Test of Proficiency in Korean (TOPIK) Preparation Class

- **Tuition fee** : 100,000 KRW

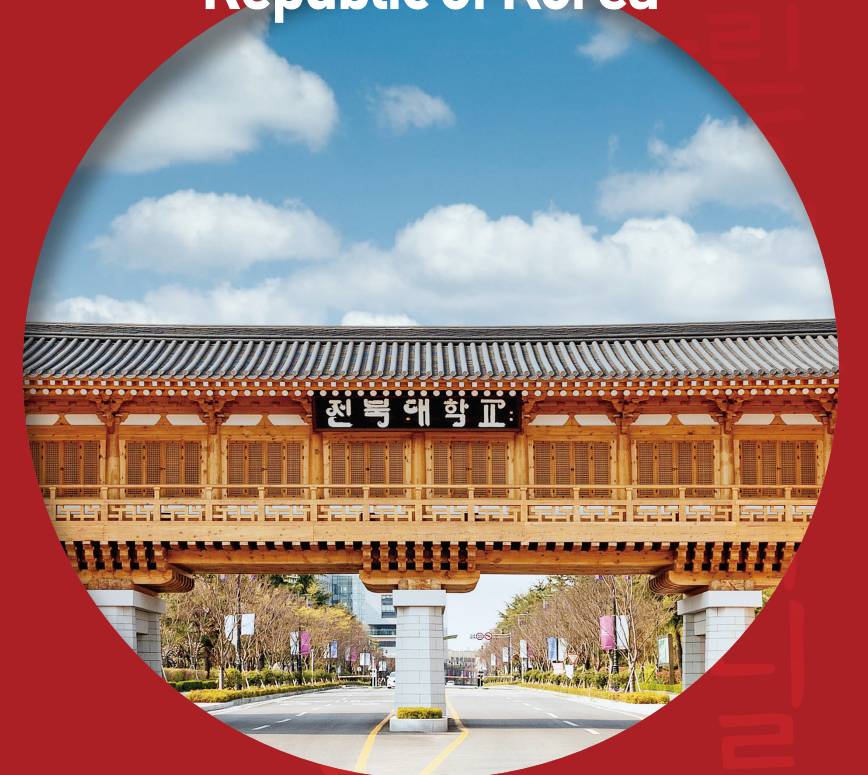

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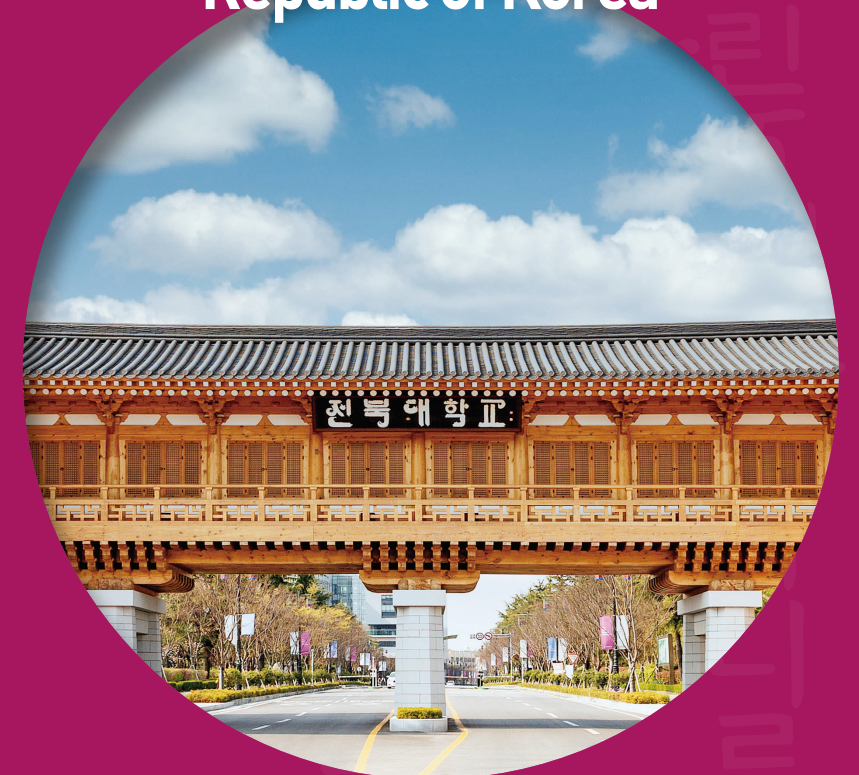
