- Evaluation criteria : 100% Language proficiency
- No need to apply for the 1st Semester Scholarship.
- E scholarship is given to Sookmyung alumni or previous exchange students.
- E scholarship is applied to Graduate students only.

2. Scholarship while in School

- (1) Automatically awarded based on GPA of the previous semester.
- (2) According to the International Students Admission regulations, the scholarship could be changed.
- (3) Tuition 100% scholarship : Publication of a thesis in an international journal that reflects the Academy info (student as the first author, full-time faculty as the corresponding author), limited to within 6 months after publication of the thesis. If eligible, applicants must apply by e-mail to the International Student Service Team (studyabroad@sm.ac.kr) within the period to be screened for scholarship.
