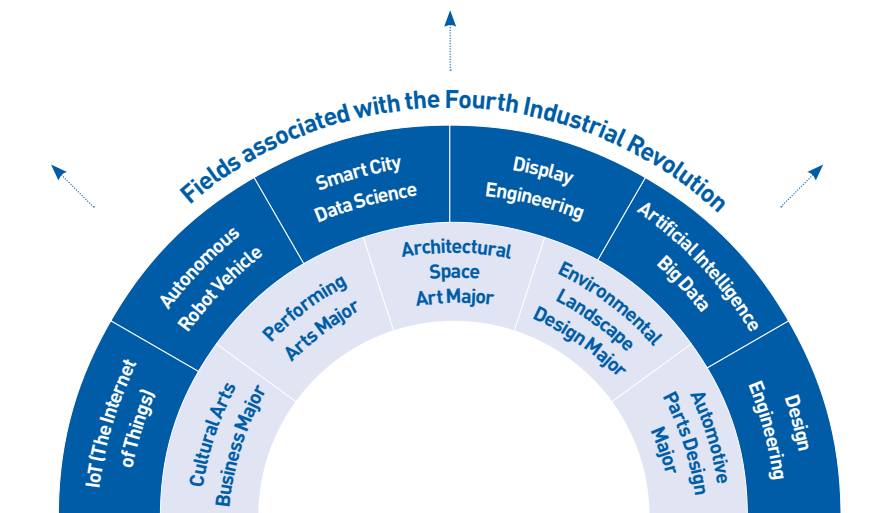

24 floors of hotel-style dormitory rooms with a view of the Han River, student cafeteria, student support facilities, study rooms, and a culture and sports complex.

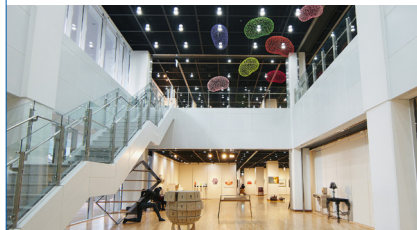


A new eco-friendly dormitory

The best musical theatre in the Daehakro area where experts from stage design, stage techniques, acoustics, and others foster professional artists of performing arts in a world-class theatre.

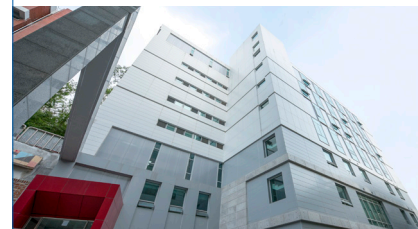

A space that supports the materialization of ideas in comfortable working areas, such as 3 large prototyping rooms, a spray room, and more.

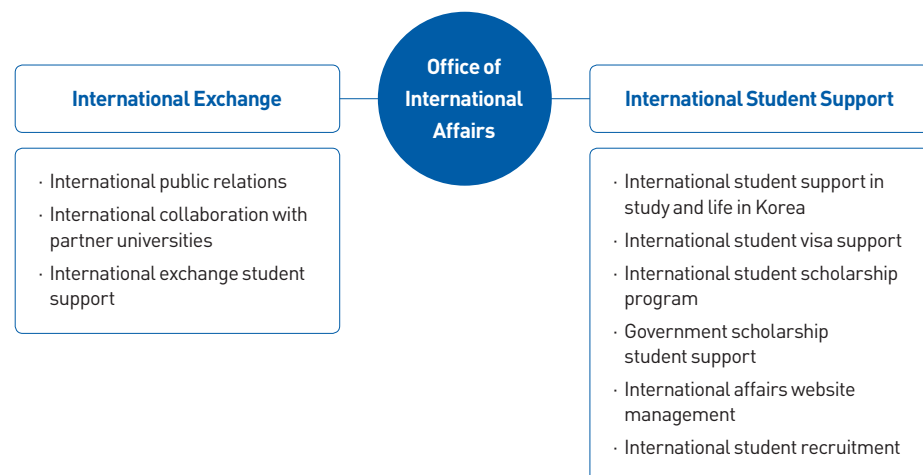


Sejong Campus Industry-Academia Cooperation Foundation

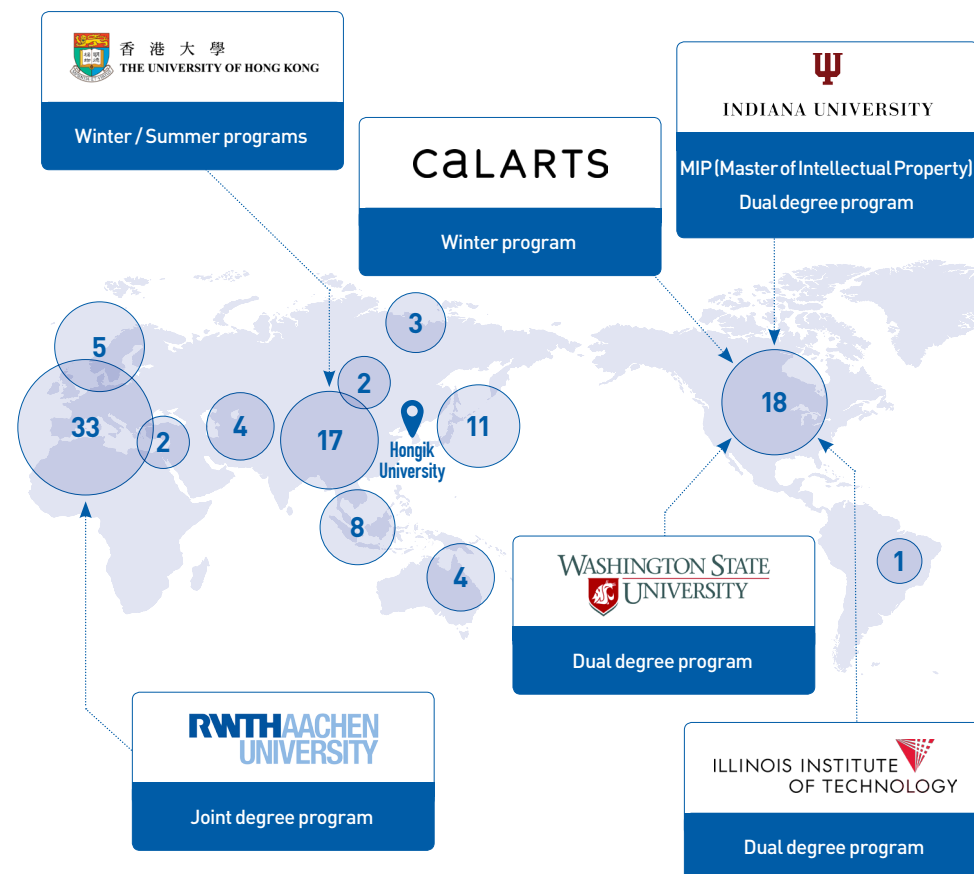

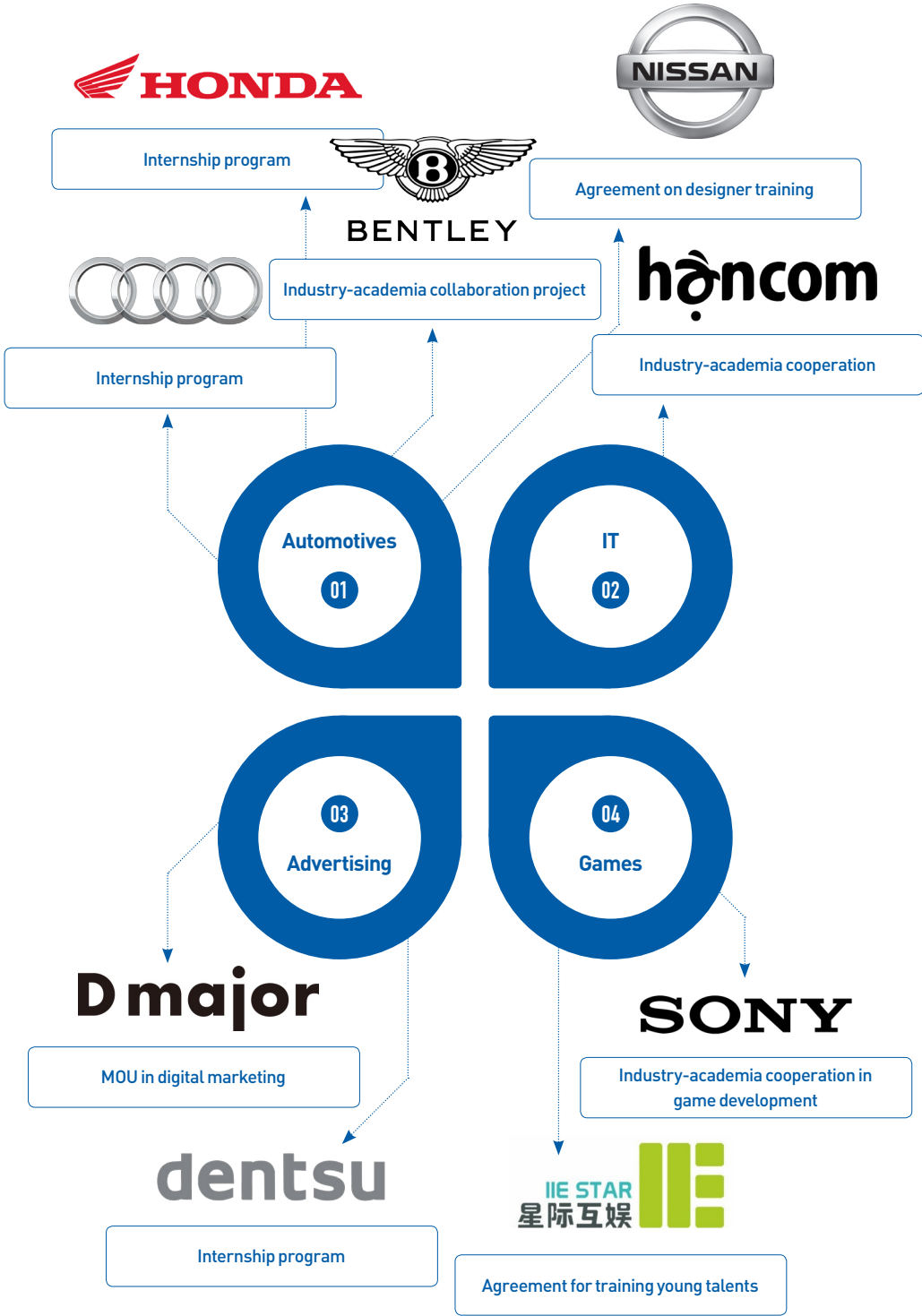

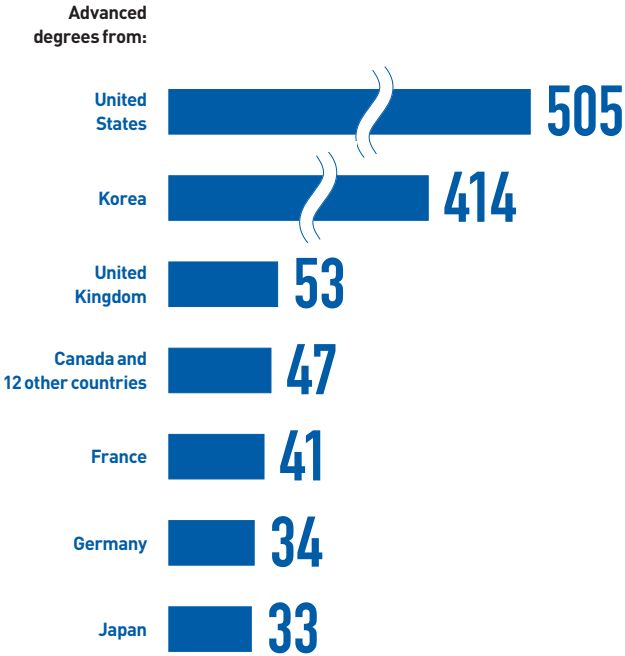

We have won three national championships in 2016 including the national baseball game and more. The national team won third place for two consecutive times in the '2016 U-23 World Baseball Championship'.

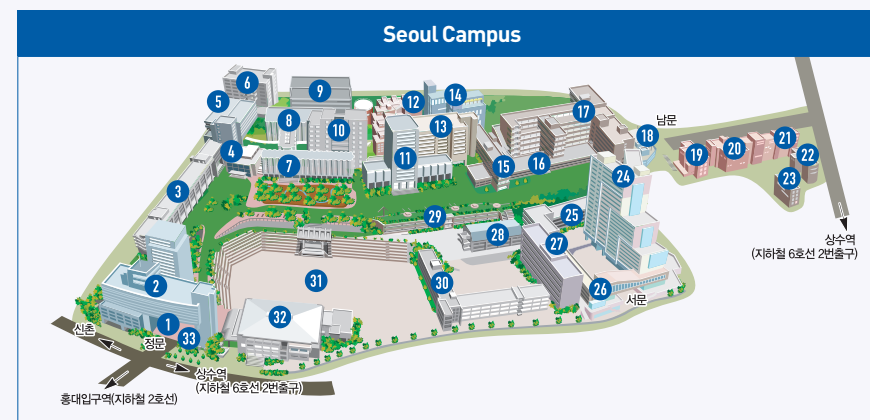
Soccer Team

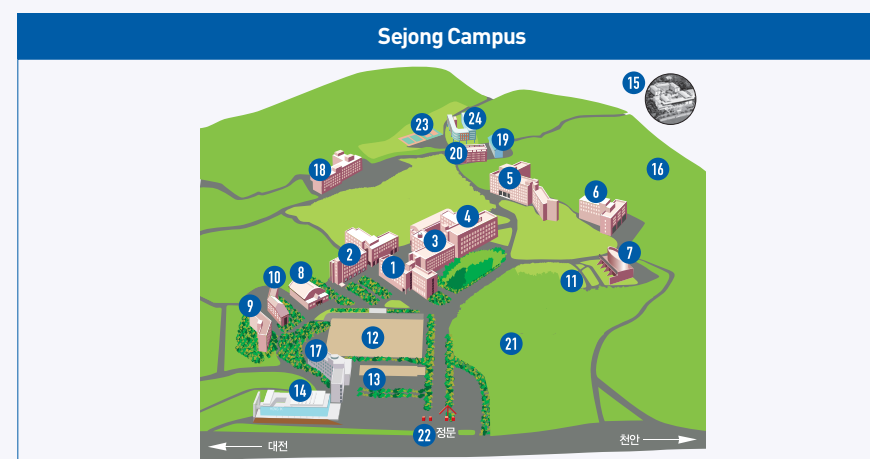
Volleyball Team
