

WHAT APPLICANTS NEED TO KNOW

- O1 If it is found that an applicant has been admitted through illegal methods including forgery and falsification of the documents to be submitted during the admission procedure, admission will be cancelled.
- O2 After the application form is received, no content on the application form and documents submitted shall be changed or voided. Accordingly, it is necessary to fully and accurately understand the contents of the Application Guide for International Students (applicants cannot change departments after submission of the application form).
- **03** If admission is cancelled due to a wrong contact number written on the application form (phone number and address) or because an applicant is out of contact, the relevant applicant is responsible for the cancellation.
- **O4** If an applicant cannot enter Korea because their visa is rejected by a relevant authority after the admission is confirmed, admission is cancelled.
- 05 All documents submitted by the applicants are not returned (The certificate of graduation will be returned after verification).
- O6 According to the National Health Insurance Act and the Enforcement Rules of the same Act, international students will be required to pay the applicable insurance premium from March 2021, as other registered foreigners who are local subscribers to the national health insurance.
