Korea Association of Business Education Accreditation (KABEA)

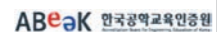
College of Business Administration has been accredited by the KABEA, for its quality education with lectures built upon industry-academia collaboration.

University Campuses & Offered Disciplines

Myongji University has two campuses, each home of different colleges.

Humanities and Social Science Campus in Seoul



Seoul Campus is located near the economic, political and cultural center of downtown Seoul. It has easy access to public transportations and is close to Sinchon area, one of the favorite haunts of university students.

Seoul campus houses seven colleges: Humanities, Social Science, Business Administration, Law, Information and Communications Technologies Convergence, Continuing Education and General Studies, with 27 majors, the Korean Language Institute and the Institute of Continuing Education.

College of Information and Communications Technology Convergence is a unique department that combines humanities and engineering to educate an academically well-rounded and problem-solving talents.

College of Continuing Education was newly formed in 2016 after a strict evaluation process of the Korean government and the Ministry of Education. Only six universities were selected in Korea, and Myongji is one of the four located in Seoul.

Civil Engineering is ranked as number 1 in Korea and the Hybrid-center is the best in Korea (only six were authorized by the Korean Ministry of Construction and Transportation among over 400 Korean universities). Electrical/Electronics/Mechanical Engineering departments were selected within Myongji for Creative Korea Project by the Ministry of Education. If more than seven students apply for a same curriculum, a customized course can be offered in English

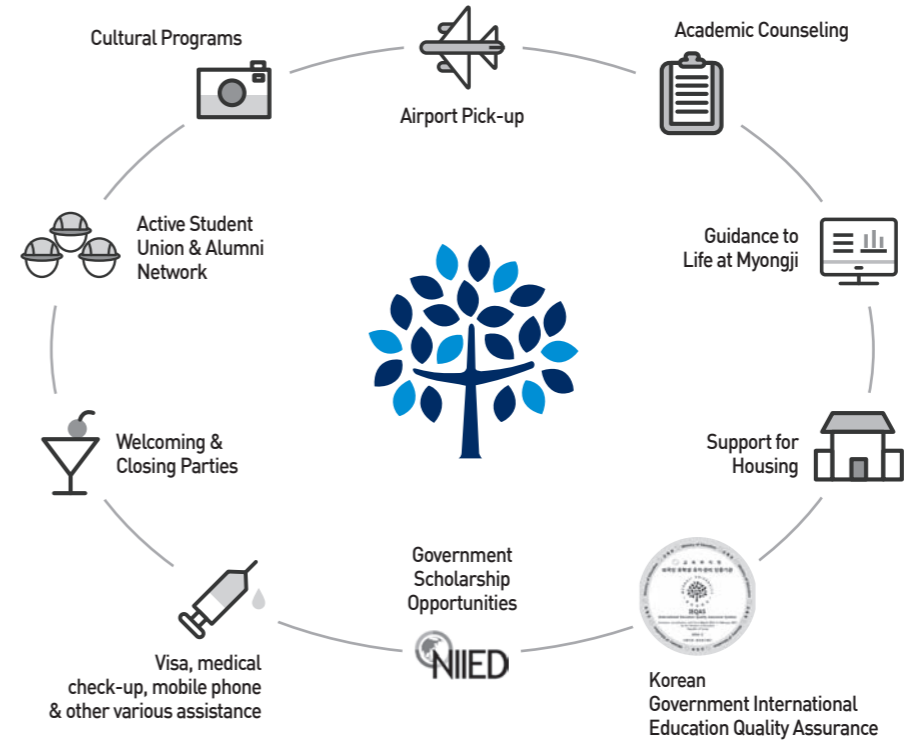

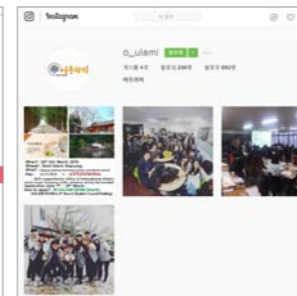

Why Choose Myongji?



Myongji Asia Leadership Program (MALP) & English / Chinese Courses: Holistic leadership development is our long-term goal, and we incorporate mentoring, leadership skill applications, field cases, and cooperative studies across different disciplines (business, politics, society, culture, art, history, science, philosophy and more especially in Asian territories) to provide an overall academic understanding.

➤ **Previous Courses:** Understanding Korean & Asian Politics, Korean Economy & Business, Korean History & Culture, Democracy & Contemporary Society, Globalization & Social Change, Understanding Global Politics, Film & Philosophy, Korean Culture & Idea, Enterprise & Management, Politics of Northeast Asia, History of Science Technology, Global Manner for Global Leaders, Understanding of International Development, Korean Economy & Business in the Global Environment, Civil Society & Administration, Internet & Contemporary Society and Leadership & Communication.

Korean Language Course & Korean Language Institute (KLI): In addition to our undergraduate-level Korean language courses, KLI offers intensive programs to those who wish to improve their Korean language proficiency in a relatively short period of time. Additional tuition fees occur for exchange students who register in the KLI. However, international exchange/visiting students receive 50% of tuition waiver. The courses are offered from Monday to Friday, 9 AM to 1 PM, for 10 weeks. One cultural excursion is included in the tuition. The classes are conducted in small sizes, which allows the students to receive special assistance from the professors and be given more opportunities to practice Korean.

Global Friendship Program: The Global Friendship Program has been established to enable students to develop an understanding of cultural diversity and a broader perspective that will allow them to embrace different cultures. Students will be assigned into groups, through which they will not only befriend each other but also work on a given project together. Each group will be a combination of Korean and international students. Students earn true friendship and gain in-depth understanding of Korean culture through this program. Participants also receive a small fund to carry on their project, and prizes are awarded to outstanding teams.

Culturally-enriching Hands-on Activities

Caring & Nurturing Environment



Variety of Cultural Excursions: Every semester, two or three times of large-group based cultural excursions are provided for international students to better understand Korean culture, learn Korean traditions and befriend each other. Students visit famous tourist sights & museums, learn to cook Korean food and make their own cultural items. Every week, there are small weekly activities for international students to enjoy daily Korean youth life. Korean volunteer students organize different events which vitalize the lives of international students at Myongji.

➤ **Previous Activities:** ice-skating, park picnic, Korean spa, Korean movie, Korean calligraphy, Korean palace, fried chicken and beer party, watch a baseball match in a baseball stadium, Halloween party, Kimchi-making volunteer, fire cracker festival and enjoy sports matches.

International Student Lounge: International students can easily seek help at the International Student Lounge where the International Outreach Student Club (OULAMI) members and staff of the Office of International Affairs provide adequate aid.

One-stop Service: The Office of International Affairs helps international students with airport pick-up, alien registration card, dormitory check-in, opening a Korean bank account, medical check-ups, course registration, guidance to life in Korea, creating a cellphone number, issuance of certificates and other necessary administrative needs.



Globalize Yourself Campaign: A Campaign to educate future global leaders is organized every semester. Students participate in a discussion about the cultural differences they experience in Korea and explore various questions they have about Korean/Asian cultures. After several discussions, international students share their findings about the cultural differences with other students in the form of exhibitions and presentations.

Myongji Festival: Myongji holds a festival on May every year. Students can experience Korean street food and games. Celebrities are invited to perform in the evening, where all Myongji students can watch for free. International students also share their cultures by sharing their origin's food and cultural items.

Korean Games and Sports Day: International students can experience traditional and contemporary Korean games and sports.

International Exchange Program

Undergraduate Academic Calendar

- Spring Semester: 02 March – mid June (apply by November of the previous years)
- Fall Semester: 01 September – mid December (apply by May)

Exchange Program

International exchange student is a student who studies at Myongji for one semester or one academic year after being nominated by his/her home university in accordance with the terms and conditions specified in the valid partnership agreement signed with Myongji.

During their Study at Myongji, International Exchange Students are:

- exempted from paying tuition to Myongji after paying the tuition fees to their home universities.
- given necessary information for convenient study in Korea, which includes post-arrival orientation and opening/closing ceremonies.
- permitted to take any undergraduate classes conducted in Korean or English to obtain credits.
- able to participate in special cultural events including Korean cultural field trips with minimum charge.
- supported by Myongji's International Outreach Student Club (OULAM) and mentors in their departments to easily adapt themselves to Myongji life and culture and make Korean and international friends.
- provided with official academic transcripts after completion of their study at Myongji.
- allowed to participate in special summer program with tuition discount.
- allowed to take intensive Korean language courses at the Korean Language Institute (KLI) with 50% tuition waiver.



Customized Undergraduate Programs

Myongji can offer customized English-taught courses when a group of more than 7 students requests certain curriculums.

All the participating students must take the same course. Especially courses from the Colleges of Engineering, Architecture, Arts, and Design, and Physical Education could be offered in English according to students' needs. Short-term programs could also be customized according to each partner institute's request.

Visiting Program

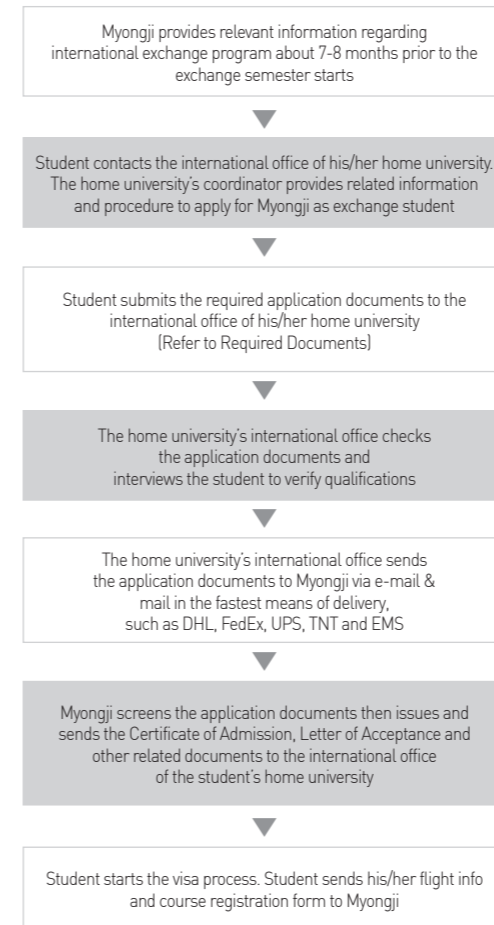
Visiting students share all the same privileges as exchange students, except they pay tuition at Myongji. However, visiting students are eligible for 20% of scholarship every semester.

Dual-degree Programs

To provide wider range of academic choices for international students, Myongji offers dual-degree programs (2+2 or 3+1) with partner institutions. These allow students to experience different academic environments which enhance understanding of their field of study.

Summer Programs

Academic Summer at Myongji (ASAM)

ASAM offers a chance for international students to become experts in Asia. Courses offered in ASAM are dedicated to educating future global leaders with expertise in different aspects of Asian countries and Korea. All the courses are provided in English from Monday to Thursday. Opportunities to explore Asian and Korean culture are provided every Friday. International students can befriend Korean students who help them during their stay in Korea.

- Special features: Befriending Korean students who guide the intentional students in all the excursions

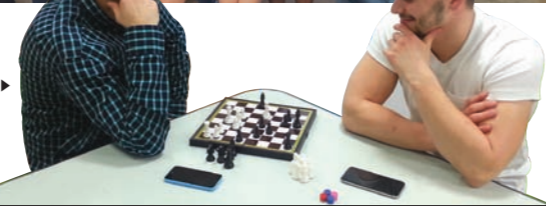

The Dormitory Building in Seoul Campus was built in 2006, a 9-story building with a capacity of 864 students with 309 rooms. There are five Dormitory Buildings in Yongin Campus which can host 1,872 students. 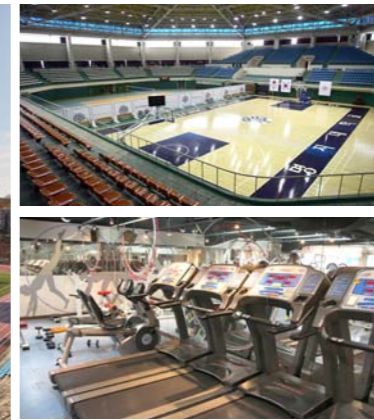
