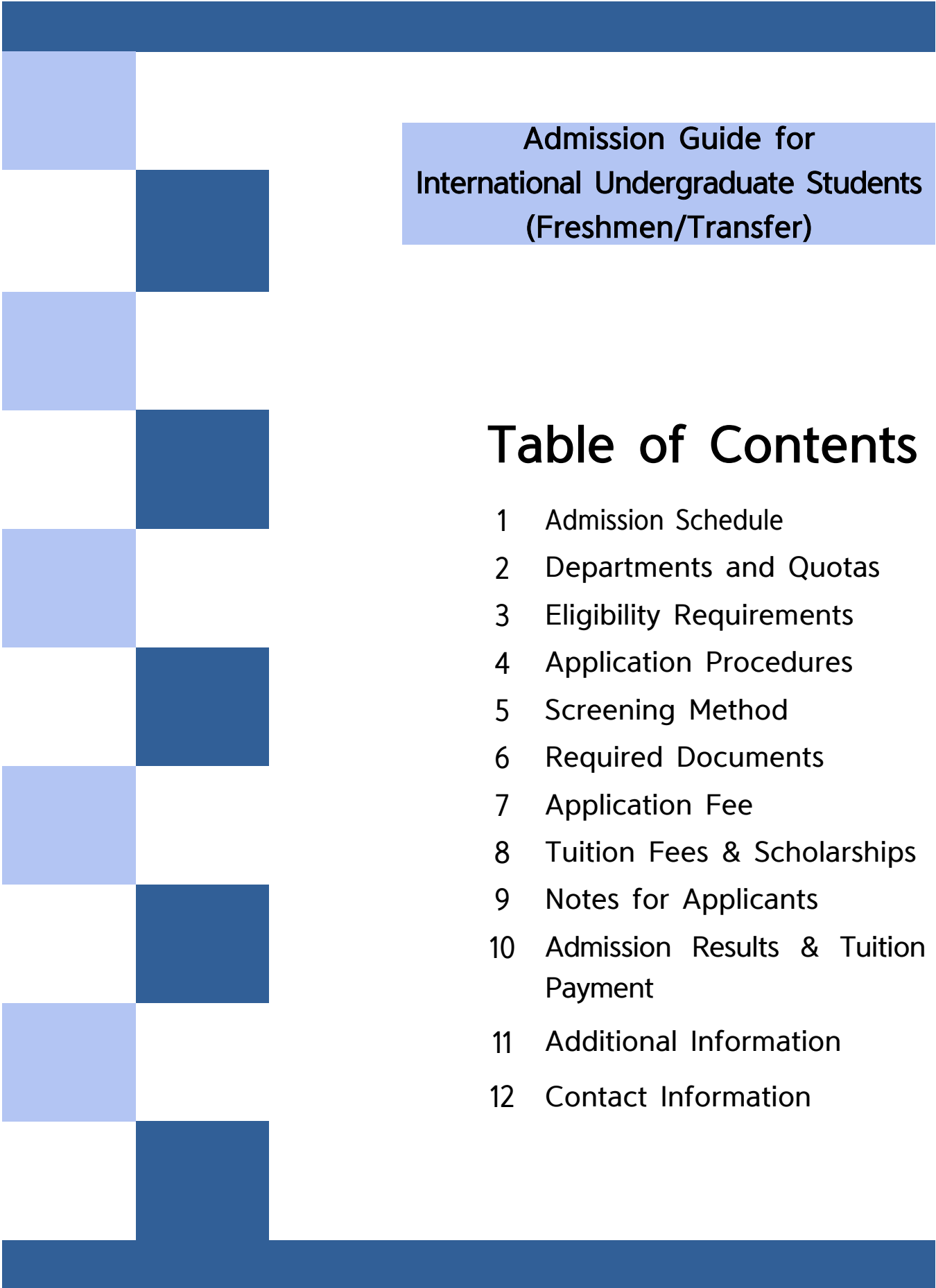

3. Eligibility Requirements

1. General Eligibility

Transfer to Sophomore (2nd year)	1) Applicants whose parents are both non-Korean (pure foreign nationals). 2) Applicants who have completed education equivalent to Korea's 12-year school system. 3) Graduates (or expected graduates) of junior colleges, or students who have completed at least one year in a 4-year university.
Transfer to Junior (3rd year)	1) Applicants whose parents are both non-Korean (pure foreign nationals). 2) Applicants who have completed education equivalent to Korea's 12-year school system. 3) Graduates (or expected graduates) of junior colleges, or students who have completed at least two years in a 4-year university.
Transfer to Senior (4th year)	1) Applicants whose parents are both non-Korean (pure foreign nationals). 2) Applicants who have completed education equivalent to Korea's 12-year school system. 3) Applicants who graduated (or are expected to graduate) from a 3-year junior college in the same or a related major .

2. Korean Language Proficiency Requirement

Admission Requirement (Optional – choose one of the following)	Graduation Requirement (Mandatory – must meet at least one)
a. TOPIK (Test of Proficiency in Korean) certificate holder b. Korea Immigration and Integration Program (KIIP) completion certificate or pre-test score c. Completion certificate from King Sejong Institute (Korean language course) d. Certificate from a language institute at Wonkwang Univ. or another university in Korea e. Other proof of Korean proficiency ※ Submit only if in possession of the above certificate (Omit if not)	a. TOPIK Level 4 (Arts & Sports: Level 3) or higher (no expiration) b. KIIP Level 4 or higher completion, or pre-test score ≥ 81 c. Completion of King Sejong Institute Intermediate 2 or higher d. Pass the WKU Korean Proficiency Test (WKU-TOPIK) e. Completion of at least 2 semesters (20 weeks) at WKU Korean Language & Culture Center f. The English track is exempt from Korean language graduation requirements ※ 4th-year transfer students must complete at least 2 semesters at the Korean Language & Culture Center regardless of the above.

- Passing Criteria: Total score $\geq$ 60 points (average score if 2 or more interviewers)
- Applicants deemed academically unprepared may not be admitted.
- In case of tie scores, all tied applicants are admitted. (Interviews are conducted in Korean.)

<Example>

- A. A Chinese who has obtained a degree in the United States of America: Apostille or confirmation from the Korean embassy in the US or the US embassy in Korea must be submitted.
- B. An American who has obtained a degree in China: Verified documents issued by a Center for Accreditation of Education and Degree run by the Chinese Education Ministry or the Korean consulate in China must be submitted

1. How to submit supporting documents for the certificate of Degree/Diploma:

- Freshmen: High school graduation certificate / **Transfer:** High school graduation certificate + bachelor's enrollment(graduation) Certificate or associate's graduation certificate must be submitted.

A. General Country (choose from below)

- 1) Apostille confirmation: Issued by the relevant country's government agency (limited to the Apostille Convention countries)
- 2) Consular confirmation: Consular confirmation must be issued by the embassy in the country or the Korean consulate in Korea.

B. China: Degree/Diploma certificate is required using the Chinese Ministry of Education Certificate Center (Chinese Middle/High School Education Student Information Network, <http://www.chsi.com.cn>)

C. Additionally, Degree/Diploma certification reports recognized by the "Ministry of Justice's Guidelines for Issuing Visa and Managing Stay for Foreign Students" must be submitted.

2. Submission of Academic Credential Documents for Chinese Applicants

① For applicants whose final education is high school:

(a) General high school graduates (choose one of the following):

- Gaokao (高考): score report (issued and certified by the Ministry of Education) + graduation certificate (issued by the principal)
- Huikao (会考): pass certificate or transcript (certified by the Ministry of Education) + graduation certificate (issued by the principal)

(b) Graduates from secondary vocational schools, etc. that are not eligible for CHSI academic degree certification (limited to institutions recognized by the Ministry of Education).

- Must submit proof of high school graduation (certified by the Ministry of Education) + proof of bachelor's enrollment/graduation or associate's degree graduation (certified by the Ministry of Education).

Note2) Financial capability Documents

1. Applicants from overseas:

- The applicant or financial guarantor shall submit a bank statement with a balance of 13,000 USD within one month from the date of issue of the certificate.

2. Applicants residing in Korea:

- The applicant (transferring the D-4 to D-2 visa and extending the date of expiration of D2 visa) shall submit bank statement that shows a deposit of KRW 16,000,000 (within one month from the date of issue of the certificate).

Note for submitting Financial Document

- 1) The financial ability document should be submitted with a copy of bank book.
- 2) When applying for Recognition of Visa Issuance, you must submit the financial ability document issued within one month.
- 3) The financial ability document must be issued in a form of the bank and must contain the bank contact information.
- 4) If the visa is refused because the financial ability documents are not prepared, our university does not take any responsibility.

Note for Preparing the Application Form

- 1) All original and copied documents required for the application for admission must be submitted after being separated. Diplomas and transcripts must have a translation attached with the confirmation of the translator.
- 2) Write the same English name on your passport in the name section of the application form. All required information shall be accurately entered in Korean. Applicants shall be responsible for omissions, typographical errors, or any mistakes in the application form.
- 3) **Changing of department (division) is not allowed once the application has been accepted.**
- 4) Applicants must record full contact information including name, address, phone numbers and e-mail (domestic and international). Wonkwang University is not responsible for any problem or disadvantage to applicants due to incorrect contact information.
- 5) In case the information on the application for admission is falsely provided or the attached documents are invalid, the applicant may be excluded from the admission process.
- 6) You may be asked to submit extra documents for your application. The submitted documents are not returned.

- ※ Scholarships apply only to “foreign student quota” admissions (both parents foreign).
- ※ **The above scholarships are not applicable to 4th-year transfer students or students in the advanced major program (both upon admission and while enrolled).**

9. Notes for Applicants

- 1) Admission will be revoked if documents are found to be falsified or admission gained by fraudulent means.
- 2) Applicants must pay tuition within the designated period; failure to do so will be regarded as withdrawal.
- 3) Academic divisions are based on WKU classification (not on high school coursework).
- 4) Any matters not specified in this guideline follow WKU academic regulations.
- 5) **Admission is canceled if the applicant's visa is denied by the Korean government.**
- 6) Applicants must bring their admission slip and valid ID (Alien Registration Card, driver's license, or passport) to the interview.
- 7) **This guideline is provided in Korean, English, and Chinese. In case of discrepancies, the Korean version prevails.**
