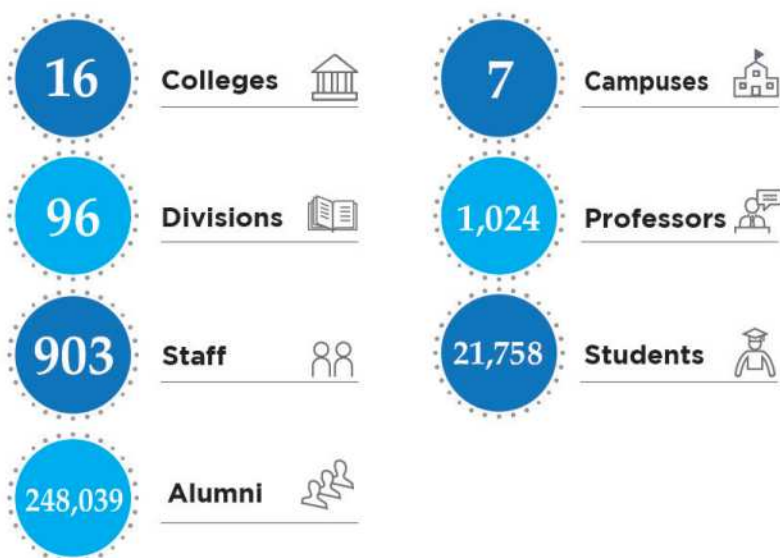

Come and explore in and around Jeonju, while studying at JBNU.



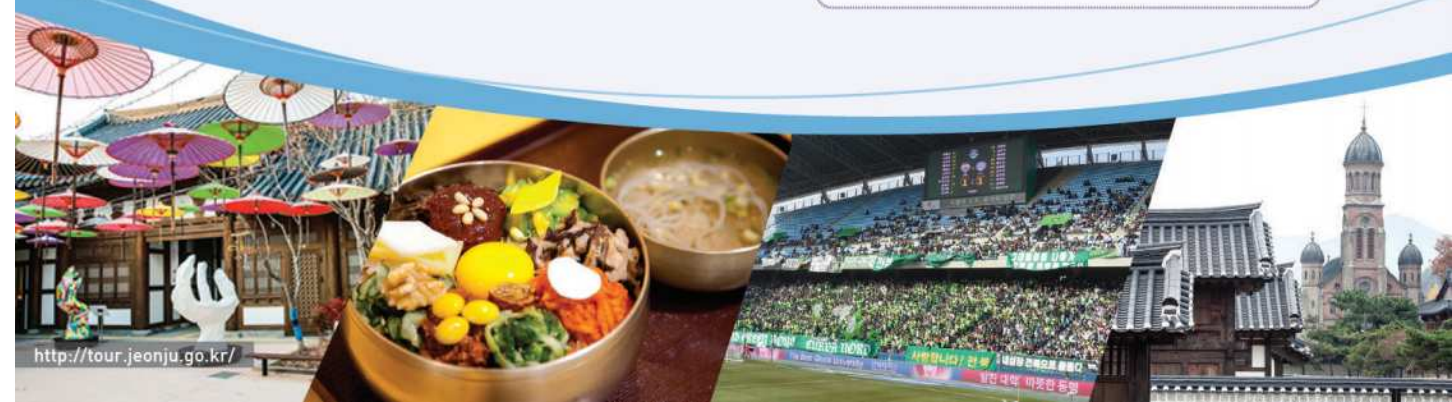

The Feeling Korea program has been designed to provide participants with the great opportunity to learn both Korean language and culture. The program includes a few field trips through which participants can experience Korean culture different from their own.

## Periods

2 weeks starting in July or August  
2 weeks starting in January or February

## Eligibility

Anyone above the age of 17

## Course Title

2 credit hour course: Practice in Traditional Korean Culture

## Participation Fees

\$1,000 fee that covers tuition, room & board, activities, and field trips

## Scholarship

\$200 for students from a partner university

## Other Expenses

Airfare, insurance, and shuttle transportation to and from Incheon airport (optional)



## Customized Short-term Program

Partner universities or potential partner universities may contact the Office of International Affairs, JBNU for any customized program for students and/or staff. The program may differ somewhat from *the Feeling Korea* in terms of program periods, activities, and costs.





## INTENSIVE PROGRAMS AT KOREAN LANGUAGE EDUCATION CENTER (KLEC)

One of KLEC's missions is to help international students acquire high levels of Korean language proficiency; the majority of international students advance to academic programs after graduating from the KLEC courses.

### Intensive Korean Language Course

**Course Length** 4 semesters (10 weeks/semester)

**Class Hours** 4 consecutive hours in the morning or in the afternoon

**Class Levels** Basic (1~2), Intermediate (3~4), Advanced (5~6)

**Tuition (semester)** 1,300,000KRW (approx. \$1,200)

KLEC offers extracurricular activities such as cooking classes, field trips, and sports games.

KLEC provides a 2-week program for those who are interested in Korean culture and JBNU. Participants will learn Korean language, experience Korean culture through various activities, and go on a field trip to Seoul. High school students and their parents will have ample opportunity to take a closer look at JBNU.

### Jeonbuk National University Hospital

JBNU hospital, founded in 1909, is the largest general hospital in the province of Jeonbuk and has more than a thousand hospital beds. Medical staff here treat approximately 900,000 outpatients and 370,000 inpatients and perform 19,000 surgical operations each year. The JBNU hospital has firmly established its status as a top-tier general hospital over the last 110 years. JBNU students get a 15% discount on medical bills.
