CU Hospital

It provides patient-oriented medical services.

Chosun University Hospital opened 19 medical departments on April 17, 1971 for the purpose of improving the health care in the Honam Area and nurturing qualified medical professionals. It has developed continuously since its opening. The Hospital has 707 beds in 25 medical departments to provide high-quality medical services. Recently, six professional medical centers with advanced medical equipment, outstanding faculty, and efficient diagnosis systems have opened, which are providing a wider range of medical services. The hospital received an ISO certificate(ISO 15189) in pathology through a Certified Medical Test and was certified as a Grade 1 Hospital in prevention against the abuse of antibiotics to stop the expansion of resistant bacteria. We are a certified general hospital which provides high-quality and safe medical services. In addition, we have been trusted to manage a rehabilitation hospital in the Honam area designated by Gwangju City.

CU Dental Hospital

The Dental Hospital, which was opened in 1978, is striving for the development of dental technology through a variety of academic exchanges with sister hospitals such as Dokusima College of Dentistry, Japan, Gottingen College of Dentistry, Germany, Alabama College of Dentistry, U.S.A, Hang Tuah College of Dentistry, Indonesia, and Yangon-Mandalay College of Dentistry, Myanmar. It is equipped with a dental CT, a velscope, an arthroscope, a rapid form XOR3OCS, an order-communication system, a Full-PACS, and an EMR to provide the best dental service. In particular, it has introduced advanced medical technology for implant surgery, and opened an oral cancer center for more organized diagnosis.

Chosun University Museum of Art

Chosun University Museum of Art was founded in 1989 to collect, organize, exhibits, keep and research domestic and overseas art works for the academic development of university, and support cultural activities in local communities.

The staff of Chosun university museum of art has been making a lot of efforts to develop the Asian culture as a cultural art museum in line with our university's objective of supporting unique talents who can contribute to the human society based on creative spirits developed by education for individuality.



Chosun University's College of Arts and Design has been playing a central role in the artistic circle of Jeollanam-do province for the past 65 years, having produced outstanding artists such as Oh Ji-ho and Yim Jic-soon. In 2011 Chosun university art museum revamped its website to make a new start.

Po Kim and Sylvia Wald Museum of Art

Po Kim and Sylvia Wald Museum of Art has opened in the main building where has been designated as national heritage in 2004 on September 29, 2011. It has Po Kim's and his wife, Sylvia Wald's works.

Born in Korea in 1919, Po Kim studied art in Tokyo, Japan. He returned to Korea in 1946 to establish Fine Art Department of Chosun University in Gwangju, Korea, where he was a professor and a chairman.

In 1955, he came to United States on a fellowship at University of Illinois and eventually moved to New York City two years later. In 2000, Po Kim received Honorary Doctorate Degree of Letters from Chosun University. Po Kim's career as an artist spans more than six decades. Trained in academic style of painting in his study days, his works developed into abstraction in the fifties, and his mature style in the abstracted idiom. Po Kim's works have been exhibited nationally and internationally in galleries and museums.



Sylvia Wald was born in 1915 in Philadelphia and studied art at Moore Institute in Philadelphia before moving to New York in 1930's. Her painting style was associated with American Magic Realism and Surrealism. In the forties and in fifties, she developed an experimental print making method, which garnered her a title of a pioneer Abstract Expressionist printmaker. Wald's sculptural works made with found objects combined with roughly built up surfaces, works were noted for "vital in its ever developing quality". Wald's works are featured in many national and international collections.

The Rose Garden

On May 23, 2003, the first rose festival was held in Chosun University. Now, it has become a large annual event where many students and citizens can enjoy beautiful variety of roses. Samsung Everland's civil engineers designed the layout and a total of 18,000 roses of 230 kinds flourish in our garden. You can enjoy the many elegant varieties from May to November, including such as Princess De Monaco which was dedicated to Grace Kelly, Queen of Monaco. This garden was built to make a park on campus where students, faculty, and the people Gwangju and Jeonnam can relax and unwind.



Industry-Academic Cooperation

CU Industry-Academic Cooperation Foundation has engaged in a number of projects in R&d, research facility development, business incubation, human resources development, and technology transfers. In 2010, we developed the Chosun University Convergence Design College Development Project and the Bio-refinery Research Center. As a leader in industry-university cooperation since the programs foundation in 2004, Chosun University has won a presidential award, and was designated as the first accredited organization and a ministerial award in the area of industry-university cooperation.

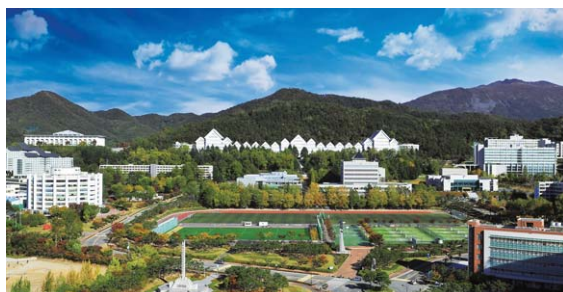

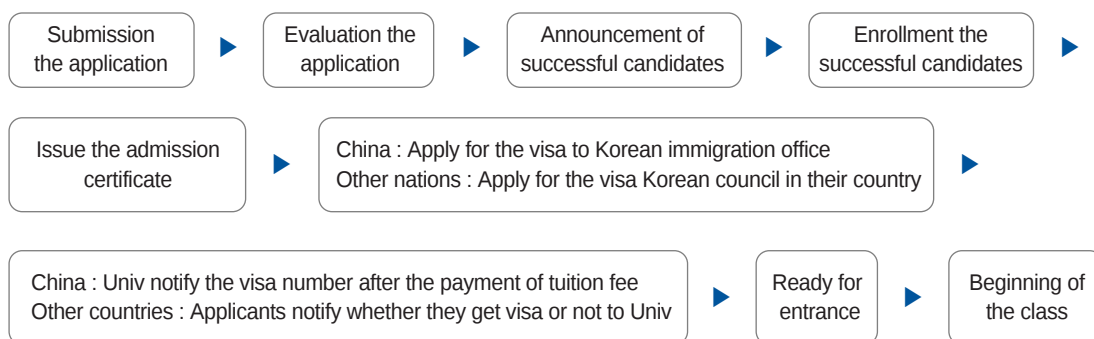

6. Dormitory

1) Introduce

(1) Dormitory 1 (Baek-hak-hak-sa)

This is an energy-saving building with a solar energy system and an overnight electric boiler that can accommodate 1,026 residents. It is equipped with a solar energy heating system and a central cooling and heating system. It is an ideal model of an environmentally-friendly school dormitory using a future-oriented energy system under the intent of creating a campus that enhances its natural environment. This dormitory has a 2-leveled underground section(parking), and two 9-stories buildings for male students and female students respectively equipped with basic furniture such as a bed, a desk, a chair, a closet, and supplies needed. As it is close to the library and student center, students have a good environment for study.



(2) Dormitory 2 (Global House)

This is a second dormitory comprised of two levels underground and 11 above and can accommodate a total of 956 students. It has an 'English Only Zone', a book cafe, a video room, a study room, and a multi-purpose center for exchanges among students, and healthy student activities. The Living&Learning Program is composed of an English program, GH-ESL, and GH-CSL. As one native teacher and six students are formed into a team and take part in the program in the morning and the evening. An advanced living environment with a cafeteria for regular and healthy living, a fitness center, a reading room, and a seminar room are provided.



(3) Green Village (For International Students)

This is an environmentally-friendly dormitory accommodating 170 students equipped with a solar energy system. Yeohaksa (building for male students) has a community kitchen, lockers, a reading room, and a computer room. Each room of the Namhaksa (building for female students) has a private toilet and a kitchen. Assistants in charge of international students help the residents adapt to campus life.

3) Facilities : A single bed (with drawers), a desk with a book-shelf, a chair, a closet(mirror and shoe-rack attached), LAN cable, a telephone, a bed pad, vertical curtains, and ceiling fan, cook facility (Only for Green Village - timeshare for men / individual cooking space for women)

4) Students shall prepare a blanket, a pillow, a bed cover, a cloth hanger, soaps and a toothbrush, slipper etc.

5) Convenient Facilities : Internet rooms, laundry room, common room, shower room, etc.

6) Notice : All students who stay in the dormitory or new students must get medical check up and buy insurance.



7. Library



The CU University Library, which is equipped with advanced facilities, has a collection of 1.1 million books and is the largest in Gwangju and Jeonnam. To provide different kinds of academic information for students, it has carried forward with a 'Donation Campaign' as well as the dynamic purchase of new books. Also, the library organizes various events such as Reading 300 recommended books, reading and debate, reading mentoring, parents' book recommendations, reading festival, and field trips to cultural relics to induce active reading activities. In addition, the library offers electronic data search and download services, copying services

and SDI (Selective Dissemination of Information) service through which students are regularly provided necessary information.

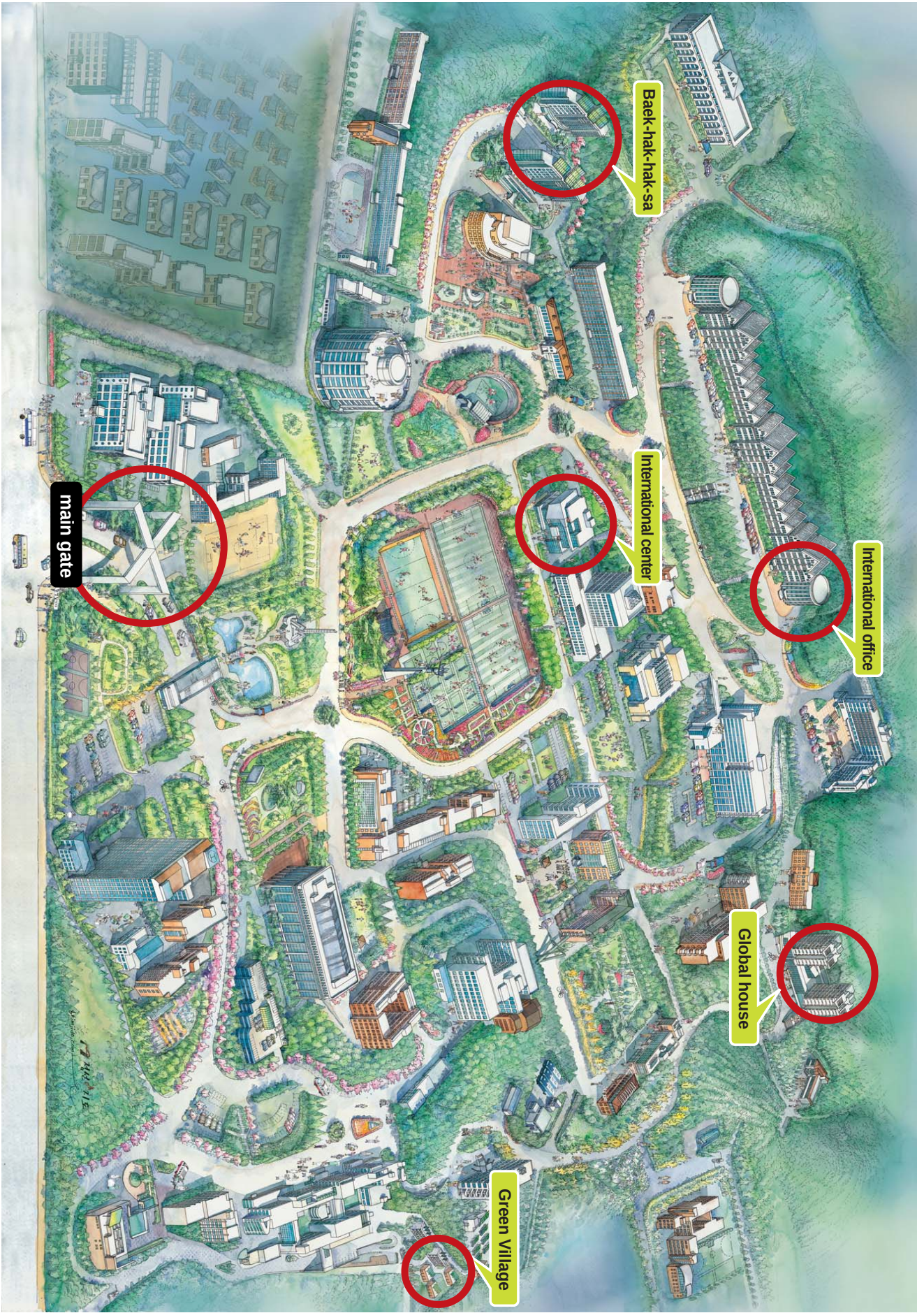
